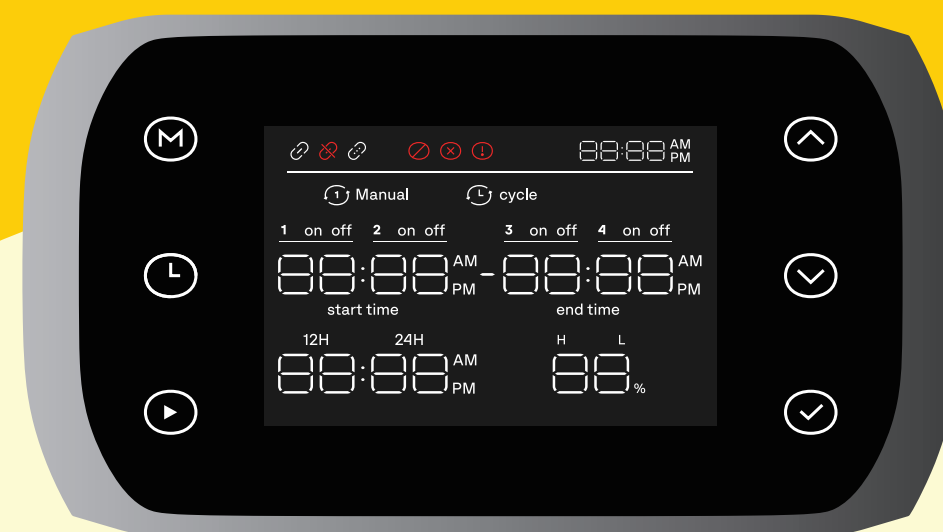

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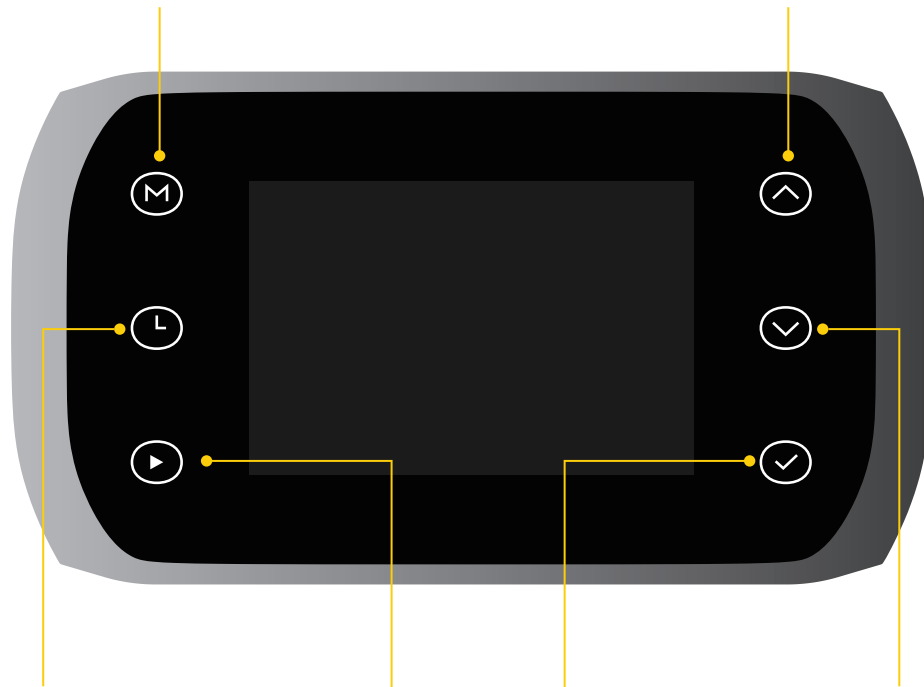


Mode Button:

Short press to switch between Manual/Auto mode.
Long press to pair.

Up button:

Short press to increase by 1 digit.
Long press to increase digits rapidly.



Long press to set system time.

Down button:

