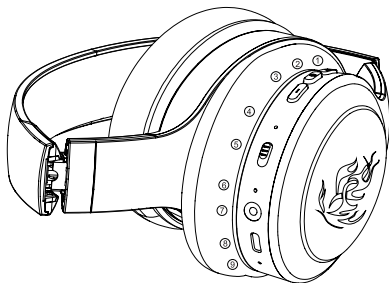

- Adopt fully sealed design and magnetic horn with strong 40mm large diameter iron alloy; it has excellent tuning after repeatable verification.

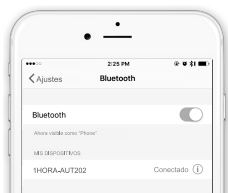
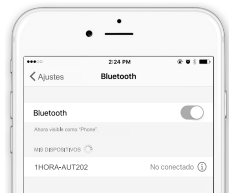


- ① Next Song / Volume Up

Pairing Your Device

The steps for pairing phones are as follows:

1. Make sure the wireless headphones have sufficient power before pairing the device.
2. Charging headphones: Connect the type c charging cable to the charging port, the indicator light shows red when charging, when the battery is full, the indicator light would disappear.
3. Turn on the headphones: turn on the power button, the indicator light flashes blue and red alternately and it enters the pairing status.
4. Search the headphones: keep the wireless headphones and the phone within 1 meter distance, turn on the phone's Bluetooth and start searching for pairing.
5. Pairing: click 'Connect' when 1HORA-AUT202 is displayed on the mobile phone; when the indicator on the headphones is blue, pairing with the device is successful.
6. After disconnecting from the connected device, turning on Bluetooth again will automatically connect to the last paired device.



Use

Power On	When the handphone is off, slide the toggle switch upwards and you will hear On, it will light up blue.
Turn Off	When the headphone is on, slide the toggle switch down and the wireless headphones will turn off.
Answer and End Calls	When there is an incoming call, the sound from the mobile phone will be heard through the headphones. To answer the call, press the "O" button once. To end the call, press the "O" button once. To reject the call, press and hold the "O" button for two seconds.
Call Back	In standby mode, press the "O" button twice to dial the last call.
Play / Pause Music	In music mode, press the "O" button once to play or pause the music.
Previous and Next Song	Press and hold the "-" button for an extended period of time to play the previous song, and press and hold the "+" button for an extended period of time to play the next song.
Volume Up and Down	Press "+" button to increase volume, press "-" button to decrease volume.
Charge Battery	Use a 5V/1A adapter to charge the headphones.
Activate Siri	Click the "O" button three times to enter the Siri function page.
Light Control and Light Off	When the device is turned on, the red, green, and blue breathing lights are turned on by default. Press and hold the "O" key once for 1 second to switch in sequence, red breathing light - green breathing light - blue breathing light - turn off the LED breathing light.
Clean the Headphones	Use a soft, clean cloth to clean, do not use any cleaning solvent.

Charging the headphones: connect the type c charging cable to the charging port, the indicator light shows red when charging, when the battery is full, the indicator light would disappear.

Problems and Solutions

• No Sound

- 1) Check if the headphone is turned on
- 2) Check if the device volume has been set to minimum or muted
- 3) Take out the 3.5mm audio cable

• Multi-function Button Issue

- 1) Check whether the mobile phone supports the Bluetooth headset control device;
- 2) Try changing players;
- 3) Play/pause operation is performed by short pressing;

• No Connection

- 1) Check if the headphone is turned on.
- 2) Observe if the indicator light on the side of the headset flashes red and blue. Otherwise, the headset has been connected to another device.
- 3) Place the headset as close to the phone as possible and try turning it on again.

•Attention to Moisture

Do not expose the headphones to rain or humid air, do not use a hair dryer or microwave to dry the device.

•Battery Safety

This device contains a built-in battery. Do not heat the battery, puncture or destroy the product.

In fire, do not expose the headphones to direct sunlight for a long time, otherwise they may melt and the battery would be damaged.

•Cable Safety

Don't damage the charging cable and 3.5mm auxiliary cable, and prevent people from stepping on, squeezing or bending severely, especially at the link between the cable and the device. Do not let children and pets bite the cable, do not pull the cable from the heat source, when disconnecting the charging cable, unplug the power plug, do not pull the cable.

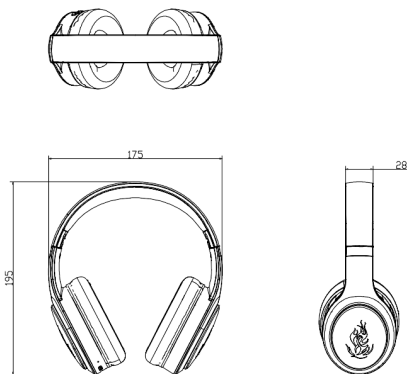
•Hearing Safety

Set the volume to appropriate level, do not excessively increase the volume, your ears have the ability to adapt after a certain period of time, so high volume sounds like normal volume, but high volume can still damage your hearing.
