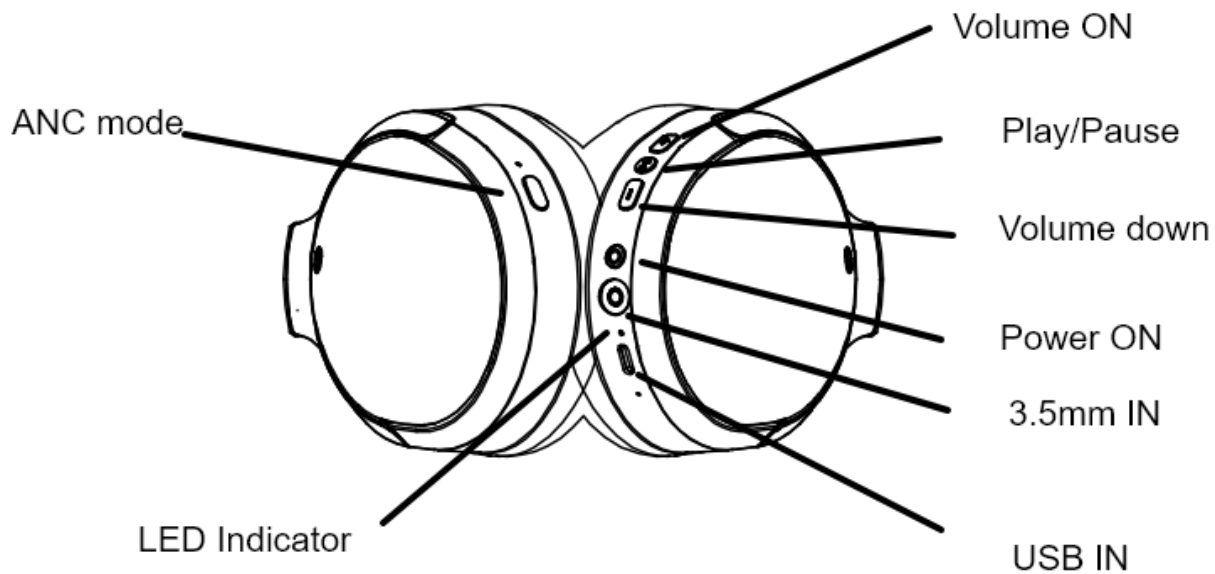


FIIO F4001E instruction manual

Interface and Function Description



Play/Pause Button

Play/Pause Music

Single press to switch between play and pause

Voice Assistant

Press and hold 3 seconds to activate the voice assistant

Answer / Reject / End Call / Call Transfer

Incoming call answer: A short press of the button answers the call

Incoming call rejection: Press and hold for 2 seconds reject the call

Incoming call end: Press and hold for 2 seconds ends the ongoing call

Call switching: Double-press to switch between calls

Pairing and Unpairing

Pairing

After the first power-on, the device automatically enters pairing mode, and the blue indicator light flashes continuously

After successful connection, when powered on again, the device will enter auto-reconnection mode and automatically connect to the previously paired device

With the device powered off, press and hold the Power button for 5 seconds without releasing it, until the voice prompt "Pairing" is heard and the blue LED flashes continuously

Unpairing

While the device is powered on, press and hold the Volume + and Volume - buttons for 5 seconds until the voice prompt "pairing" and blue LED flashed continuously, this means the pairing has been cleared successfully

Volume + and Volume - Buttons

Volume up:

Short press once to increase the volume by 1 level

Next track:

Press and hold the Volume + button for 2 seconds to skip to the next track

Volume down:

Short press once to decrease the volume by 1 level

Previous track:

Press and hold the Volume - button for 2 seconds to skip to the previous track

LED Indicator Status Descriptions

LED Indicator

Power On/Off: The white LED flashes three times.

Bluetooth Pairing: The blue LED flashes.

Low Battery: The red LED flashes.

Charging: The red LED remains solid.

Fully Charged: The blue LED remains solid.

3.5mm Aux Input: The green LED illuminates.

Bluetooth Codec Indication:

SBC: Blue

AAC: Cyan

LDAC: White

Multipoint Connection

After the connecting F4001E to the first device, disconnect the Bluetooth connection to enter pairing mode. The manually search for "FIIO F4001E" on the second device and connect to it. Once successfully connected, reconnect to the first device via Bluetooth.
