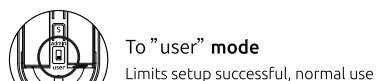
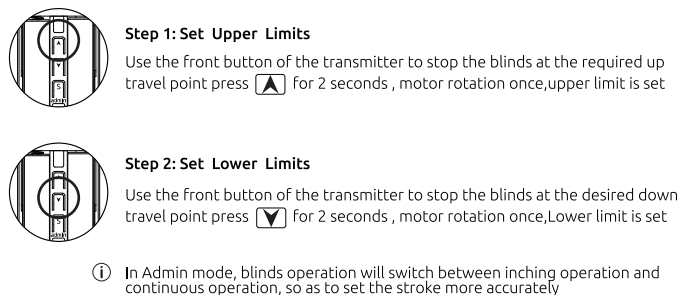
"admin" mode

2. Setting Limits

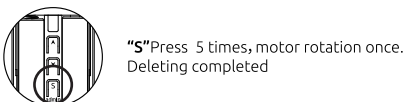


3. Motor Reversing

The running direction of the blinds is opposite to that of the transmitter button.



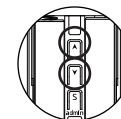
4. Delete Remote Control Matches

The user can proceed normally, Operation and use, will not be wrong operation of the motor

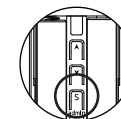
1. Favorite Point



2. Add A New Remote Control

Normally, Remote control A controls the motor, Remote control B also needs to control.

Method 1



Press the S key once, The motor rotates once

Method 2

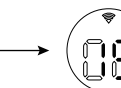
Remote Control B, "Quick matching"

3. Remote Control Lock Channel

One channel of transmitter controls one motor, and 15 channels control up to 15 motors. For example, the 15 channel transmitter only uses 1-5 channels, the remaining 6-15 channels are not used and can be hidden without display

① Remote control access channel selection

Press and hold two channel switch keys at the same time Remote Control display, "L" appears first, then "15" words appear, then release the key



② Use channel switch button

Select channels to keep

③ Using the Remote Control stop key

Confirm the channel to be reserved



① Reserved channels can only be counted from channel 1. For example, 1-5. No support for 3-7. Repeat the operation to adjust the final required number of channels.

4. Motor Speed Regulation

The running speed of the motor is three gears in total, and the default is gear 1. Slower and quieter



Both Hold Until the motor jog up one gear



Both Hold Until the motor jog reduced by one gear

Only one gear can be raised or lowered in one operation. When switching to the corresponding gear, the number of motor rotation is the same as that of the gear
