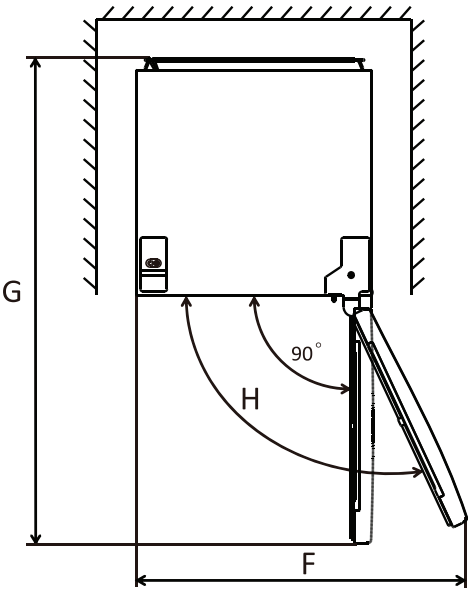
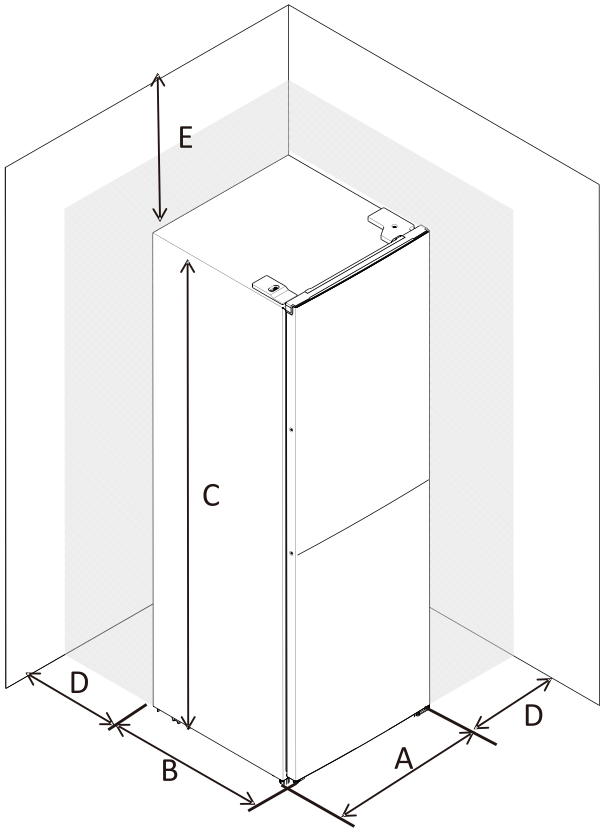

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION LOCATION

- This refrigerator is designed for indoor, household use only.
- Keep away from heat and avoid direct sunlight or places near a heat source, such as an oven or a radiator.
- Do not place the refrigerator in moist or watery places to prevent rust or reduction of insulating effect to affect the electrical insulation properties of the refrigerator.
- The refrigerator is placed in a dry and well-ventilated indoor place.
- The ground shall be flat, and sturdy (rotate the adjustable leg left or right to adjust for leveling if unstable.)
- The temperature of the location ranges from a minimum of 55°F to a maximum of 110°F. However, for better energy usage and superior cooling, the temperature is preferred to be between 60°F and 90°F.
- For proper air circulation and electric connections, allow a 2" clearance on each side and behind the refrigerator. Allow a 2" clearance at top of the refrigerator.
- Spare enough space for convenient opening of the doors and drawers, especially when the refrigerator is installed next to a fixed wall to allow the door to swing open.

ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

Before plugging in, ensure that the voltage and frequency shown on the rating plate correspond to your domestic power supply. The appliance must be grounded. The power supply cable plug is provided with a contact for this purpose. If the domestic power supply socket is not grounded, connect the appliance to a separate ground in compliance with current regulations, consulting a qualified electrician.

