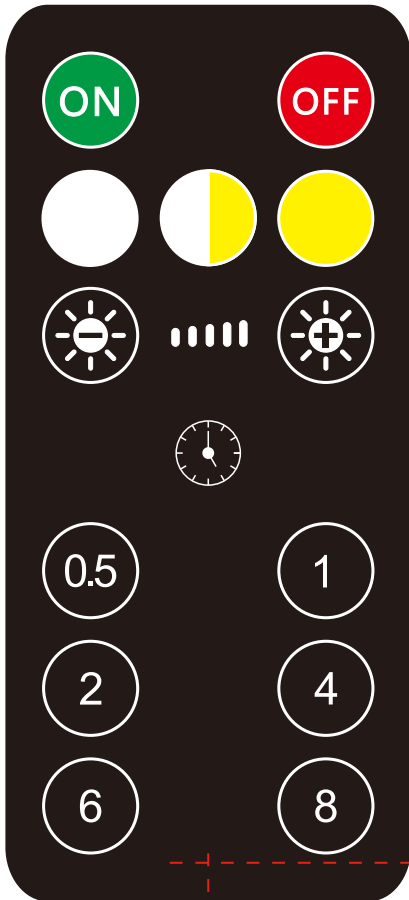
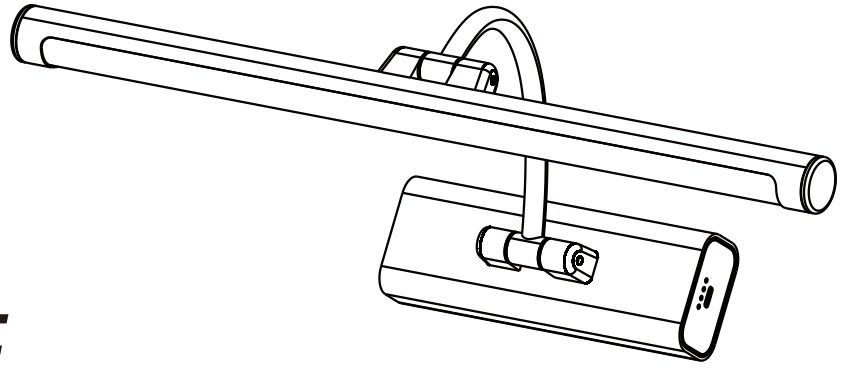

# Picture Light



## Power buttons

1. ON: Turn on the picture light.
2. OFF: Turn off the picture light.

## 3 Light Color

Cold White, Natural White, Warm White.

## Brightness Adjustment

- "+": Brightness increases from 20% to 100% in 5 levels.
- "-": Brightness decreases from 100% to 20% in 5 levels.

## Timer Function

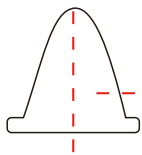
6 timer options for 0.5h, 1h, 2h, 4h, 6h, 8h.

Press to set timer, the light will flash once to confirm your selection.

## NOTE:

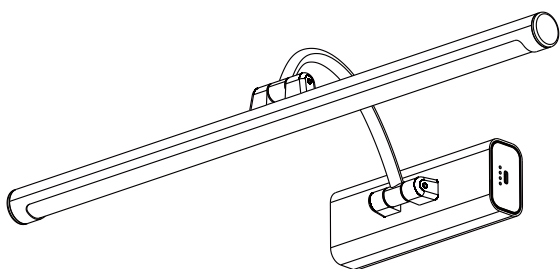
The light will auto turn off after the selected time, but will not turn on again the next day.

Slightly remove the transparent film before use the remote

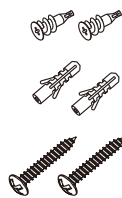

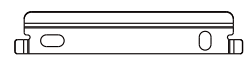




Mounting Bracket






Mounting hole distance




**Cautions**  
Please choose the right wall rivets according to different wall surfaces.



-  +  Suitable for concrete/brick walls

light mounting hole    Mounting Bracket


**Step 1**  
Mark drill points on the wall according to the mounting bracket, then drill holes.

**Step 2**  
Install the anchors to the hole.

**Step 3**  
Secure the mounting bracket to the anchors with self-tapping screws.


**Step 4**  
Align the lamp mounting holes with the mounting bracket, and slide downward until the lamp is completely locks into place.

# Angle Adjustment and Battery Pack Installation




250°    215°

Rotate axis A and Axis B to direct light precisely toward to your artwork.




Press here

**Removing the battery pack**  
Press firmly on the battery pack, it will pops out automatically. Then remove it for charging.

Insert the battery pack back into the lamp base until it locks into place. Then the light will be ready for normal use.


# Charging and Operation



Charging Indicator Light

TYPE-C port

- When charging, the blue LED indicator will flash.
- When the battery is fully charged, the blue LED indicator will stay lit continuously.



Touch Switch

- Touch and hold for 3 seconds to turn the light ON/OFF.
- Tap the switch to change the light color: Cold White, Natural White, Warm White.

**Note:** Before using the picture light, please make sure the battery is fully charged.
