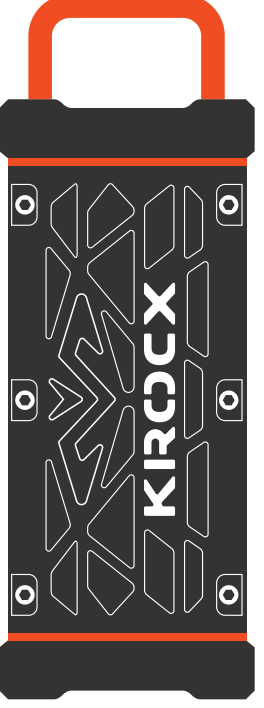
GETTING STARTED

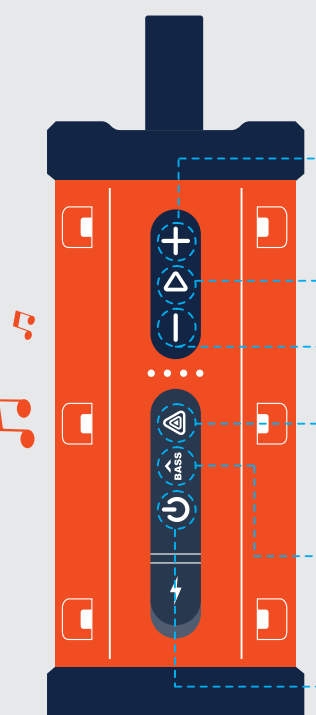

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BASIC CONTROLS

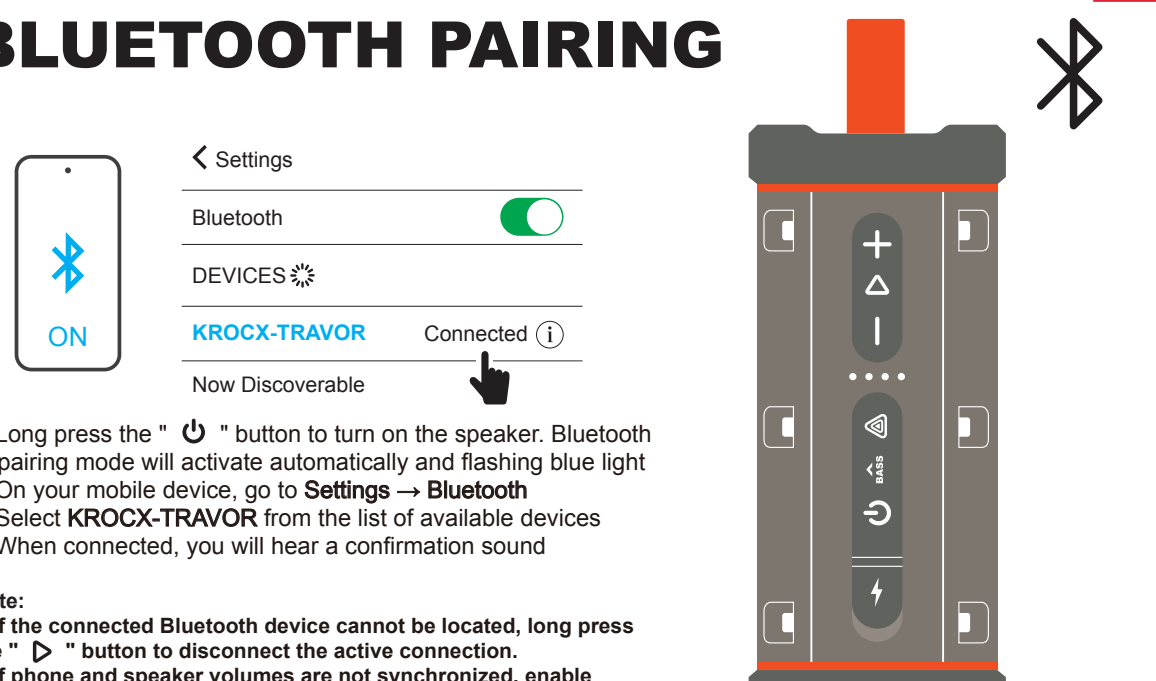
Each button supports multiple actions depending on press duration



