

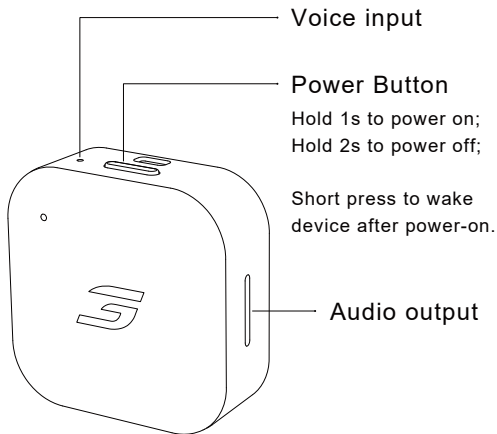

Battery: 3.8V 530mAh 2.014Wh

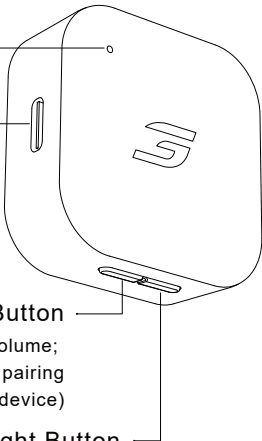
Charge: 0°C–45°C

Hold 4s: Reset Bluetooth pairing
(Auto-connects to nearest device)

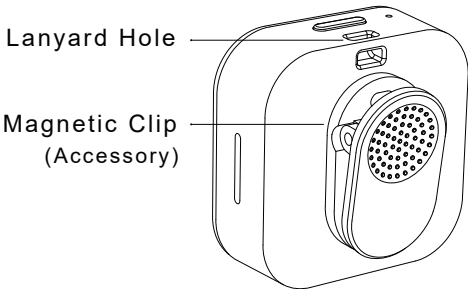
Right Button

Short press: Decrease volume;
Hold 4s: Switch Chinese/English mode
