

# HS-999 Audio AI SMART GLASSES

User Manual



## How to Turn ON/OFF

Boot operation instructions: Turn on the glasses legs and turn on the machine automatically  
Indicator light: white and green light flashing slowly  
Voice prompt (default English)"Power on"



Shutdown operation instructions: Close glasses legs  
Indicator light: White light is always on for 1S  
Voice prompt (default English)"Power off"



## How to enter pairing status

Pairing operation instructions: The left and right temples will be paired automatically after being turned on  
Indicator light:After the left and right temples are successfully paired, the indicator light on one temple goes out, and the indicator light on the other temple shows green and white flashing  
Voice prompt Pairing/connected



After booting and pairing successfully, turn on the mobile phone's Bluetooth and search for the Bluetooth device name: "HS-999" Click to connect, accompanied by a voice prompt "Connected". After the mobile phone is connected, the product indicator light goes out.

## How to disconnect

Operating instructions: Disconnect the phone  
Indicator light: green and white light flashes  
Voice prompt "Disconnected"



## Play music

Click on the left/right touch area and hear the voice prompt "dudu"



Previous: Double-click the left touch area  
Next song: Double click on the right touch area  
Pause: Click on the left/right touch area

## Control the volume increase



Press and hold the right touch area for 2 seconds, and a "dudu" sound will be heard when the volume reaches the maximum

## Control volume reduction



Long press and hold the left touch area for 2s

## Arouse Mobile Assistant (SIRI)

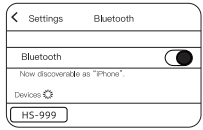
Operation instructions: Three clicks on any headphone touch area  
Voice prompt: "dudu" sound  
The touch area is on the back of the charging point

## Automatic callback

Operation instructions: After the machine is turned off and restarted, Bluetooth will automatically connect back to Bluetooth  
Voice prompt: Connected  
Disconnect at a long distance, return to within 10 meters within 1 minute, and connect back to Bluetooth  
Voice prompt: "Disconnect"



## Mobile phone battery display/volume display

Bluetooth is connected to Bluetooth, and the phone has a battery display. (Playing status)  
Machine volume is synchronized with mobile phone volume

## No connection or disconnection of Bluetooth

Automatic shutdown in 5 minutes/error within 30 seconds, and a prompt tone of "Disconnect"

## Answer/End



Click on left/right ear

## Rejecting the incoming call



Long press left/right ear 3S

## End of life

Check on your mobile phone that when the battery power connected to the Bluetooth smart glasses is less than 20%, it will prompt you to charge the Bluetooth smart glasses for low battery/an alarm will be prompted at 3-minute intervals.

The magnetic charging cable is connected to the left and right temple charging columns respectively for charging.

The white indicator light is always on when fully charged