- Volume Control:**
 - Short press: Increase volume
 - Long press: Next track
- Play/Pause:**
 - Short press: Play or pause music
 - Long press: Disconnect current bluetooth connection
- Volume Control:**
 - Short press: Decrease volume
 - Long press: Previous track
- TWS & AURACAST:**
 - Long press: Activate True Wireless Stereo (TWS) mode (green indicator)
 - Short press: Activate Auracast mode (white indicator)
- BASS:** Bass Adjustment
 - Short press: Switch between Outdoor Mode and Indoor Mode.
- Indicator Status:**
 - White indicator solid on: Outdoor Mode
 - Indicator off: Indoor Mode(Default on first power-on)
- Power Button:**
 - Long press: Turn the speaker on or off
 - Short press: Check battery level

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BLUETOOTH PAIRING



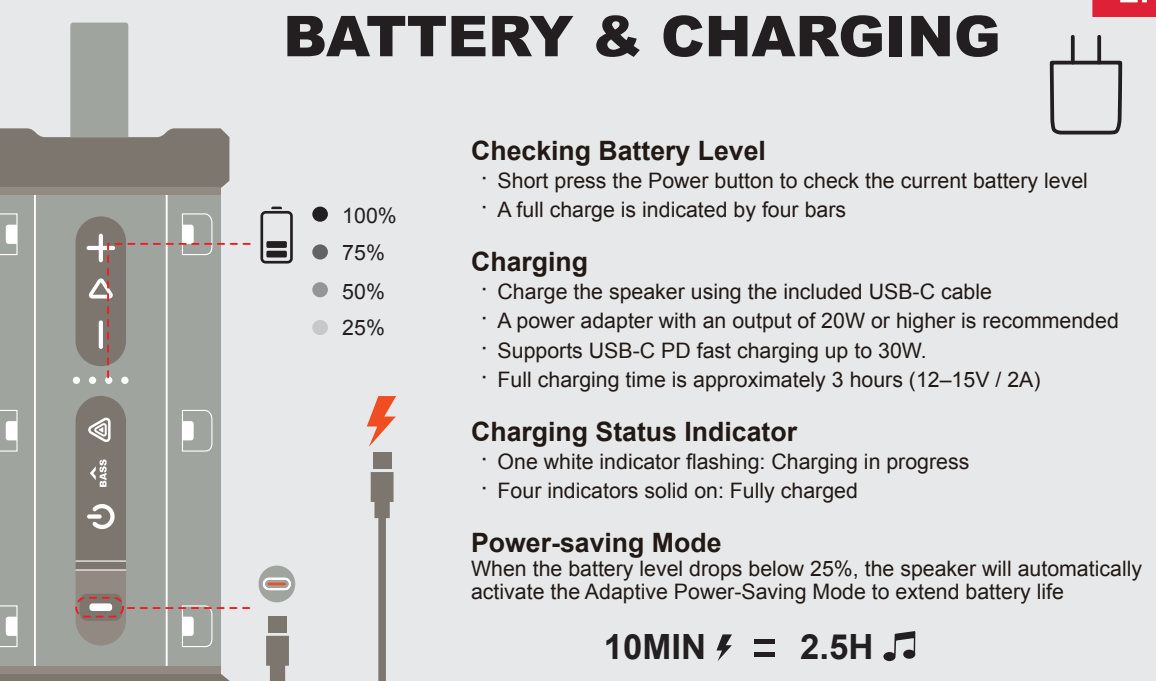
- Long press the "Power" button to turn on the speaker. Bluetooth pairing mode will activate automatically and flashing blue light
- On your mobile device, go to **Settings** → **Bluetooth**
- Select **KROCCX-TRAVOR** from the list of available devices
- When connected, you will hear a confirmation sound

Note:

- If the connected Bluetooth device cannot be located, long press the "Play/Pause" button to disconnect the active connection.
- If phone and speaker volumes are not synchronized, enable "Device Volume Sync" in the Bluetooth device settings. (Tap the icon next to the speaker name "KROCCX-TRAVOR" to find it.)

