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Speed

Initial velocity of the tag/disc (in km/h or mph) before it's released from hand



Spin

Spin of the disc after release (in RPM).



Wobble

How much the tag wobbles or vibrates after the release from hand, in degrees.



Nose Angle

The nose angle of the disc at the time of the release, unit in degrees. Negative angle means nose down, positive angle nose up.



Hyzer Angle

The hyzer angle of the disc at the time of the release, unit in degrees. Negative angle means anhyzer, whereas positive angle means hyzer.



Launch Angle

Launch Angle is the angle at which the disc leaves the hand compared to the horizon.

WHAT BUTTON BATTERIES ARE COMPATIBLE WITH GAMEPROOFER™ eTAG?

Compatible Button batteries are CR1220 or CR1225

DOWNLOAD THE GAMEPROOFER™ APP

NOTE: The application needs following permissions to work properly:

- Bluetooth
- Location
- Mobile Data
- Nearby device should be set to "Allowed" (Android Only)
- It is also highly recommended to allow "Notifications" for Find-My-Disc info



START/REBOOT THE GAMEPROOFER™ eTAG

GameProofer™ eTAG has a power on/off button, on top of the tag.



PAIRING THE GAMEPROOFER™ TAG

To pair the GameProofer™ eTAG, ensure Bluetooth and location are enabled on your mobile device. Ensure GameProofer™ eTAG is turned on.

Tags can be paired when installing the app first time or going into Your Discs menu in Discs Section and selecting Add new.

UPDATING THE GAMEPROOFER™ TAG

GameProofer™ eTAG firmware can be updated in the GameProofer™ App, Discs section. You will also get notifications when a new firmware update is available.

POWER OFF THE GAMEPROOFER™ eTAG

GameProofer™ eTAG is powered off either:

- by pressing down the power button for 5 seconds
- in the application. Go to the Discs section and select the disc you want to power off. Select Power off.



THROWING

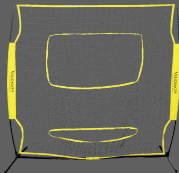
GameProofer™ eTAG is build for NET throwing indoors.

To throw, press the power button on the tag and ensure you have paired the eTAG with GameProofer™ application.

Start throwing.

Recommended throw distance to the net is 1-3m (3-10ft).

Application is guiding you, in case the throw was performed too close to the net.
