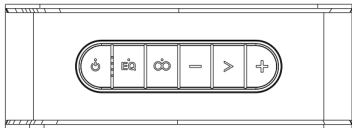

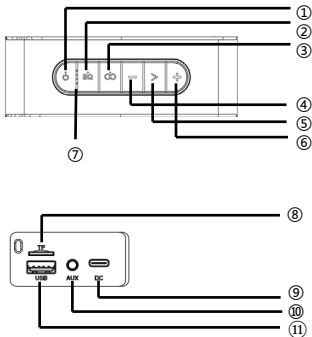

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Instructions for Speaker Button Functions

key	Operation	Function Description
	short press	Mode switching: Bluetooth/AUX/TF/USB drive
	Long press	Press and hold for 3 seconds to power on/off
EQ	short press	Switch EQ sound effect mode
	Long press	Voice assistant wake-up
	Click	Voice assistant wake-up
	Double-click	Switch light effects 1-2-3
	Long press	Turn off/on the light effect
	short press	Play/Pause
	Long press	Press and hold for seconds to disconnect the Bluetooth connection
	Bluetooth status	Double-click: Redial the last number; During an incoming call: Single-click to answer, long-press for 3 seconds to reject the call; During a call: Single-click to hang up the call

	Long press	Next song
-	short press	Volume down

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Function usage

➤ **BT Connection**

Long press the power button for 3 seconds to turn on the device. The device enters Bluetooth mode, and the blue light of the power button icon flashes quickly to enter pairing mode.

Search for the Bluetooth "B12" on your phone and click to connect.

➤ **AUX Mode**

Connect any audio device with a 3.5mm jack and play by plugging in an AUX audio cable.

➤ **TF Card/USB Flash Drive Mode**

Insert a TF card/USB flash drive after turning on the device, and the device will automatically recognize the files and play the tracks (maximum support 32G).

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Function usage

➤ **TWS Function**

1. Turn on both speakers (if there is a Bluetooth device connected, you must disconnect the Bluetooth connection first)
2. Press the " ∞ " button on one of the speakers to enter TWS pairing, and there will be a prompt tone. After successful pairing, the orange light of the " ∞ " button on the main unit will stay on.
3. At this time, turn on the Bluetooth device, search for the Bluetooth name "B12", click to connect, and then you can enjoy wireless stereo sound effect when playing music.
4. Press the " ∞ " button once in the TWS connection state to disconnect the TWS pairing.
5. For devices that have successfully connected via TWS, they will automatically enter TWS interconnection every time they are turned on (when TWS is not actively disconnected).