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BATTERY & CHARGING



- Checking Battery Level**
 - Short press the Power button to check the current battery level
 - A full charge is indicated by four bars
- Charging**
 - Charge the speaker using the included USB-C cable
 - A power adapter with an output of 20W or higher is recommended
 - Supports USB-C PD fast charging up to 30W.
 - Full charging time is approximately 3 hours (12-15V / 2A)
- Charging Status Indicator**
 - One white indicator flashing: Charging in progress
 - Four indicators solid on: Fully charged
- Power-saving Mode**
 - When the battery level drops below 25%, the speaker will automatically activate the Adaptive Power-Saving Mode to extend battery life

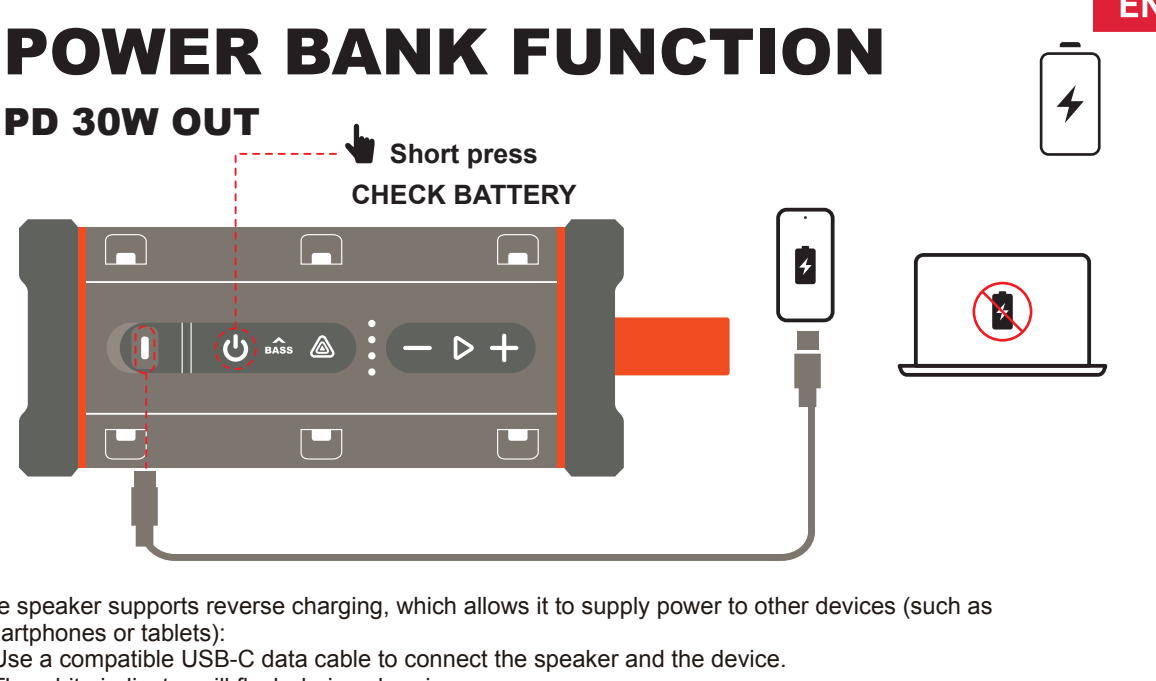

- Short press CHECK BATTERY

The speaker supports reverse charging, which allows it to supply power to other devices (such as smartphones or tablets):

- Use a compatible USB-C data cable to connect the speaker and the device.
- The white indicator will flash during charging

Ensure the speaker's battery level is at least 20% to maintain reverse charging efficiency

Note: Please don't supply power to large electronic devices (such as computers).