The manufacturer declines all responsibility if the above safety precautions are not observed.

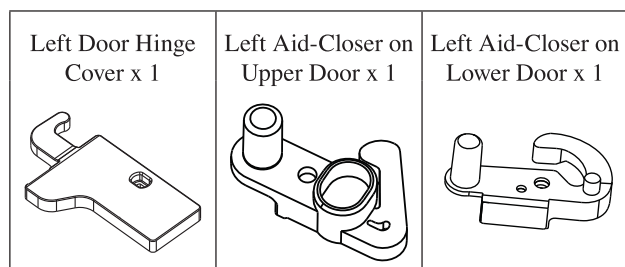

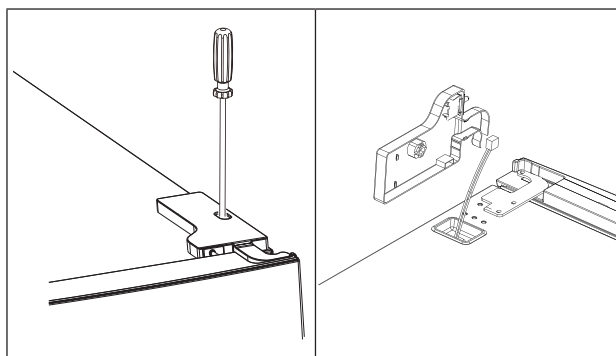

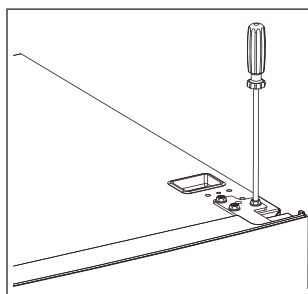

1. Unscrew top hinge cover and disconnect connector of door switch.



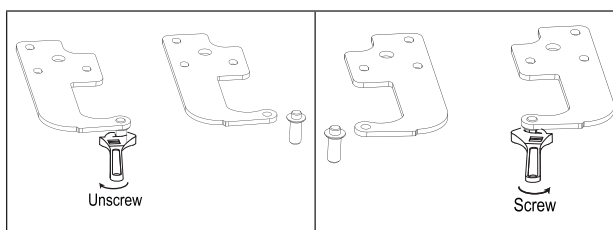
2. Unscrew top hinge with screwdriver or 1/4" socket wrench and remove the upper door.



3. Remove the pin with a wrench or 3/8" socket wrench and flip the hinge bracket. Then refit the pin to the hinge bracket.

