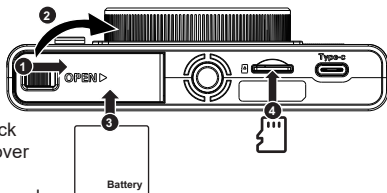
Touchscreen operation:

- Swipe up, down, left, or right to browse the menu.



Quick Start Guide

► Inserting the battery and SD card



1. Unlock the cover lock
2. Open the battery cover
3. Insert the Battery
4. Insert the micro SD card

To remove the memory card/ battery

Memory card: push the memory card in once to eject the memory card.

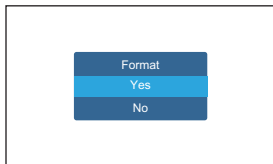
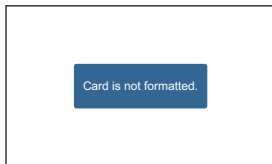
Battery: Slide the battery eject lever.

! Format the memory card

After inserting the card, briefly press the [Power] button to turn on the camera. The screen will display [Card is not formatted.]

→ A pop-up window will automatically appear [Format? Yes/No]

→ Click [Yes] → Start using the camera.



Quick Start Guide

● Setting the Language

Tap the [≡] icon in the bottom left corner → swipe left or right to find the [⚙] icon → swipe up or down to find [Language] → Click [Language] → swipe up or down to find the language you want → Click it.

● Setting the Date&Time

Tap the [≡] icon in the bottom left corner → swipe left or right to find the [⚙] icon → swipe up or down to find [Date & Time] → Click [Date & Time] → [Year-Month-Day-Hour-Minute-Second] → Click it. (Each click increments the number by 1; it cannot decrease. This cycle repeats continuously.)

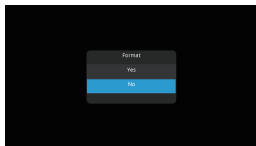
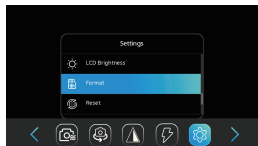

● Setting the [Macro] 📷

In photo mode, tap the [≡] icon in the bottom left corner → swipe left or right on the screen to find [Macro] → [Macro On/Macro Off] → Click [Macro On]

● Format the memory card

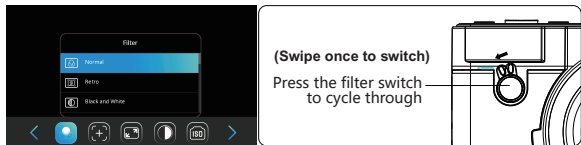
Tap the [≡] icon in the bottom left corner → swipe left or right to find the [⚙] icon → swipe up or down to find [format] → tap [format] → tap [Yes].

● Setting the Filters

Click the [☰] icon in the bottom left corner → You will see [Filter] → Swipe up or down to find the filter you want → Click it → Enter the desired filter and take a photo.



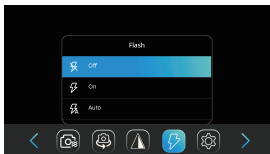
● Quickly adjust the filter

Press the filter switch to cycle through:

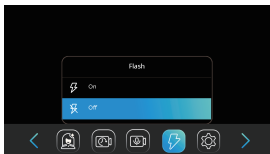

● Setting the Flash

Tap the [☰] icon in the bottom left corner → swipe left or right to find the [Flash] icon → In the Photo mode, you can see [Flash? Off/On/Auto]; In the Video mode, you can see [Flash? On/Off]

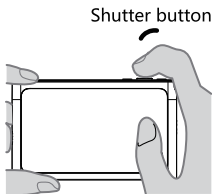

► Shooting still images/movies

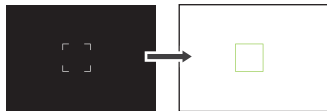
Shooting still images 📷

1. Press the [M] button → swipe the screen → select [Photo Mode] to enter photo mode.
2. Half-press the shutter button to autofocus
3. Fully press the shutter button to take the photo.



Shooting movies 🎬

1. Press the [M] button → swipe the screen → select [Video Mode] to enter video mode.
2. Half-press the shutter button to autofocus
3. Press the shutter button fully to start recording.
4. Press the shutter button again to stop recording.



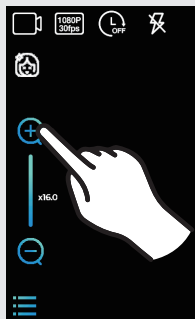

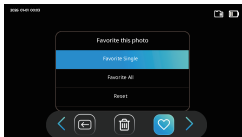
Click [➤] to view the next file, click [➤] to view the previous file.

Clicking [🖼️] will show all 12 files at once.



