User Manual

On / off

1. Turn on: Long press the multi-function key for 2 seconds to turn on.
2. Shutdown: Long press the multi-function key for 5 seconds to shutdown.

Digital Display

When power on, it will display the power level automatically.
When using, long press the multi-function key for 1 second to display the real-time power level.

Matching

1. Automatically enter the Bluetooth search state after power on (red and blue light double flash)
2. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth and click on the displayed pairing name F90 for successful pairing.

Answer calls/reject calls

1. Click the multi-function key to answer the call when it comes in.
2. Press and hold the multi-function key for 1 second to reject the call when it comes in.

Volume Adjustment

1. Long press the plus key to increase the volume.
2. Long press the minus key to decrease the volume.

Switching Songs

1. Click the minus key to switch to the previous song.
2. Click the plus button to switch to the next song.

Switch between Chinese and English

Double-click the multi-function key to switch the voice without connecting Bluetooth
(default Chinese boot)