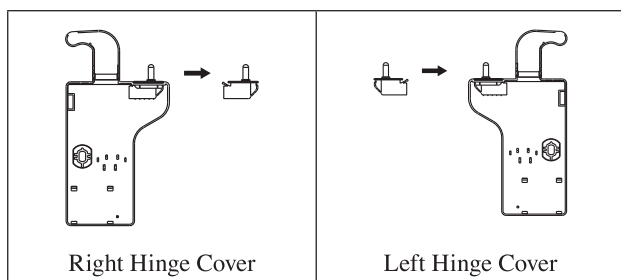

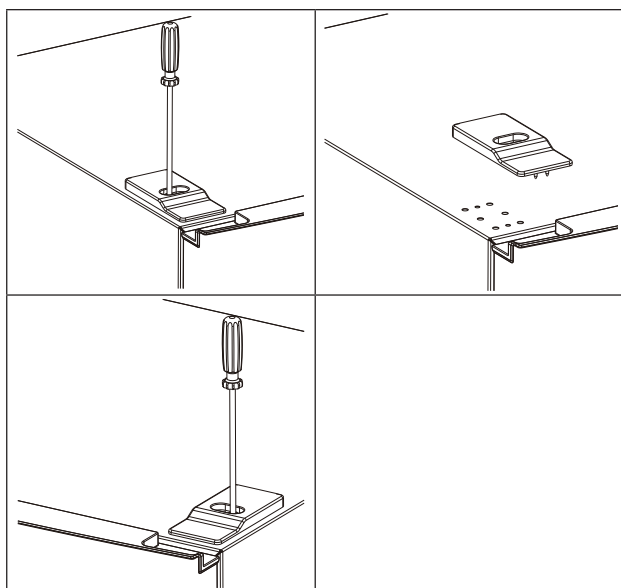

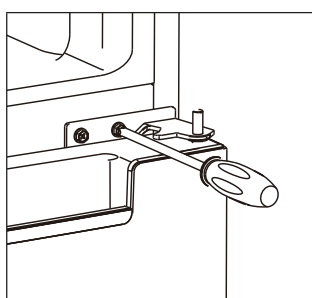
4. Move door switch from right hinge cover to left hinge cover in accessory bag.



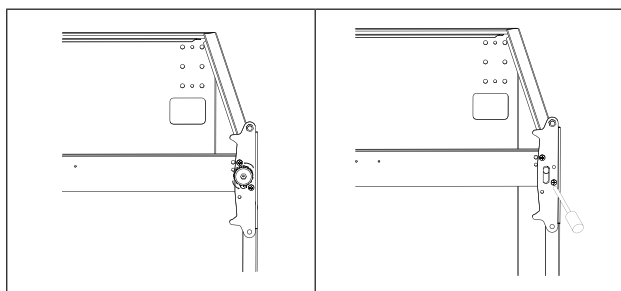
5. Move top left cover to right side.



6. Take off the upper door, take out the screw from the middle hinge by phillips screwdriver or 1/4" socket wrench, then take off the lower door.



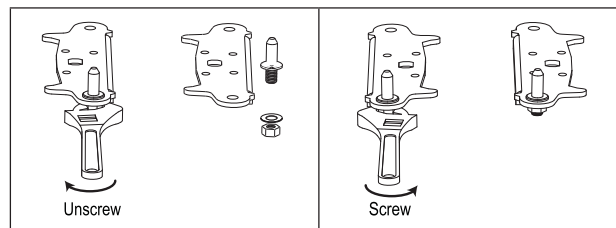
7. Unscrew bottom hinge with 3/8" socket wrench



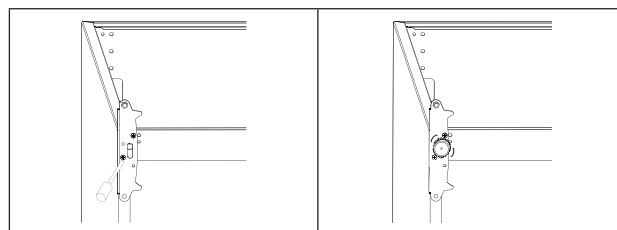
8. Unscrew and remove the bottom hinge pin with wrench or 3/8" socket wrench, turn the bracket over and refit it.

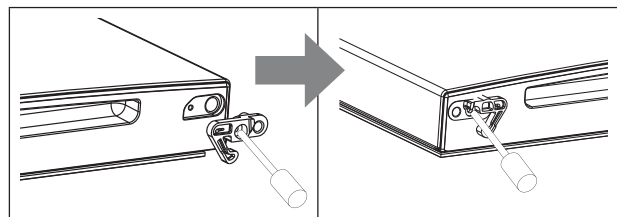

9. Refit the bracket fitting the bottom hinge pin on the left side. Replace both adjustable feet.

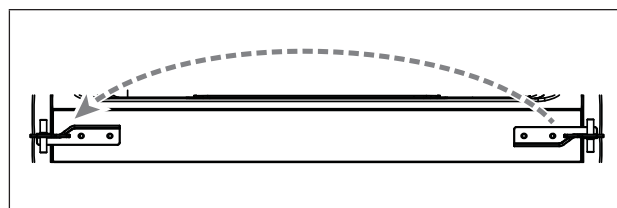


10. Remove aid-closers from bottom of upper and lower doors with screwdriver.



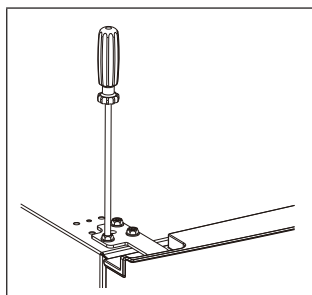
Then take new aid-closers from accessory bag and install them to the left side.