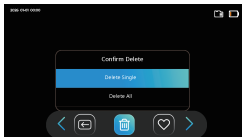
► Collect images

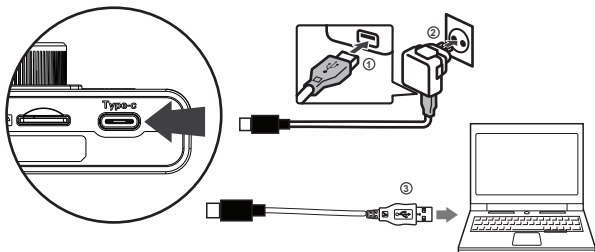


► Delete images

► Charging the battery

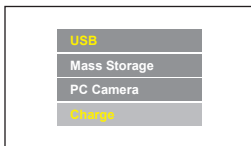
Turn off the camera while charging the battery.

1. Connect the camera to the AC Adaptor, using the dedicated USB cable(Supplied).
2. Connect the AC Adaptor to the wall outlet.
3. Connect the camera to the computer using the dedicated USB data cable to charge it.

► To charge by connecting to a computer

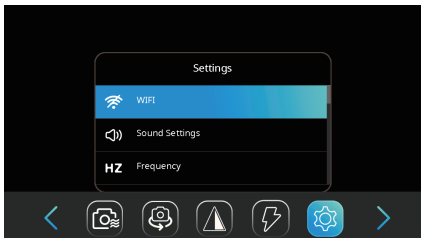
The battery can be charged by connecting the camera to a computer using the dedicated USB cable.

Connect the camera to the computer using a data cable → Briefly press the Power button to power on → Three options will appear → Select [Charge].

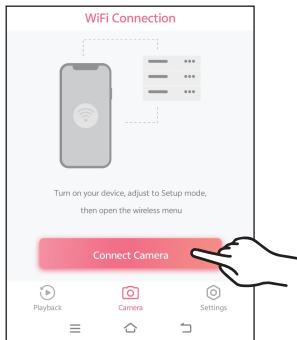
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network

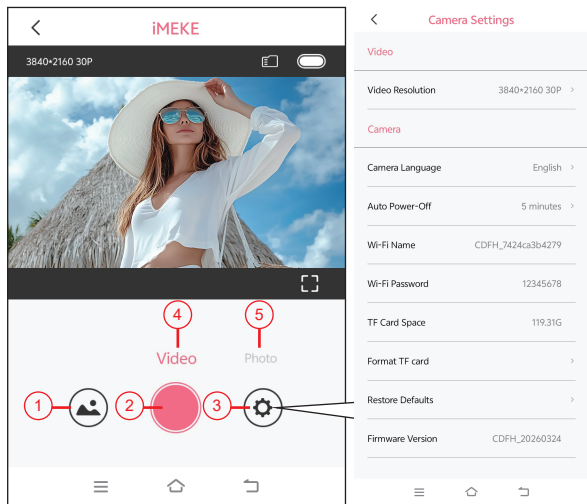
- On smartphone, select [Settings] → select [WLAN] → Select the SSID of the camcorder and enter password displayed on camcorder to connect.

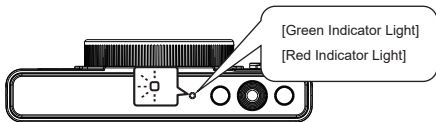

Indicator light description



1. [Operation Indicator]

The green indicator light remains constantly on after power-on; it will flash when taking photos or recording videos.

2. [Charging Indicator]

The red indicator light remains constantly on when the device is connected to the charger.

The red indicator light will gradually turn off after the battery is fully charged.

! Note: If the battery is not installed or has poor contact while charging, the charging indicator light will flash frequently.



NOTES for Using the camera

- Do not drop the camera, impact it with hard objects (such as rocks), or throw it into water.
- If moisture (such as water droplets) adheres to the exterior of the camera or the inside of the battery cover, wipe it clean immediately with a soft, dry cloth.
- If foreign objects adhere to the exterior of the camera or the inside of the battery cover, remove them immediately with a hairdryer or a soft cloth.
- Do not expose the camera to cold environments or temperatures of 40°C (104°F) or higher for extended periods.
- Do not use the camera in hot springs.

Technical Notes

Troubleshooting:

If your camera is not working as expected, please check the list of frequently asked questions below before contacting your retailer.

Question	Causes/Solutions
Camera cannot be turned on	- Battery depleted. - Battery installed incorrectly.
Camera shuts down without warning	- The camera automatically shuts off to save power (automatic shutdown function). - The camera and battery may not function properly in low temperatures. - The camera is overheating internally. Please turn off the camera and allow it to cool down before trying to turn it back on.
The monitor displays no image.	-The camera is off. -The camera automatically shuts down to save power (automatic power-off). -During this period, only one display will be on.
Camera gets hot	- The camera may get hot during prolonged use (such as filming) or in high-temperature environments; this is not a malfunction.

Compatible Memory Cards

This camera supports Micro SD (TF) memory cards.

- It is recommended to use a TF memory card with a speed rating of 6 or higher for movie recording. Using a lower speed rating memory card may cause movie recording to stop unexpectedly.
- If you are using a card reader, please ensure it is compatible with your memory card.
- Please contact the manufacturer for information on features, operation, and usage limitations.
