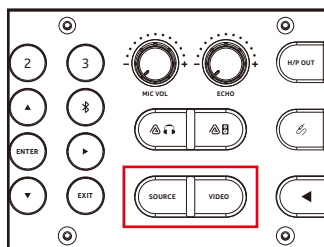
- Flip the power switch to ON to check current battery level.

SOURCE SWITCHING KEY

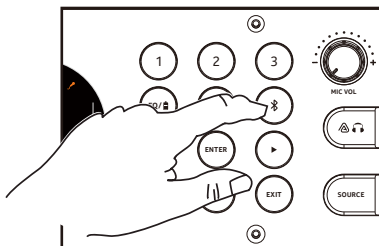
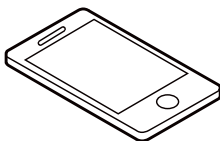
- Main unit has 4 Sources (Display/Bluetooth/Aux in/Radio) Press "Source" key on remote control to change between source DISPLAY/FM/AUX/BT sequence: DISPLAY/FM/AUX/BT
- The main unit supports 4 sources under audio mode:
 1. Display source (default source);
 2. FM source;
 3. AUX IN source;
 4. Bluetooth source.
- If Main unit is on in Display mode, it will have 4 sub-sources in Display mode. Press the video key on the unit OR press "TV"/"HDMI"/"USB" button on Remote Control to change source between "TV"/"HDMI1"/"HDMI2"/"USB"; the related source message will show on TV screen;



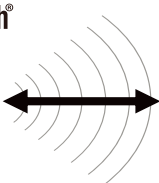
BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

Manual Bluetooth pairing

- Place speaker and Bluetooth device within 3 feet of each other.
- Make sure Bluetooth function is enabled on your device.
- Press and hold Bluetooth  button for 2 seconds to enter pairing mode. BLUE LED will flash.
- Search for Bluetooth devices on your device. Select "**MONSTER VISION 3**".

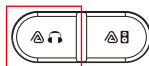
- Speaker will confirm connection with audible sound.

Using Auracast™ on Your Speaker

Auracast is a Bluetooth audio broadcasting technology that allows one device to share its audio with multiple receivers. Whether you're syncing multiple speakers for an immersive sound experience or broadcasting to headphones, Auracast makes it seamless.

How to Connect AURACAST™ (Headphone)

How to find the Main device and Secondary device



Main device (Transmitter Mode) Setup:

- Select "MONSTER VISION 3" as main device from your Bluetooth enabled audio device and paired with it.
- Press the Auracast Headphone button on the MONSTER VISION 3 to activate **Main device as Transmitter (TX)**. It has Voice prompt with "Auracast Headphone Pairing".

Secondary device (Receiving Mode) Setup:

- Power on the secondary device of Headphone equipped with standard Auracast function on Bluetooth Pairing mode and do not pair it with any other Bluetooth devices.
- Press the **Auracast** button on the Headphone to activate the Auracast function as **Secondary device as receiver (RX) and scan** for available broadcasts.

Note: Please ensure the headphone with standard Auracast function.

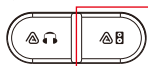
The Auracast Headphone indicator

- Search Mode: The **TX LED** and the Headphone LED  solid and other headphones equipped with standard Auracast functionality will flash or solid. (Behavior varies by model; please refer to the specific indicator light on your headphones).
- Connected Mode: The **TX LED** and the Headphone LED  solid and other headphones equipped with standard Auracast functionality will solid. (Behavior varies by model; please refer to the specific indicator light on your headphones).



How to Connect AURACAST™ (Speaker) & (TV Mode)

How to find the Main device and Secondary device



Main device (Transmitter Mode) Setup:

- Select "MONSTER VISION 3" as main device from your Bluetooth enabled audio device and paired with it.
- Press the Auracast Speaker button on the MONSTER VISION 3 to activate **Main device as Transmitter (TX)**. It has Voice prompt with "Auracast Speaker Pairing".

Secondary device (Receiving Mode) Setup:

- Power on the secondary Speaker of MONSTER VISION 3 on Bluetooth Pairing mode and do not pair it with any other Bluetooth devices.
- Press the Auracast Speaker button on the speaker to activate **Secondary speaker as receiver (RX) and scan** for available broadcasts.

TV Mode

- After powering on the device, switch to "Display" mode to play audio and video content. Briefly press the "Auracast Speaker" button to enter Auracast transmission mode. Ensure the secondary speaker is in Bluetooth pairing mode, then briefly press its "Auracast Speaker" button to enter reception mode; the audio will then be synchronized.

Note: The secondary speaker's screen remains off; it receives audio only.

