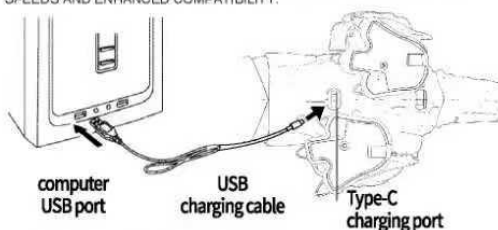


CHARGING MODE

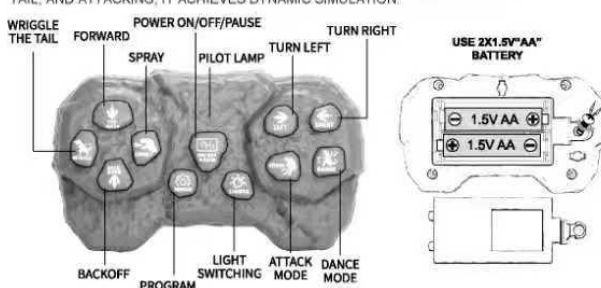
THE DINOSAUR IS EQUIPPED WITH A 3.7V 500MAH RECHARGEABLE LITHIUM BATTERY, ELIMINATING THE NEED FOR FREQUENT BATTERY REPLACEMENTS, MAKING IT MORE COST-EFFECTIVE AND CONVENIENT. THE BATTERY IS CHARGED THROUGH THE BOTTOM CHARGING PORT, WHICH IS A UNIVERSAL TYPE-C PORT, OFFERING FASTER CHARGING SPEEDS AND ENHANCED COMPATIBILITY.



SWITCH: Turn off the power and start charging
Red light: Charging
Lamp off: fully charged

REMOTE CONTROL

THE DINOSAUR REMOTE CONTROL ADOPTS A 2.4GHZ WIRELESS MODE, WITH MULTIPLE MODES THAT CAN BE SWITCHED FREELY. THE LEFT AND RIGHT HANDS ARE DIVIDED TO CONTROL THE DIRECTION, AND WHEN COMBINED WITH EACH OTHER, IT CAN CONTROL THE MOVEMENT OF DINOSAURS FREELY. COMBINED WITH BIONIC FUNCTION KEYS SUCH AS DANCING, WAGGING THE TAIL, AND ATTACKING, IT ACHIEVES DYNAMIC SIMULATION.



CAUTION

Dinosaurs use USB cable for charging. Remote control usage 2x "AA" batteries. Remove the battery cover by using a phillips/crosshead screwdriver as shown.

Install correct battery as shown in the diagram making sure to match polarity direction.

IMPORTANT BATTERY INFORMATION:

Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may explode or leak.

Do not mix old and new batteries.

Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon Zinc) or rechargeable (Nickel-cadmium) batteries.

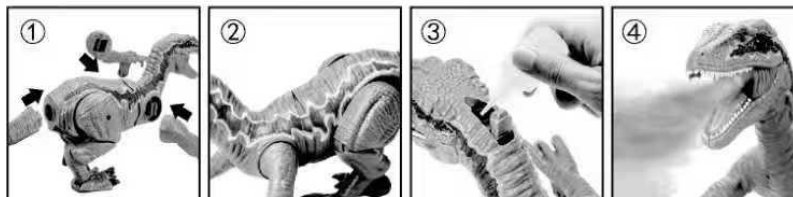
Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

Batteries should be replaced by adults because of small parts.

Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.

The supply terminals are not to be short circuited. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are not recommended.

FUNCTION



The disassembly and assembly method of dinosaurs is simple. The left and right arms can be tightly connected through buckles, and the tail is precisely combined through a rotating slot, scientifically combining to maintain a firm and safe gameplay.

Multiple LED lights are installed inside the stripes on both sides of the dinosaur's body. These LED lights switch in a variety of loop modes according to different remote control commands, accompanied by a dynamic rhythm, making them both cool and agile.

Open the water injection hole on the top of the dinosaur, fill the hole with the attached water bottle, and then use the spray function.

Dinosaur's mouth is equipped with spray and LED light, which can simulate the effect of flame spraying. The water mist particles are fine, smooth and even.
