Safety Usage Precautions and Maintenance

• **Usage Environment:** Avoid humid, high-temperature, dusty, and strong magnetic environments.

• **Cleaning Method:** After disconnecting, wipe with a soft cloth lightly dampened with a neutral cleaner. Do not rinse directly with water.

• **Placement:** Position on a stable tabletop, avoiding drops and impacts.

• **Electrical Safety:** Do not disassemble by yourself, prevent liquids from entering, and avoid short circuits.

■ Connection

Wireless 2.4G:
Open the keyboard and press Fn+. The 2.4G code indicator is green (blinking three times in about one second). Insert the adaptor into the USB interface of the device and you can use it.

Bluetooth 1:
Open the keyboard, long press Fn+ for 3 seconds, Bluetooth pairing indicator light on blue light (flash), open the device Bluetooth name, click to connect.

Bluetooth 2:
Open the keyboard, long press Fn+ for 3 seconds, Bluetooth pairing indicator light is Red (flash), open the device Bluetooth search name, click to connect.

Note:
1. Switch channel: Press the FN key briefly the channel corresponding .
2. 2.4G mode 20S is not paired and enters the sleep state, and Bluetooth mode 120S is not paired and enters the sleep state. Press the corresponding channel when you pair it again.

With the FN lock off: Pressing a key alone activates its F1-F12 function.
With the FN lock on: Pressing a key alone activates its multimedia function.

TROUBLESHOOTING

• **The keyboard is unable to input.**

Solution: Check whether the connection is secure; for wireless keyboards, please verify the power supply and battery level; reinsert the receiver or restart the keyboard.

• **The wireless keyboard connection is unstable or experiences delays.**

Solution: Move the receiver to the front USB port of the computer, away from USB 3.0 devices (blue ports) and wireless routers; ensure there are no obstacles between the keyboard and the receiver.

• **Some of the keys are not functioning properly.**

Solution: Attempt testing on other computers or software; check for any physical damage or foreign objects lodged; use compressed air to clean beneath the keycaps.

• **The computer is unable to recognize the Bluetooth keyboard.**

Solution: Ensure that the keyboard is in pairing mode; delete the records of previously paired devices on the computer and re-pair; restart both the keyboard and the computer's Bluetooth.

■ Power saving sleeping mode

When the keyboard does not have any operation instructions within 30 minutes, it will automatically enter the sleep mode. When you need to use it, you only need to press any key , the keyboard will wake up and the keyboard can work normally.

■ Charging

When the battery power is low, the power indicator flashes red, the voltage is lower than 3.4V and the low battery indicator alarms, and the light flashes once every 2 seconds. At this time, please charge the keyboard:
Step 1: Connect the B end of the original USB cable to the keyboard charging port.
Step 2: Connect the A end of the USB cable to the power adapter or the USB interface of the computer.
Step 3: When charging, the charging indicator light turns red, and the green light turns green when fully charged.

Noted:
1) For longer battery life, charge the keyboard only when the keyboard power light is blinking.
2) The original power cord must be used for charging under working conditions. If other data cables are used to charge during work, garbled characters and functional failures may occur.
