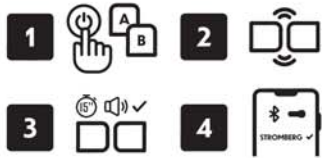

! Turn on both speakers, wait 15 seconds for them to pair together, and then connect them to your smartphone.

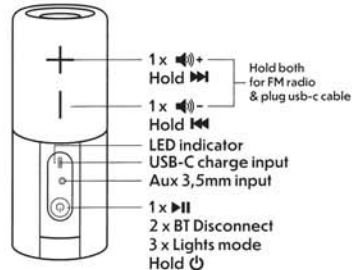


If one of the speakers isn't working:

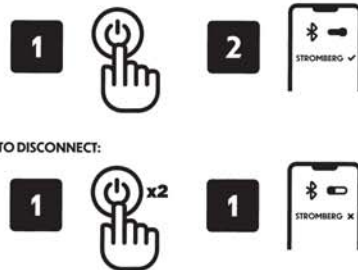
1. Turn off the Bluetooth on your phone.

CONTROL PANEL

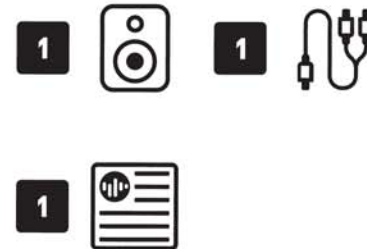
! STAND BY: Unit will turn off automatically after 5 minutes if it is not in use.