11. Move the hinge hole covers from left side to right side. Place the lower door, flip and refit the middle hinge (that you removed on step 6).



12. Refit upper door, please ensure the door is align with the cabinet to make sure door gasket is sealed to the cabinet tightly. Then connect the door with the cabinet by tightening the screw to the top hinge with a screwdriver or socket wrench.

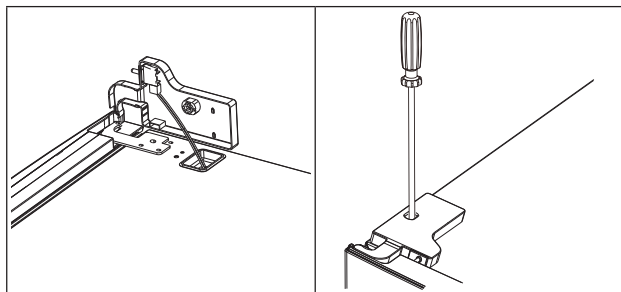

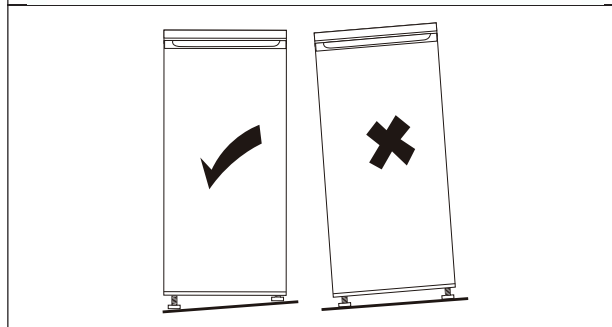
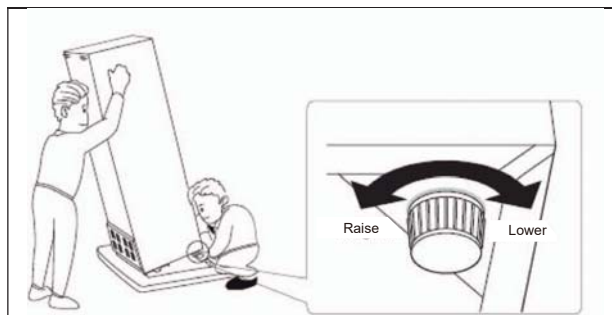

To do this adjust the two leveling feet at front of the unit.

