• Assembly



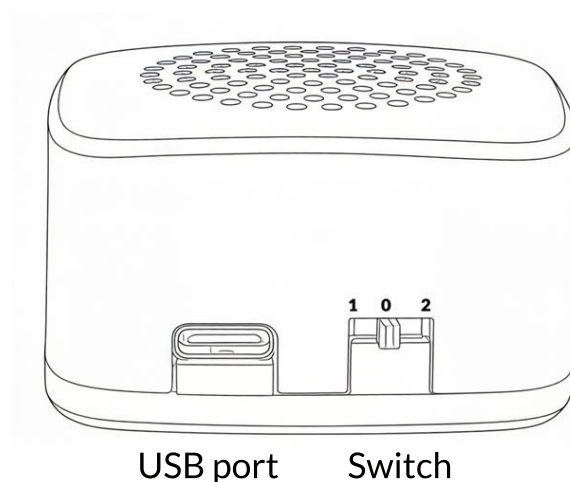
• Hang the music box on the Christmas tree with a hook.

• Product dimensions



• Connect the music box power adapter to the plug of tree stand.

• Function



- **Turn to 1 :** The music box will play ten built-in Christmas songs in a loop. The playback volume of the song is fixed and cannot be adjusted. The song list is as follows:

1. We Wish You a Merry Christmas
2. Jingle Bells
3. Silent Night
4. Joy to the World
5. Hark! The Herald Angels Sing

6. The First Noel
7. Away in a Manger
8. Deck the Halls
9. Go, Tell It on the Mountain
10. The Twelve Days of Christmas

- **Turn to 2 :** Turn on Bluetooth connection mode for the music box. After hearing the prompt sound, use your phone's Bluetooth to search for and connect to a device named "**Stand**" to start playing music from your phone. You can control the volume of the music box through the volume button on your phone.

- **Turn to 0 :** Power off.

• Remark

1. There is no lithium battery inside the music box, and there is no charging function. It can only be used when connected to a power source.
2. When the music box is used together with the tree stand, the adapter of the music box can only be connected to the plug of the tree stand for use.