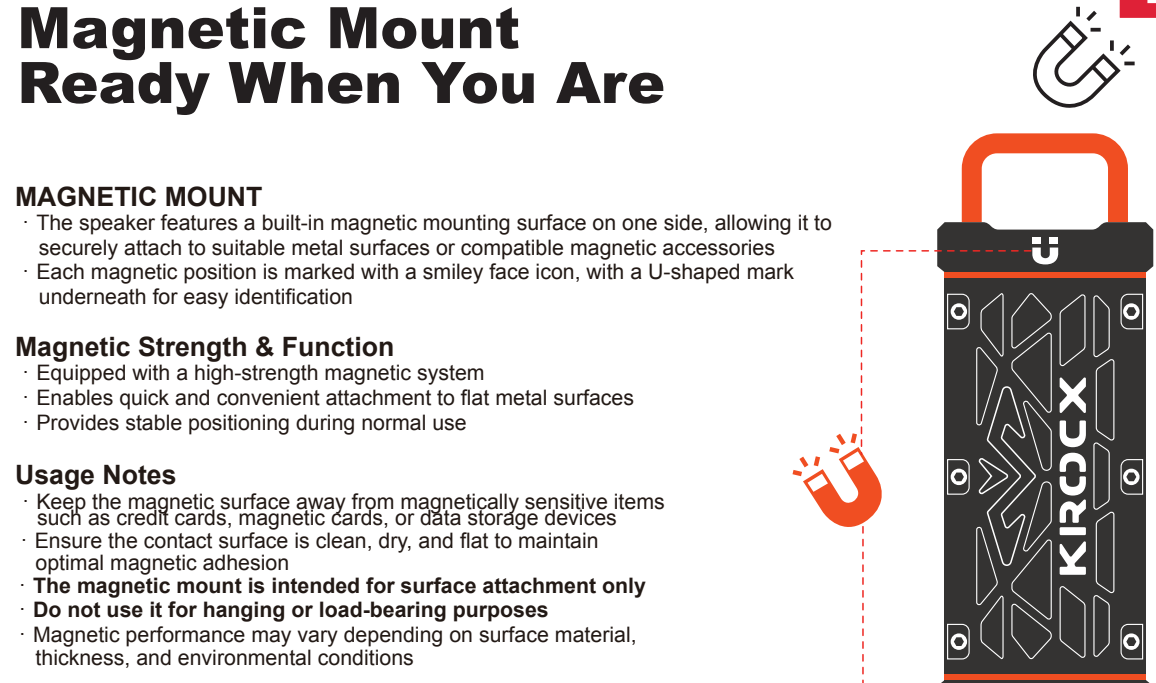

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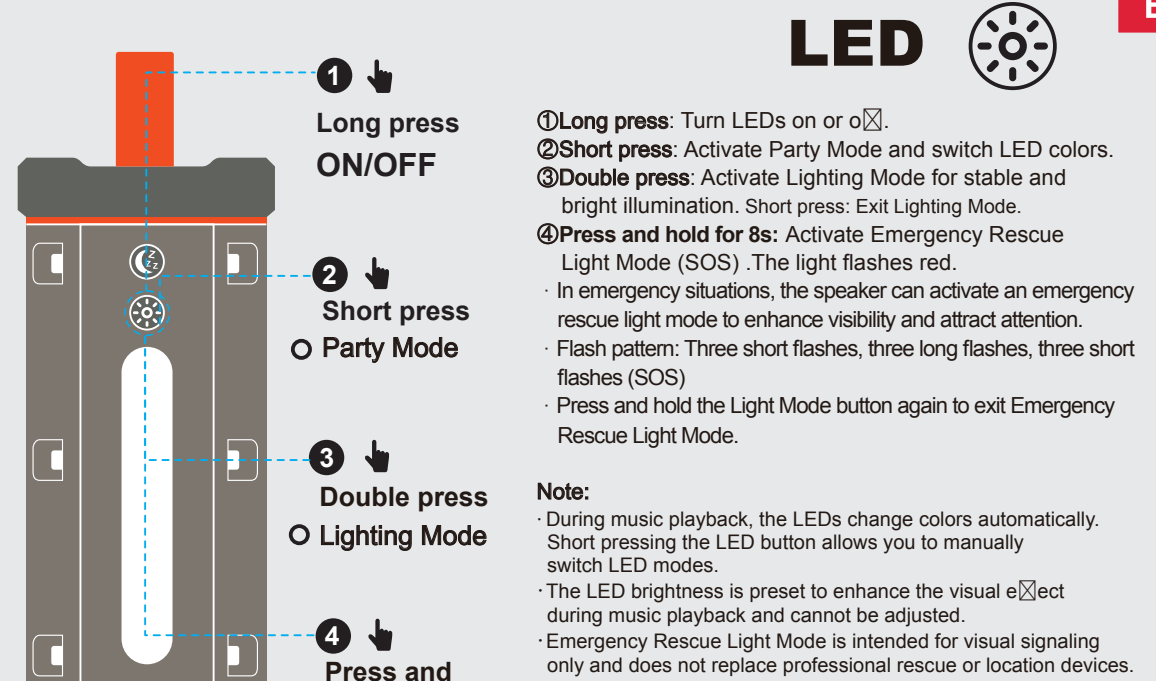
Magnetic Mount
Ready When You Are