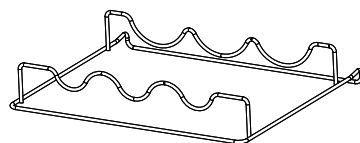
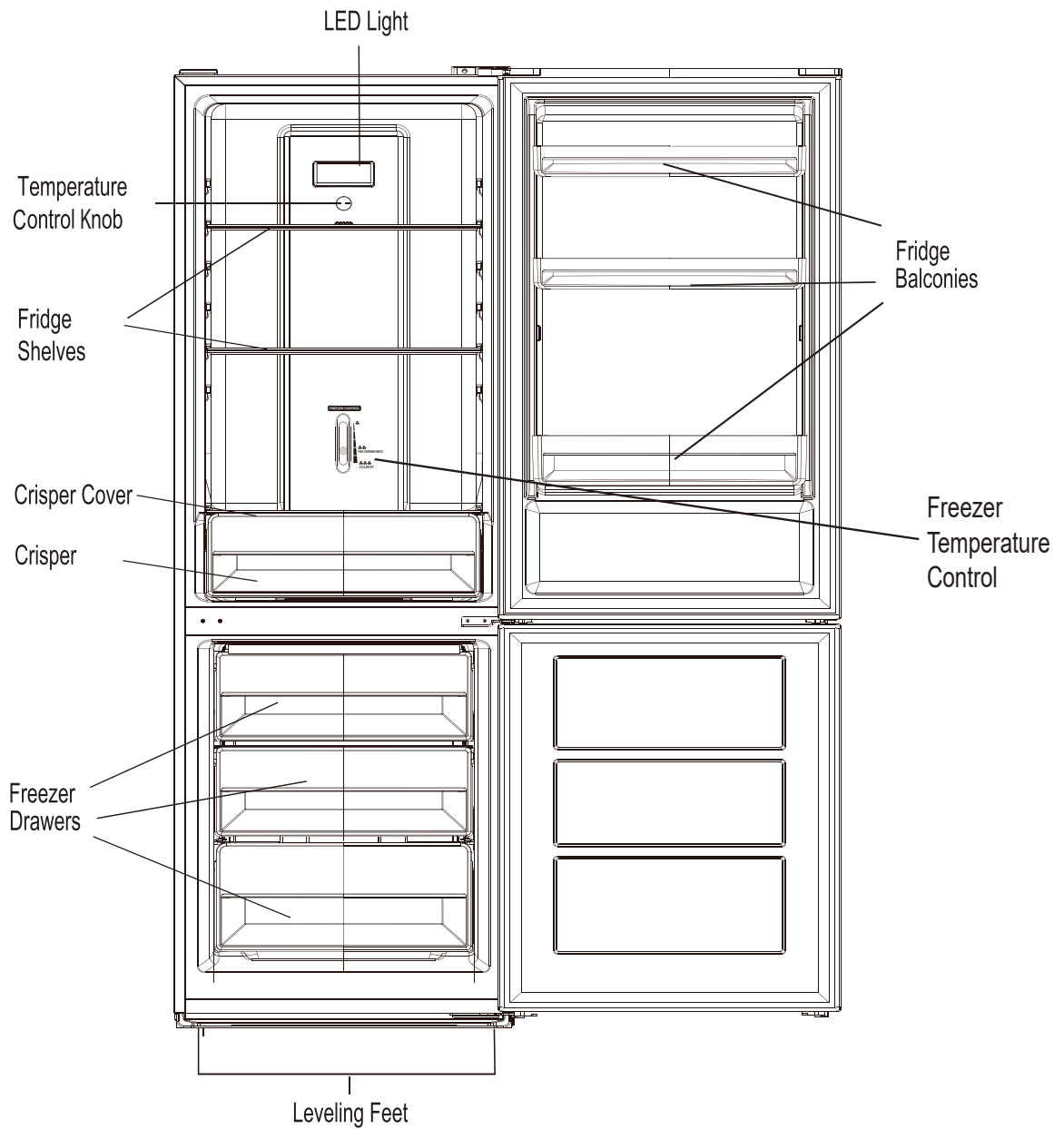
If the unit is not level, the doors and magnetic seal alignments will not be sit properly.

