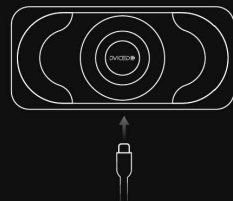

Connect a power adapter of no lower than 45W into the socket, and connect it to the device with the Type-C charging cable.



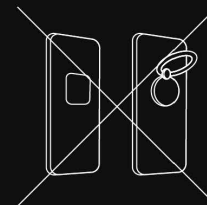
Attach the device to your phone so that the magnetic parts align.

- Do not block the air outlet to avoid affecting the charging and cooling effect

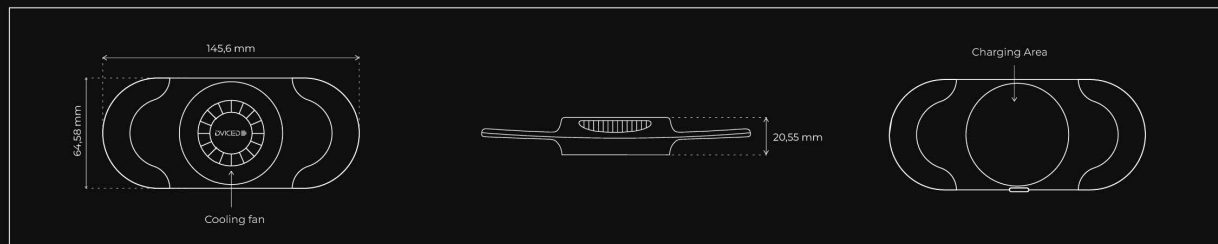