- MAGNETIC MOUNT**
 - The speaker features a built-in magnetic mounting surface on one side, allowing it to securely attach to suitable metal surfaces or compatible magnetic accessories
 - Each magnetic position is marked with a smiley face icon, with a U-shaped mark underneath for easy identification
- Magnetic Strength & Function**
 - Equipped with a high-strength magnetic system
 - Enables quick and convenient attachment to flat metal surfaces
 - Provides stable positioning during normal use
- Usage Notes**
 - Keep the magnetic surface away from magnetically sensitive items such as credit cards, magnetic cards, or data storage devices
 - Ensure the contact surface is clean, dry, and flat to maintain optimal magnetic adhesion
 - The magnetic mount is intended for surface attachment only**
 - Do not use it for hanging or load-bearing purposes**
 - Magnetic performance may vary depending on surface material, thickness, and environmental conditions

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LED



- Long press ON/OFF**
- Short press Party Mode**
- Double press Lighting Mode**
- Press and hold for 8s (SOS)**

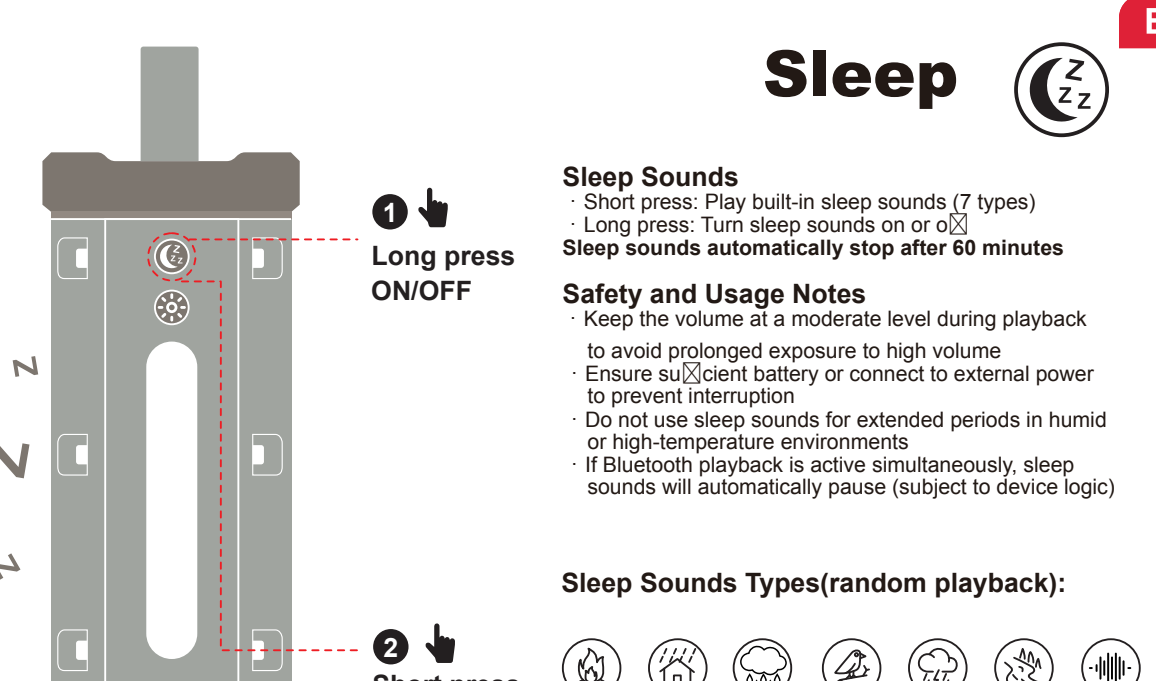
- Long press:** Turn LEDs on or off.
- Short press:** Activate Party Mode and switch LED colors.
- Double press:** Activate Lighting Mode for stable and bright illumination. Short press: Exit Lighting Mode.
- Press and hold for 8s:** Activate Emergency Rescue Light Mode (SOS). The light flashes red.
 - In emergency situations, the speaker can activate an emergency rescue light mode to enhance visibility and attract attention.
 - Flash pattern: Three short flashes, three long flashes, three short flashes (SOS)
 - Press and hold the Light Mode button again to exit Emergency Rescue Light Mode.