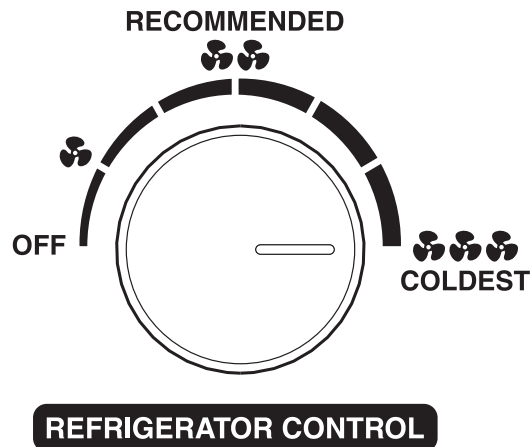

1. Temperature setting of the Fridge Compartment

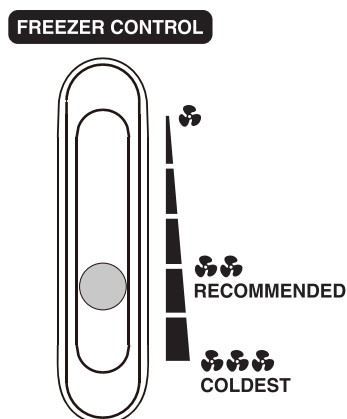
The fridge temperature setting knob



- The knob in fridge compartment is used to adjust temperature of fridge compartment.
- The internal temperature is controlled by a sensor. There are 4 settings: OFF, COLD, COLDER and COLDEST. COLD is warmest setting and COLDEST is coldest setting.
- The appliance may not operate at the correct temperature if it is in a particularly hot or if you open the door often.
- Neither fridge, nor freezer compartment works when the setting is OFF.

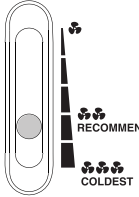
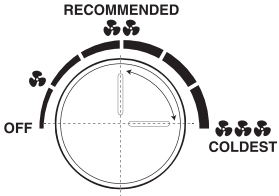
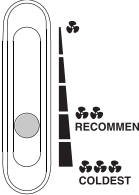
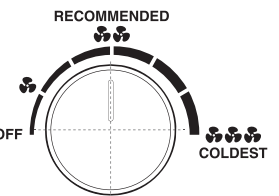
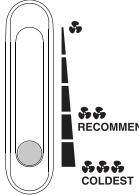
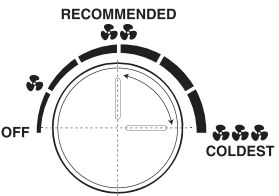
2. Temperature setting of the Freezer Compartment

The freezer temperature setting slider



- This slider in fridge compartment is used to adjust temperature of freezer compartment.
- Slider is positioned toward 1 icon, the temperature in freezer compartment will be higher. Contrarily, the temperature in freezer compartment will be lower if the slider is moved toward 4 icons.
- Middle position 2 icons of slider is advised position for normal using.
- To get lowest temperature in freezer compartment, you can adjust setting knob at coldest and position the slider at 4 icons.

- Information above give users recommendation of temperature setting.
- In winter or temperature below 61°F , users should avoid set on ❄️ and cold.
- For energy saving, the ❄️ and coldest set only apply to special need(such as quick-freezing or ice making) ,and need turn back after special need.



First use

Cleaning the interior

Before using the appliance for the first time, wash the interior and all internal accessories with lukewarm water and some neutral soap so as to remove the typical smell of a brand new product, then dry thoroughly.

Important! Do not use detergents or abrasive powders, as these will damage the finish.

Daily use

Freezing fresh food

- The freezer compartment is suitable for freezing fresh food and storing frozen and deep-frozen food for a long time.
- Place the fresh food to be frozen in the bottom compartment.
- The freezing process lasts 24 hours: during this period do not add other food to be frozen.

Daily use

Position different food in different compartments according to be below table

Refrigerator compartments	Type of food
Door or balconies of fridge compartment	• Foods with natural preservatives, such as jams, juices, drinks, condiments. • Do not store perishable foods.
Crisper drawer (salad drawer)	• Fruits, herbs and vegetables should be placed separately in the crisper bin. • Do not store bananas, onions, potatoes, garlic in the refrigerator.
Fridge shelf – middle	• Dairy products, eggs
Fridge shelf – top	• Foods that do not need cooking, such as ready-to-eat foods, deli meats, leftovers.
Freezer drawer(s)/shelf	• Foods for long-term storage. • Bottom drawer/shelf for raw meat, poultry, fish. • Middle drawer/shelf for frozen vegetables, chips. • Top drawer/shelf for ice cream, frozen fruit, frozen baked goods.

