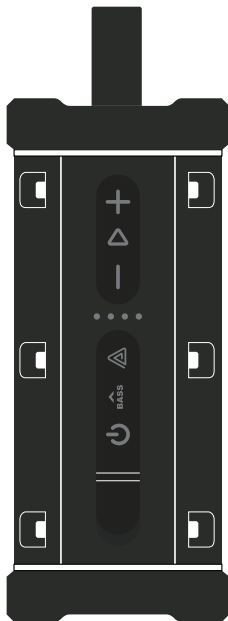
USB-C Cable

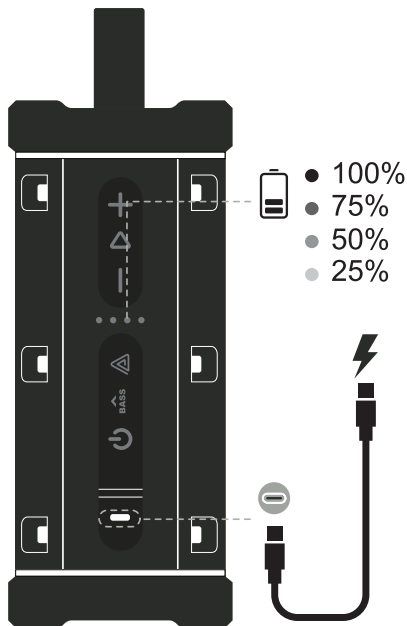


- Long press the "  " button to turn on the speaker. Bluetooth pairing mode activates automatically, indicated by a flashing blue light.
- On your mobile device, go to **Settings**→**Bluetooth**
- Select **MAGX** from the list of available devices
- When connected, you will hear a confirmation sound

Note:

- 1.If the conneted Bluetooth device cannot be located, long press the "  " button to disconnect the active connection.
- 2.The speaker will automatically power off if not used for about 20mins.

Battery & Charging



Checking Battery Level

Short press the Power button to check the current battery level

- A full charge is indicated by four bars

Charging

- Charge the speaker using the included USB-C cable
- A power adapter with an output of 20W or higher is recommended
- Supports USB-C PD fast charging up to 30W.
- Full charging time is approximately 3 hours (12–15V / 2A)

Charging Status Indicator

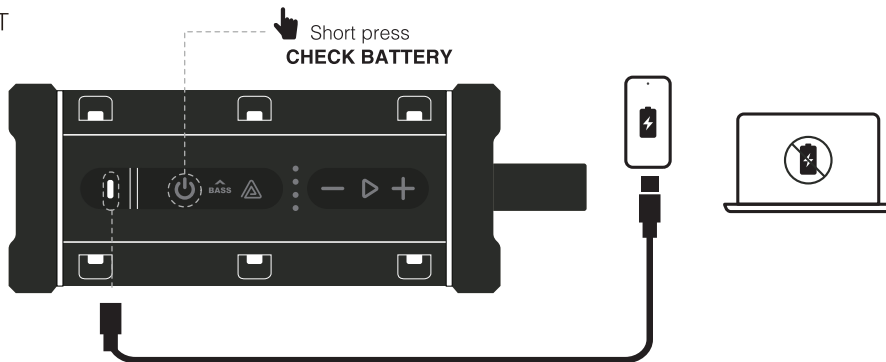
One blue indicator flashing: Charging in progress
Four indicators solid on: Fully charged

Note: When speaker battery is low, it will issue a sound prompt and the volume will automatically decrease, pls charge the speaker with the included USB-C power cable.

Power Bank Function



PD 30W OUT



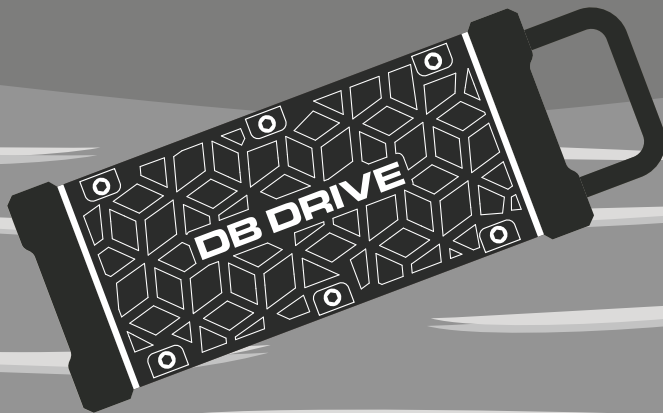
The speaker supports reverse charging, which allows it to supply power to other devices (such as smartphones or tablets):

- Use a compatible USB-C data cable to connect the speaker and the device.
- The white indicator will flash during charging

Ensure the speaker's battery level is at least 20% to maintain reverse charging efficiency

Note: Please don't supply power to large electronic devices (such as computers).

Waterproof Dustproof IP68



Important:

Ensure the charging port is fully closed before exposure to water

Do not charge the speaker while it is wet or submerged

Waterproof performance may decrease over time due to wear and tear

Magnet Mount



MAGNETIC MOUNT

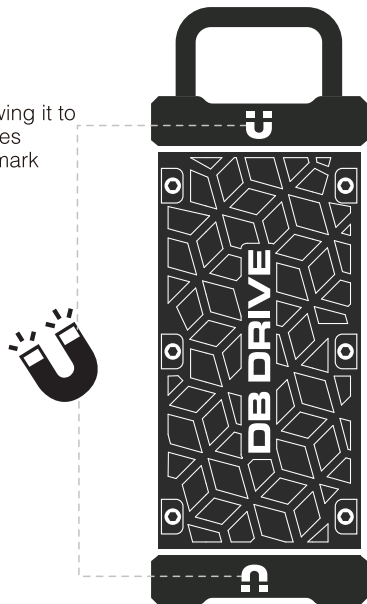
The speaker features a built-in magnetic mounting surface on one side, allowing it to securely attach to suitable metal surfaces or compatible magnetic accessories. Each magnetic position is marked with a smiley face icon, with a U-shaped mark underneath for easy identification.