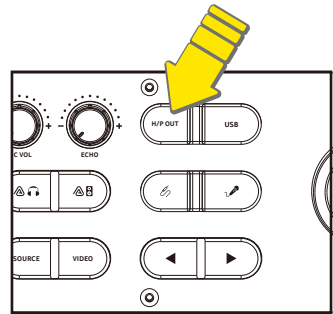
- Briefly press the "Source" button to switch between FM, USB, and AUX modes. Both the transmitting speaker and the receiving speaker will switch modes synchronously without disconnecting the Auracast link.

The Auracast Speaker indicator

- Search Mode: The **TX LED** and the Speaker LED  solid, and the RX LED is flashing, the unit is in the search mode.
- Connected Mode: The **TX LED** and the Speaker LED  solid, and the RX LED is solid, the unit is in the connect mode.

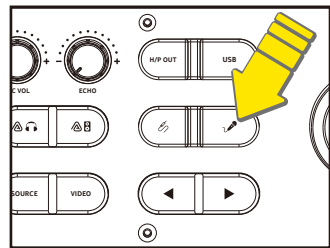
HEADPHONE OUTPUT

- In any mode, there is sound output when headphones are plugged in, and the volume is adjustable.
- When headphones are plugged in, there is no sound output from the speaker.



MIC INPUT

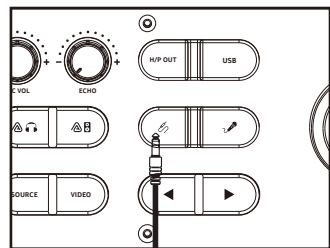
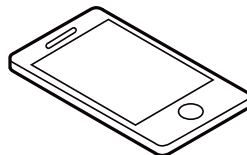
- Plug in the 1/4" audio jack plug in the MIC input for Microphone, the unit will enter into that mode (MIC), make sure the the Microphone, is on.
- You can connect any audio device that has a 1/4" audio output jack, with playback capability audio.
- Playback functions (Play, Pause, Next, Previous) can be controlled from the connected Audio device.
- Guitar not included.



Dynamic Microphone recommended

AUX INPUT

- Plug in the 3.5 mm Stereo Audio wire into the AUDIO input.
- Press the AUDIO button to change the source to AUX
- You can connect any audio device that has a 3.5mm audio output jack, and can playback and audio from the connected device.



HDMI Input when using USB Type-C Cable

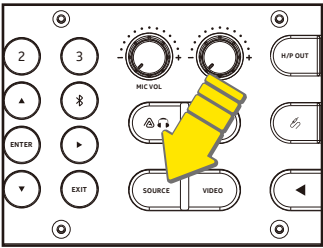

FM RADIO

Listening to FM radio

- Press the “ SOURCE ” button to select. SOURCE source, the radio station frequency will be displayed on the screen.
- Press and hold (◀ or ▶) to search a station with the strongest reception.



Store your favorite radio stations manually

- Tune to the desired radio station.
- Press and hold a number key (1-3) to enter programming mode; The corresponding number blinks on the screen; enter the stations to save on the selected preset.
- Repeat above step 1-2 to store additional stations.

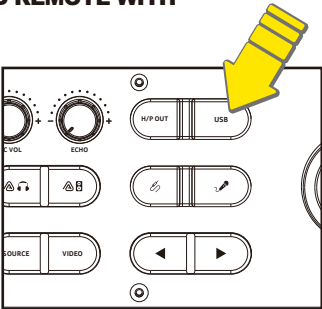

STANDBY FUNCTION

- Main unit will auto enter standby in working mode to save battery, AC charging will also power off. Only Red LED will turn on and other LED will turn off when main unit enters standby mode; Main unit will auto enter standby mode by following previous method, all LED, will turn off when main unit enters standby;
- **In Bluetooth source in working battery mode:** when BT connection fails, or disconnected for 30 minutes, the setting goes to standby mode and BT LED turns off.
- **For AUX In source in working battery mode:** main unit will auto enter standby mode when main unit is in Aux In source and no Aux cable is inserted into main unit for 30 minutes.
- **For USB source in working battery mode:** main unit will auto enter standby mode when main unit is in USB source and no music playing or pause for 30 minutes.
- **Main unit is working mode:** Press and hold the "Standby" key for 2s and it will auto enter STANDBY status.

WAKEUP FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

- **Main unit in OFF status:** Switch "Power" key from Power off to Power on will wake up main unit from standby mode; Main unit will wake up and return to the last source mode, the Power Red LED will turn off when main unit is working.
- **Main unit in STANDBY status:** Press "Standby" key and the main unit will wake up main unit from standby mode; Main unit will wake up and return to the last source mode, the Power Red LED will turn off when main unit is working.
- **Main unit in STANDBY status:** Press "Standby" key for 1s ; Main unit will wake up and returns to last source mode;
- **Main unit at STANDBY status:** Press "Power" key on Remote Control to wake up main unit from standby mode; Main unit will wake up and return to the last source mode, the Power Red LED will turn off when main unit is working.
