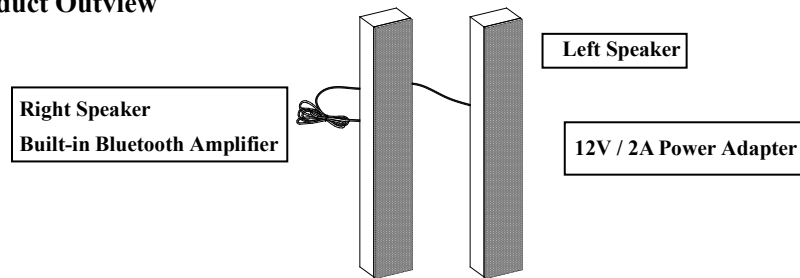

3. Installation & Operating Instructions

1. Connect the DC plug from the power adapter to the DC input jack located on the back of the right speaker.
2. Plug the power adapter into a suitable wall outlet.
3. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device, TV, or other compatible device.
4. Search for "fireplace speaker" and select it to pair.
5. Once connected, audio will play through the speaker.

4. Important Safety & Usage Notes

- This unit can only pair and connect to one Bluetooth device at a time. Disconnect the current device before pairing a new one.
- For indoor use only. Keep in a dry, well-ventilated environment.
- Use only the supplied 12 V DC power adapter. Using a higher voltage may damage the product.