Magnetic Strength & Function

Equipped with a high-strength magnetic system
Enables quick and convenient attachment to flat metal surfaces
Provides stable positioning during normal use

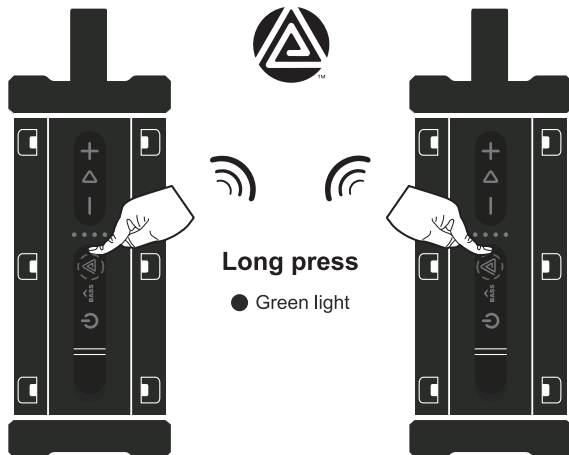
Usage Notes

- Keep the magnetic surface away from magnetically sensitive items such as credit cards, magnetic cards, or data storage devices
- Ensure the contact surface is clean, dry and flat to maintain optimal magnetic adhesion
- The magnetic mount is intended for surface attachment only
- Do not use it for hanging or load-bearing purposes
- Magnetic performance may vary depending on surface material, thickness, and environmental conditions



True Wireless Stereo

TWS



STEPS

1. Power on both MAGX speakers.
2. Press and hold the “” button on both speakers for about 3 seconds to active TWS and enter into TWS mode.
The speaker will have a sound to remind. When TWS pairing is successful, the “” button indicator will remain blue or flash blue, this speaker will act as primary speaker (left channel), the “” button indicator will remain solid green, it's as the secondary speaker(right channel).
3. To disconnect from TWS mode, short press the “” button on either of MAGX speaker, and a sound prompt will notify you of the disconnection

TWS connection notes:

1. After TWS paired, the “” button and “” button indicators will turn off automatically after about 1 minute, please press any key to reactivate the indicators light if need.
2. If power on the two MAGX at BT mode next time, they will TWS paired automatically.
3. Place the left and right speakers in the corresponding positions to enjoy true stereo sound.

Multi-Speaker Connection

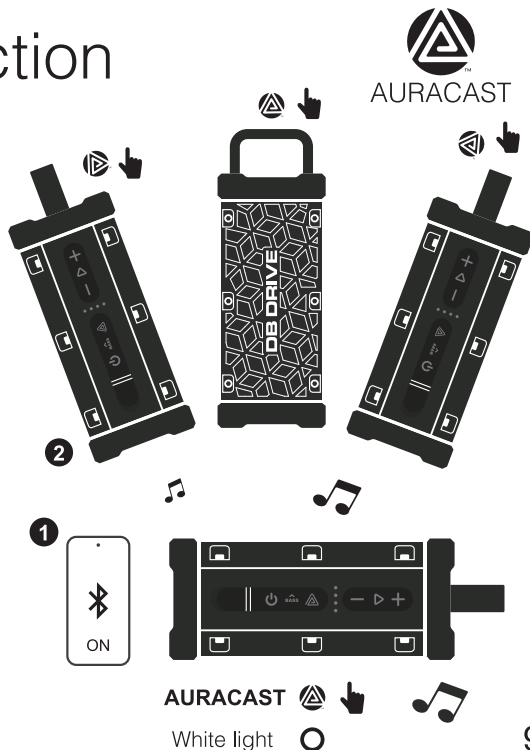
STEPS

1. Power on multiple MAGX speakers.
2. Connect your mobile device to one of the speakers.
3. Short press the "  " button on this speaker to activate Auracast mode.
4. The "  " button indicator will remain solid white. This speaker will act as the primary speaker.
5. Short press the "  " button on each additional speaker one by one to complete pairing.

When pairing is successful, the indicator lights on all connected speakers will remain solid white.

Note

- Auracast technology allows audio to be broadcast to multiple speakers simultaneously.
- Supports connection of up to 100 speakers
- Ideal for parties and outdoor gatherings



IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

- To maintain optimal battery performance, fully charge the speaker at least once every three months when not in regular use.
- Battery life may vary depending on usage patterns and environmental conditions.
- Do not expose the speaker to liquids while the charging port is open or while charging.
- Charging in wet conditions may result in permanent damage to the speaker
- Salt water, chlorinated pool water and other chemicals may damage waterproof seals or internal components.
- After exposure to such substances, rinse the speaker with clean water, dry it thoroughly and ensure the charging port is completely dry before charging.
- Do not charge the speaker until it is completely dry and clean.
- Charging while moisture is present may cause damage to the speaker or battery
- When using an external power adapter, ensure it complies with USB-C PD standards.
- Use of non-certified or incompatible chargers may result in damage.