Storing frozen food

When first starting-up or after a period out of use. Before putting the product in the compartment let the appliance run at least 2 hours on the higher settings.

Important! In the event of accidental defrosting, for example the power has been off for longer than the value shown in the technical characteristics chart under “rising time”, the defrosted food must be consumed quickly or cooked immediately and then re-frozen (after cooked).

Thawing

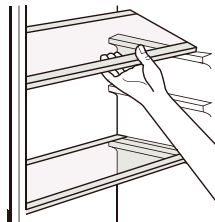
Deep-frozen or frozen food, prior to be used, can be thawed in the freezer compartment or at room temperature, depending on the time available for this operation.

Small pieces may even be cooked still frozen, directly from the freezer. In this case, cooking will take longer.

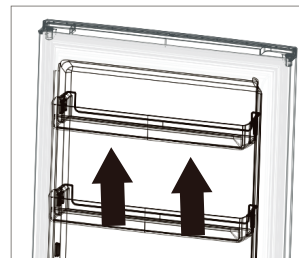
Accessories Movable shelves

The walls of the refrigerator are equipped with a series of runners so that the shelves can be positioned as desired.



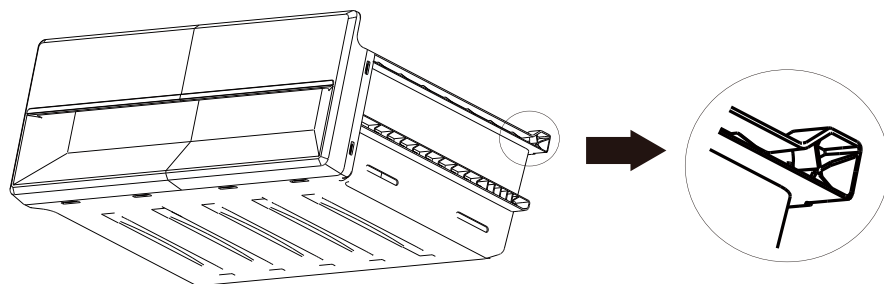
Positioning the door balconies

Door balconies can be disassembled for cleaning. To make the disassembling as follows: gradually pull the balcony in the direction of the arrows until it comes free, after cleaning, reposition it.



Disassemble the bottom drawer

1. Pull out the bottom drawer to stopper position.
2. Lift up the front of drawer.
3. Pull out the bottom drawer.



Helpful hints and tips

Hints for freezing

To help you make the most of the freezing process, here are some important hints:

- The freezing process takes 24 hours. No further food to be frozen should be added during this period;
- Only freeze top quality, fresh and thoroughly cleaned, foodstuffs;
- Prepare food in small portions to enable it to be rapidly and completely frozen and to make it possible subsequently to thaw only the quantity required;
- Wrap up the food in aluminium foil or polythene and make sure that the packages are airtight;
- Do not allow fresh, unfrozen food to touch food which is already frozen, thus avoiding a rise in temperature of the latter;
- Lean foods store better and longer than fatty ones; salt reduces the storage life of food;
- Water ices, if consumed immediately after removal from the freezer compartment, can possibly cause the skin to be freeze burnt;
- It is advisable to show the freezing in date on each individual pack to enable you removal from the freezer compartment, can possibly cause the skin to be freeze burnt;
- It is advisable to show the freezing in date on each individual pack to enable you to keep tab of the storage time.

Hints for storage of frozen food

To obtain the best performance from this appliance, you should:

Make sure that the commercially frozen foodstuffs were adequately stored by the retailer;
be sure that frozen foodstuffs are transferred from the food store to the freezer in the shortest possible time;

Do not open the door frequently or leave it open longer than absolutely necessary.

