Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device won't charge	Underpowered adapter / Loose cable connection	Use a PD/QC fast charge charging adapter and re-seat the cable firmly.
LED indicator blinks	Foreign object on the pad / device misaligned	Remove all metal objects, reposition the device correctly
Slow charging	Too thick case / non-fast-charge adapter	Remove the case, see a 30W+ PD/QC adapter

How to Use

- Power Connection:** Plug the included C-C cable into the charger, then connect the other end to a QC/PD compliant power adapter (30W or higher is strongly recommended for full speed).
- Charge Your Phone:** Align your Qi2/MagSafe-compatible phone with the magnetic charging pad on the upper section. It will automatically snap into place and begin charging.

Safety Precautions

* Do NOT place any metal objects (coins, keys, credit cards, metal phone rings, etc.) on the charging area. These may trigger protection mode or cause overheating.

* Use a phone case with a thickness of $\leq 2\text{mm}$. Thick or metal-containing cases may block the wireless signal and cause charging failure.

* Keep the charger away from moisture, high temperature, and humid environments. Do not expose it to water or other liquids to avoid short-circuit damage.