Note:

- During music playback, the LEDs change colors automatically. Short pressing the LED button allows you to manually switch LED modes.
- The LED brightness is preset to enhance the visual effect during music playback and cannot be adjusted.
- Emergency Rescue Light Mode is intended for visual signaling only and does not replace professional rescue or location devices.

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Sleep

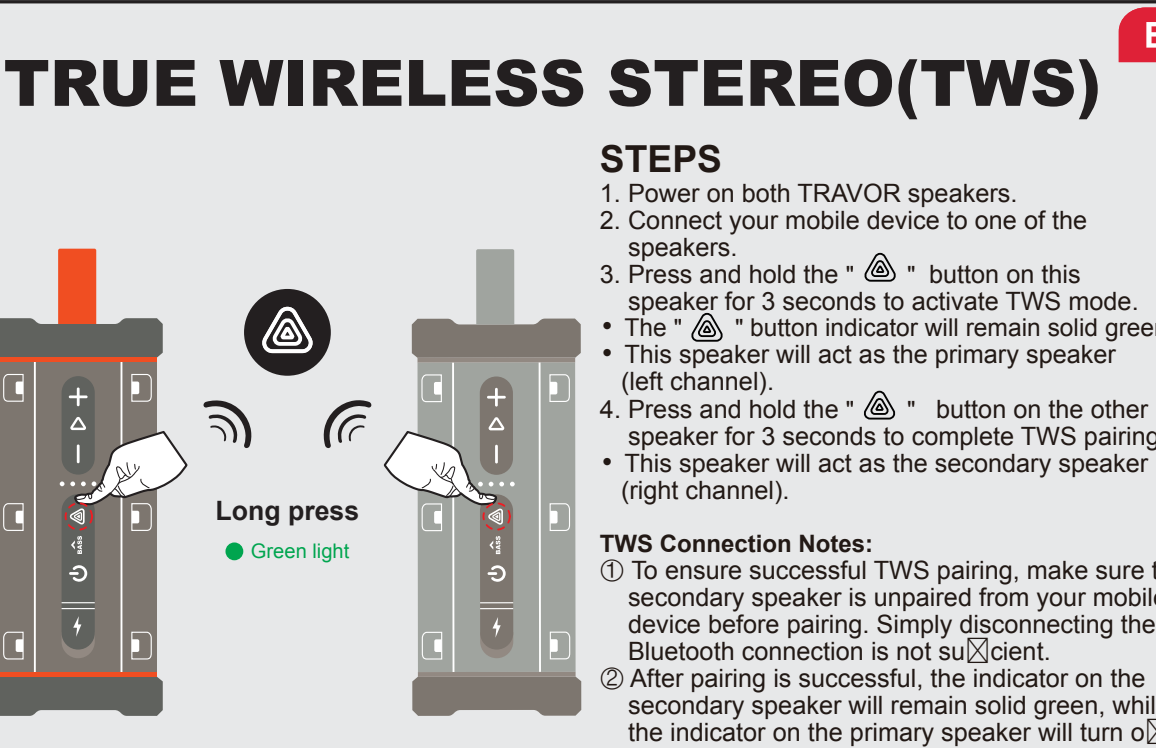


- Long press ON/OFF**
- Short press Change Sounds**

- Sleep Sounds**
 - Short press: Play built-in sleep sounds (7 types)
 - Long press: Turn sleep sounds on or off
 - Sleep sounds automatically stop after 60 minutes
- Safety and Usage Notes**
 - Keep the volume at a moderate level during playback to avoid prolonged exposure to high volume
 - Ensure sufficient battery or connect to external power to prevent interruption
 - Do not use sleep sounds for extended periods in humid or high-temperature environments
 - If Bluetooth playback is active simultaneously, sleep sounds will automatically pause (subject to device logic)
- Sleep Sounds Types(random playback):**
 - Flame
 - Rain
 - Raindrops
 - Birdsong
 - Thunder
 - Stream
 - White noise

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TRUE WIRELESS STEREO(TWS)