Once defrosted, food deteriorates rapidly and cannot be refrozen.

Do not exceed the storage period indicated by the food manufacturer.

Hints for fresh food refrigeration

To obtain the best performance:

- Do not store warm food or evaporating liquids in the refrigerator
- Do cover or wrap the food, particularly if it has a strong flavor

Hints for refrigeration

Useful hints:

- Make (all types): wrap in polythene bags and place on the glass shelves above the vegetable drawer.
- For safety, store in this way only one or two days at the most.
- Cooked foods, cold dishes, etc...: these should be covered and may be placed on any shelf.
- Fruit and vegetables: these should be thoroughly cleaned and placed in the special drawer(s) provided.
- Butter and cheese: these should be placed in special airtight containers or wrapped in aluminum foil or polythene bags to exclude as much air as possible.
- Milk bottle: these should have a cap and should be stored in the balconies on the door.
- Bananas, potatoes, onions and garlic, if not packed.
- For energy efficiency, all drawers, baskets and shelves, must be in right place.

Cleaning

For hygienic reasons the appliance interior, including interior accessories, should be cleaned regularly.



Caution! The appliance may not be connected to the main outlet during cleaning. Danger of electrical shock! Before cleaning switch the appliance off and remove the plug from the main outlet, or switch off or turn off the circuit breaker or fuse. Never clean the appliance with a steam cleaner. Moisture could accumulate in electrical components, danger of electrical shock! Hot vapors can lead to the damage of plastic parts. The appliance must be dry before it is placed back into service.

Important! Ethereal oils and organic solvents can attack plastic parts, e.g. lemon juice or the juice from orange peel, butyric acid, cleanser that contain acetic acid.

- Do not allow such substances to come into contact with the appliance parts.
- Do not use any abrasive cleaners
- Remove the food from the freezer. Store them in a cool place, well covered.
- Clean the appliance and the interior accessories with a cloth and lukewarm water. After cleaning, wipe with a dry cloth and rub dry.
- After everything is dry place appliance back into service.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Replace the lamp

The internal light is a LED type. To replace the lamp, please contact a qualified servicer or 1-800-BE-SHARP.

Troubleshooting

 **Caution!** Before troubleshooting, disconnect the power supply. Only a qualified technician of competent person must do the troubleshooting that is not in this manual.

Important! There are some sounds during normal use (compressor, refrigerant circulation).

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Appliance does not work	Temperature regulation knob is set at coldest	Set the knob at other switch on the appliance.
	Mains plug is not plugged in or is loose	Insert mains plug.
	Fuse has blown or is defective	Check fuse, replace if necessary.
	Socket is defective	Mains malfunctions are to be corrected by an electrician.
Appliance freezes or cools too much	Temperature is set too cold or the appliance runs at coldest.	Turn the temperature regulator to a warmer setting temporarily.
The food is not frozen enough.	Temperature is not properly adjusted.	Please look in the initial Temperature Setting section.
	Door was open for an extended period.	Open the door only as long as necessary.
	A large quantity of warm food was placed in the appliance within the last 24 hours.	Turn the temperature regulation to a colder setting temporarily.
	The appliance is near a heat source.	Please look in the installation location section.
Heavy build up of frost on the door seal.	Door seal is not air tight.	Carefully warm the leaking sections of the door seal with a hair dryer (on a cool setting). At the same time shape the warmed door seal by hand such that it sits correctly.
Unusual noises	Appliance is not level.	Re-adjust the feet.
	The appliance is touching the wall or other objects.	Move the appliance slightly.
	A component, e.g. a pipe, on the rear of the appliance is touching another part of the appliance or the wall.	If necessary, carefully bend the component out of the way.
Water on the floor	Water drain hole is blocked.	See Cleaning section.
Side panels are hot.	It's normal. Heat exchange parts are in the sides.	Use gloves to touch sides if needed.
