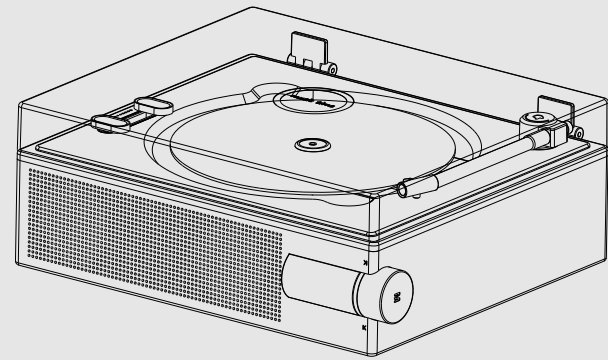
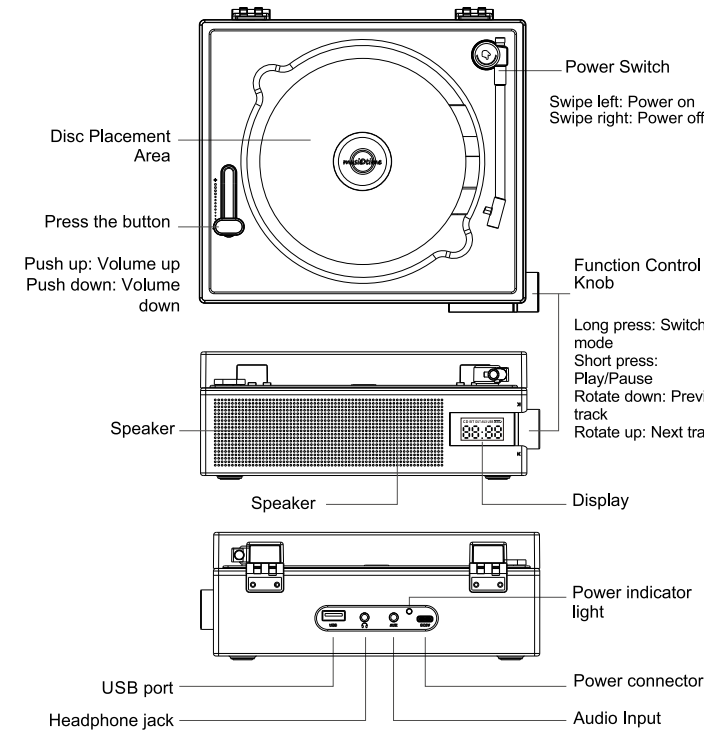

Description of Main Components

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Operating Steps

- CD Mode:**
Before powering on, remove the cardboard insert from the drive. Insert a CD, slide the play lever to the left to turn the unit ON, and wait approximately 3 seconds for the disc to begin spinning. Playback will commence after about 10 seconds.
- Bluetooth Mode:**
Slide the power switch to the left to turn it ON. Press and hold the M button to switch to Bluetooth mode. Open your phone or computer and search for "CD Player" to pair and connect. Playback will begin once connected.
- USB Drive Mode:**
Slide the power switch to the left to turn it ON. Insert the USB drive into the device's USB port, ensuring it is oriented correctly. Press and hold the M button to enter USB drive mode. The device will automatically detect music files on the USB drive. Playback will begin shortly.
- AUX Mode:**
Flip the power switch to the left to turn it ON. Plug the LINE IN cable into the AUX port. Press and hold the M button to switch to AUX mode. The device will automatically play audio from the connected input device.
- OUT Port:**
Connects to external 3.5mm headphones or audio cables.

Common Faults

If the machine malfunctions, please check the following:

- Remote control not functioning
Remote control battery insulation tab not removed / Remote control battery depleted / Remote control not aligned with the host unit's signal reception area / Remote control and host unit separated by more than 6 meters.

- *Playing discs in other formats may cause significant noise or damage to the laser head.
- *Cracked discs may cause player malfunction; do not use them.
- *Severe scratches, fingerprints, or dirt on discs may cause product malfunction or shorten the laser head's lifespan.
- *If water spills inside, immediately unplug the device from the outlet.
- *Never touch the power cord with wet hands while the device is powered on. To avoid electric shock, do not touch internal components.
- *Prevent the product from falling, liquid spills, or intrusion by foreign objects.
- *For energy savings and safety, ensure the power is completely disconnected when the product is not in use for extended periods.

- *This product does not include a power adapter; consumers must provide one. The power adapter provided by the consumer must meet the following output specifications: DC 5V--2A. Failure to comply with this specification may pose a safety risk, such as fire, electric shock, or explosion.
- *The selected power adapter must meet the following specifications: Input: AC 100-240V~, 50/60Hz; Output: 5V--2A.

- To prevent potential hearing damage from prolonged exposure to high volume at close range, avoid extended use or listening at high volume levels.

 - Improper battery replacement may cause explosion. Only replace with identical or equivalent batteries. Dispose of used batteries according to instructions.

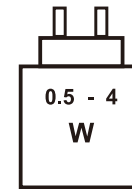
