

INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARING FOR INSTALLATION

1. Remove keyboard protective sheet and cable from inside the case.



INSERTING YOUR IPAD INTO THE CASE

1. Firmly press the left-hand side corners of the iPad into the left corners of the case.
2. Firmly press the right-hand side corners of the iPad into the right corners of the case.
3. Ensure all four corners are firmly in position, and the edge of the case fits smoothly around the front outer edge of the iPad, the device is installed correctly into the case.



REMOVING YOUR IPAD FROM THE CASE

1. Release the top right corner of the iPad by firmly pushing the corner of the case back and away from the iPad.
2. Release the bottom right corner of the iPad by firmly pushing the corner of the case away from the iPad.
3. The iPad will be easy to remove once the top and bottom right corners are released from the case.

CHARGING THE KEYBOARD

Insert one end of the USB-C cable (included) into a power source (not included) and the other end into the port on the right side of the keyboard. The red light will illuminate while charging, and will switch to green when fully charged. When the cable is disconnected from the keyboard or power, the green light will turn off immediately.

TURNING THE KEYBOARD ON AND OFF

Once the keyboard is charged, it can be turned on and off using the toggle switch that is located on the right side of the keyboard, next to the charging port.

Off = toggle towards the iPad

On = toggle away from the iPad

The keyboard will automatically enter sleep mode when the iPad screen is off or after 30 minutes of inactivity. To wake the keyboard, press any key (excluding the Fn key).

PAIRING YOUR KEYBOARD WITH YOUR IPAD

The Dux Guard Bluetooth Keyboard links to your iPad via a Bluetooth connection. The Keyboard must be charged first before pairing. The first time you use the keyboard case, it must be paired with your iPad.

ON THE KEYBOARD:

- Turn the keyboard on, making sure that the on/off toggle is switched away from the iPad.
- Press and hold the Fn key and the C key at the same time, until the blue light next to the charging port flashes. When this happens, the keyboard is "discoverable" by the iPad.

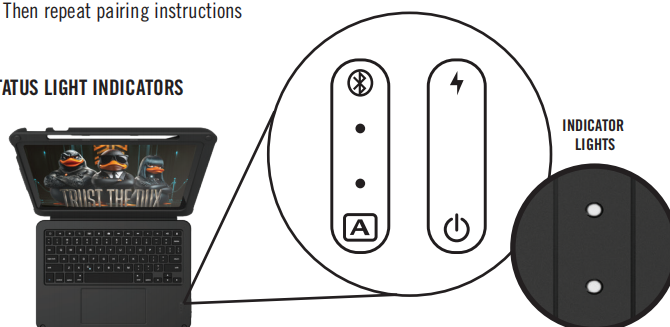
ON THE IPAD:

- Go to Settings/Bluetooth/toggle > On
- Select "Dux keyboard BT" from the Devices menu.

IF PAIRING IS NOT SUCCESSFUL

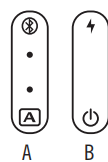
- Go to iPad Settings/Bluetooth/toggle > Off, then On again to reset iPad Bluetooth.
- Then repeat pairing instructions

STATUS LIGHT INDICATORS



Your Dux Guard Keyboard includes status lights that provide information about the power and connection.

A - *Bluetooth shares light indicator with Power

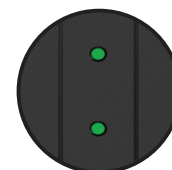
B - *Power shares light indicator with Bluetooth

BATTERY POWER CAPACITY INDICATOR

For battery power capacity indicator press Fn and Control simultaneously.