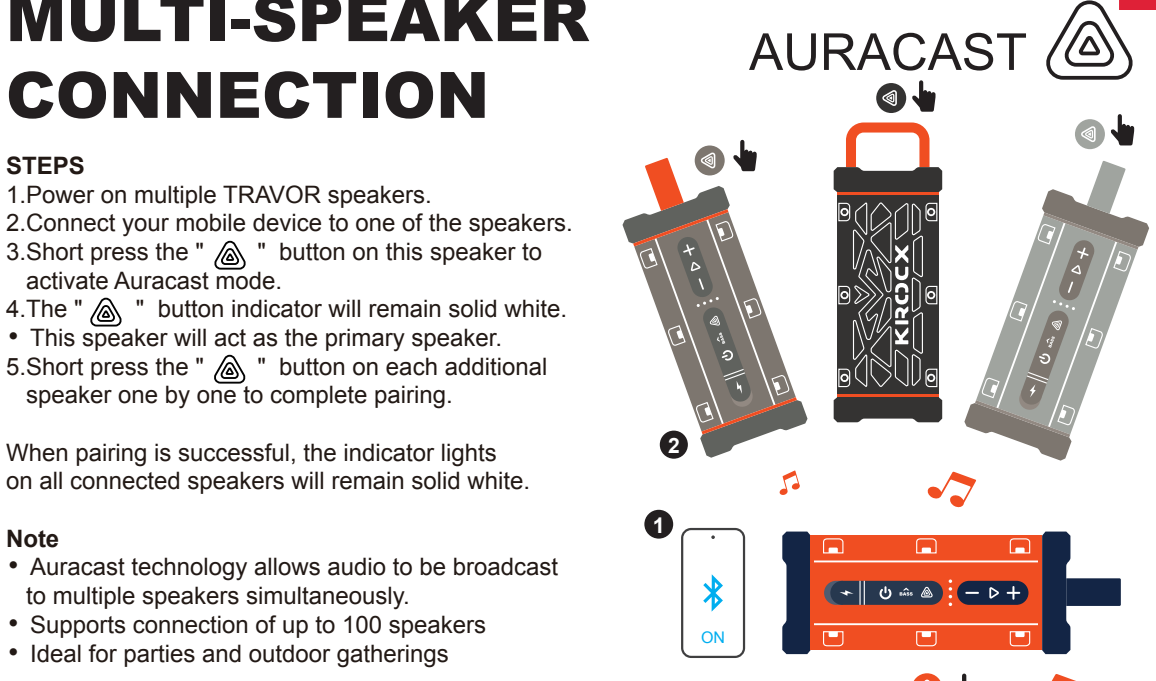


- Long press** Green light

- STEPS**
 - Power on both TRAVOR speakers.
 - Connect your mobile device to one of the speakers.
 - Press and hold the "TWS" button on this speaker for 3 seconds to activate TWS mode.
 - The "TWS" button indicator will remain solid green.
 - This speaker will act as the primary speaker (left channel).
 - Press and hold the "TWS" button on the other speaker for 3 seconds to complete TWS pairing.
 - This speaker will act as the secondary speaker (right channel).
- TWS Connection Notes:**
 - To ensure successful TWS pairing, make sure the secondary speaker is unpaired from your mobile device before pairing. Simply disconnecting the Bluetooth connection is not sufficient.
 - After pairing is successful, the indicator on the secondary speaker will remain solid green, while the indicator on the primary speaker will turn off.
 - Place the left and right speakers in their corresponding positions to enjoy true stereo sound.

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MULTI-SPEAKER CONNECTION



- STEPS**
 - Power on multiple TRAVOR speakers.
 - Connect your mobile device to one of the speakers.
 - Short press the "Auracast" button on this speaker to activate Auracast mode.
 - The "Auracast" button indicator will remain solid white.
 - This speaker will act as the primary speaker.
 - Short press the "Auracast" button on each additional speaker one by one to complete pairing.
- When pairing is successful, the indicator lights on all connected speakers will remain solid white.
- Note**
 - Auracast technology allows audio to be broadcast to multiple speakers simultaneously.
 - Supports connection of up to 100 speakers
 - Ideal for parties and outdoor gatherings

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IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

- To maintain optimal battery performance, fully charge the speaker at least once every three months when not in regular use.
- Battery life may vary depending on usage patterns and environmental conditions.
- Do not expose the speaker to liquids while the charging port is open or while charging.