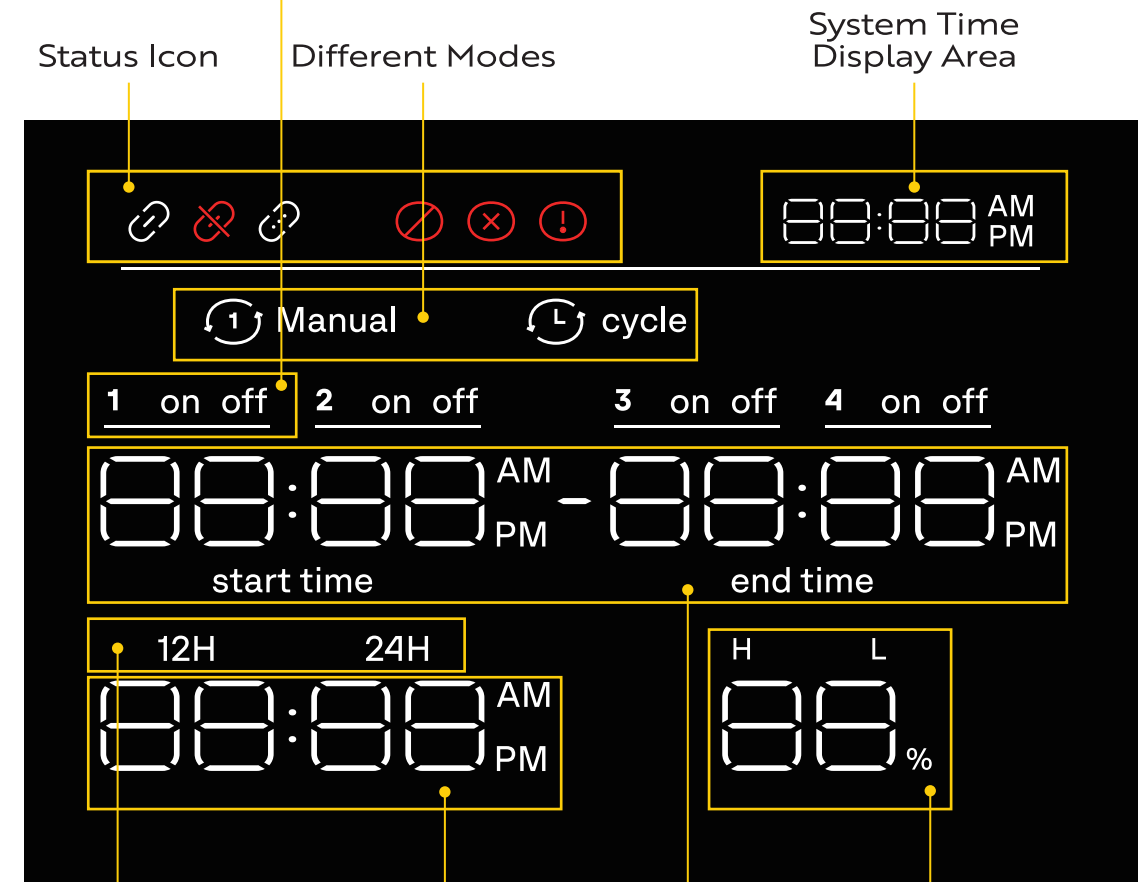
Short press to decrease by 1 digit.
Long press to decrease digits rapidly.

Pause/Start the pump

Confirm button:

Short press to confirm.
Long press to activate/deactivate a mode.

Use the Up/Down buttons  to enable or disable this time period.

Note:

This icon has the following two meanings:

1. Incorrect 115V/230V voltage wiring, motor cannot start.
2. The voltage fluctuation is abnormal, but the motor can still start, until the voltage completely exceeds the range in which the motor can start.

Solution: Connect to a normal voltage. Once the motor is running normally, the voltage abnormality indicator will disappear.



Stalled

STALL Icon Indicates:

1. **Impeller Jammed** – Debris like sand, leaves, or hair may be stuck. Turn off the pump, disassemble the housing, and clean the impeller
2. **Water in Motor** – If the pump leaks and water enters the motor, rust can cause failure. If under warranty, contact VIVOHOME for replacement parts.

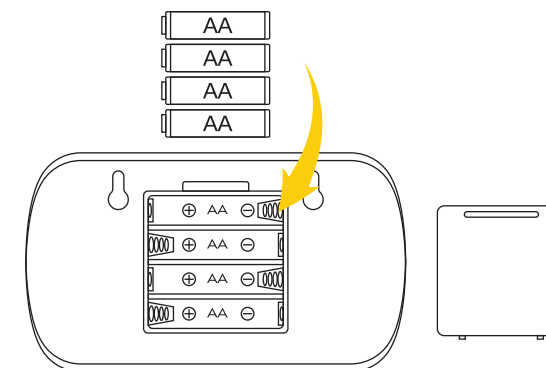

**1: Insert 4 AA batteries****Note:**

AA batteries are not included and need to be prepared on your own.

**2: Auto Pairing on Power-On**

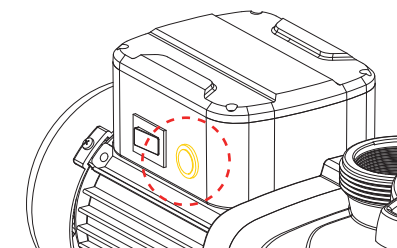
Pairing successful, display shows .

Long press the Mode button to retry pairing.

**Note:**

Press and hold the metal button on the pump for 5 seconds. After hearing a sound, press and hold the mode button on the remote control for 5 seconds within one minute to begin pairing.



3: Set the system time

Long press the Time button  to set the system time.