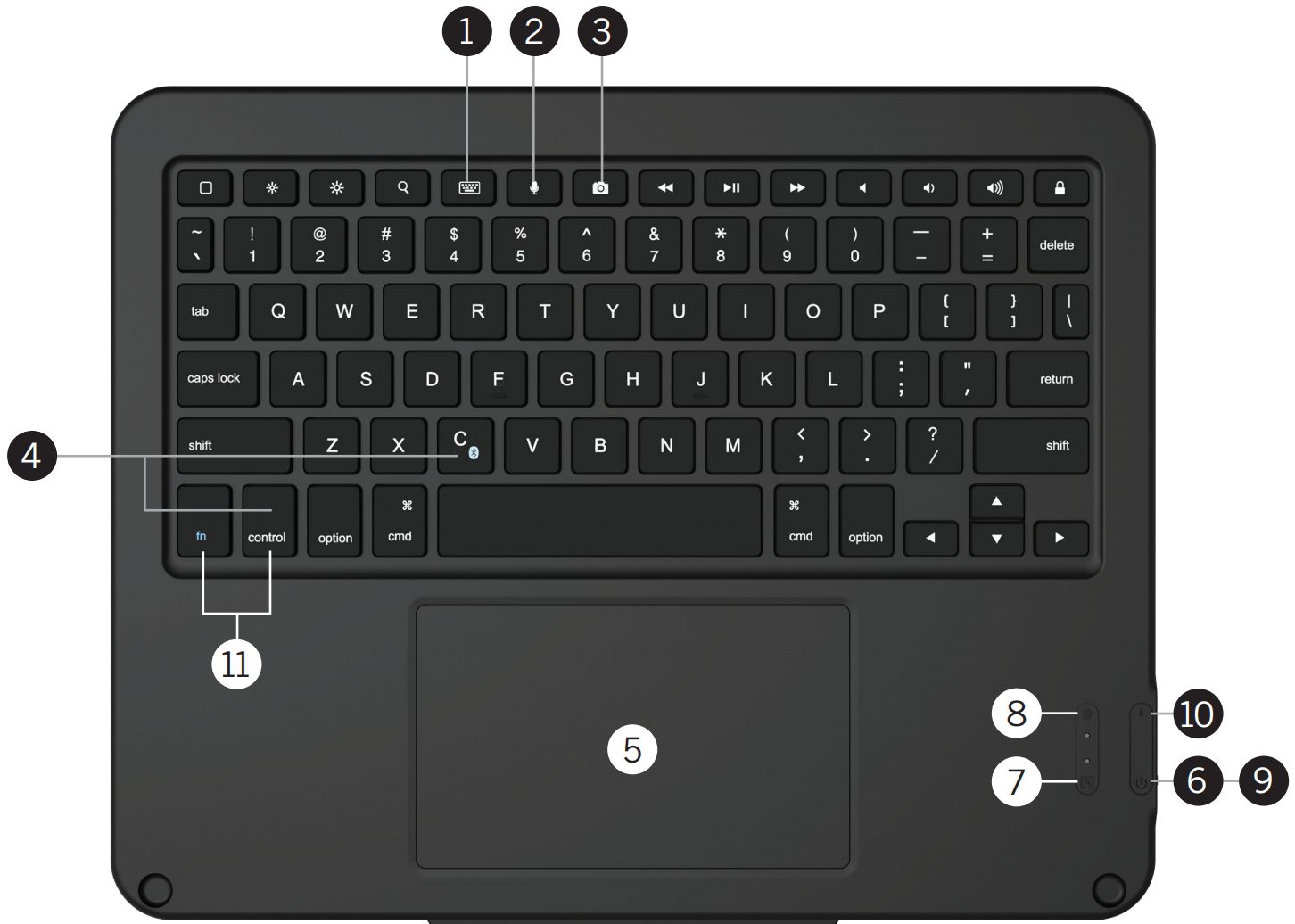
Green light flash	1 time	≤25% of battery capacity
Green light flash	2 times	25%~50% battery capacity
Green light flash	3 times	50%~75% battery capacity
Green light flash	4 times	75%~100% battery capacity

- 1 Keyboard Shortcut**
Displays or hides the on-screen iPad keyboard.
- 2 Siri Shortcut**
Activates the Siri voice assistant.
- 3 Camera Shortcut**
Captures a screenshot of the iPad screen.
- 4 Bluetooth Pairing**
Press and hold Fn + C until the blue light flashes to enter pairing mode (keyboard becomes discoverable).
- 5 Trackpad**
Supports clicking, swiping, zooming, and scrolling for intuitive navigation.
- 6 Keyboard Power Switch**
Towards iPad – Power off
Away from iPad – Power on
- 7 CAPS Indicator Light**
Solid green – Caps Lock is active
- 8 Bluetooth Indicator Light**
Flashing blue – Bluetooth pairing mode (discoverable)
- 9 Power Indicator Light (Shared with Bluetooth Indicator Light)**
Solid red – Charging
Flashing red – Low battery
Solid green – Fully charged
- 10 USB-C Charging Port**
Convenient, easy-access charging port.
- 11 Battery Status Check**
Press Fn + Control to view battery level status.