Use the Up/Down buttons  to select 12H/24H mode.

Press the Up/Down buttons  and the Confirm button  to set the numbers.

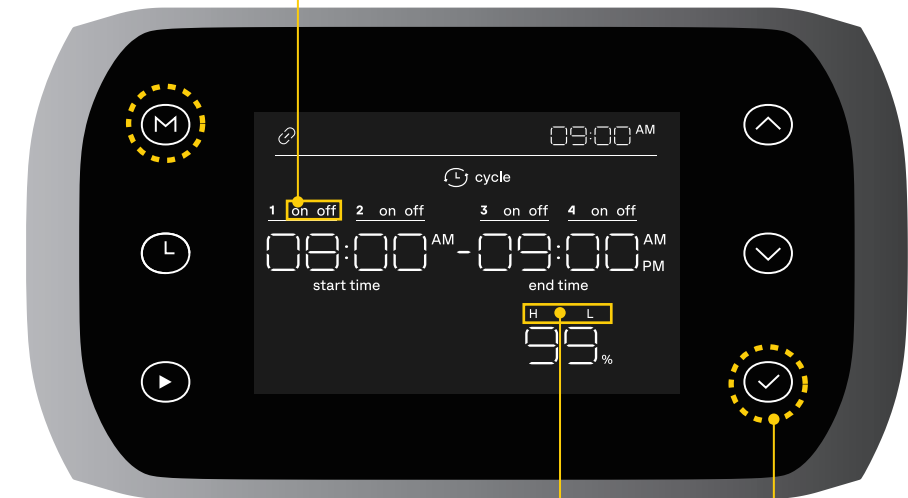

4: Set the cycle mode

Press the Mode button  briefly to switch to cycle mode settings. There are four time periods in total. After confirming each time period, proceed to confirm the speed.

Use the Up/Down button  to select to turn on/off this time period.



Use the Up/Down buttons  to switch between high and low speed.

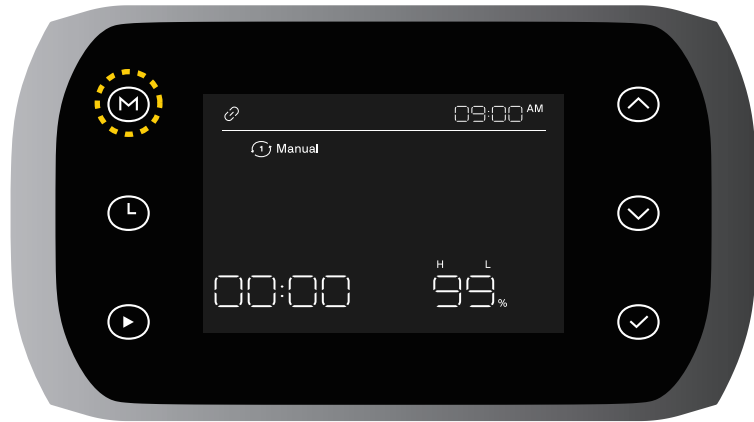
Short press the Confirm button to confirm.

Note:

- If no operation is performed within 10 seconds, the system will exit the settings mode and return to the main interface.
- By default, the pool pump runs at high speed for the first 10 minutes to start smoothly. After that, it will work according to your settings.

5: Set Manual Mode (Countdown Mode)

Short press the Mode button **M** to switch to Manual Mode settings.
The time range for Manual Mode is 1 minute to 24 hours.



6: Turn on/off a mode

The icon will blink once the mode is activated

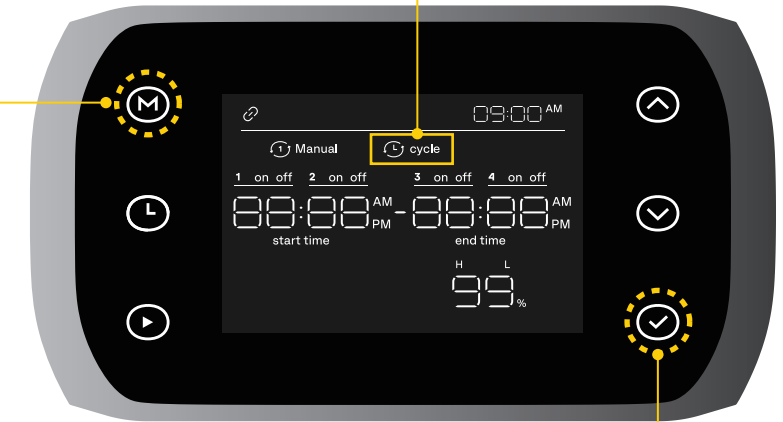
Step 1: Switch to this mode.

Note:

Manual mode overrides Cycle mode when both are active. It will automatically return to Cycle mode once Manual mode ends.

7: Pause/Activate the pump



Same function as the pause button on the pump.
