I. Product Application Scope

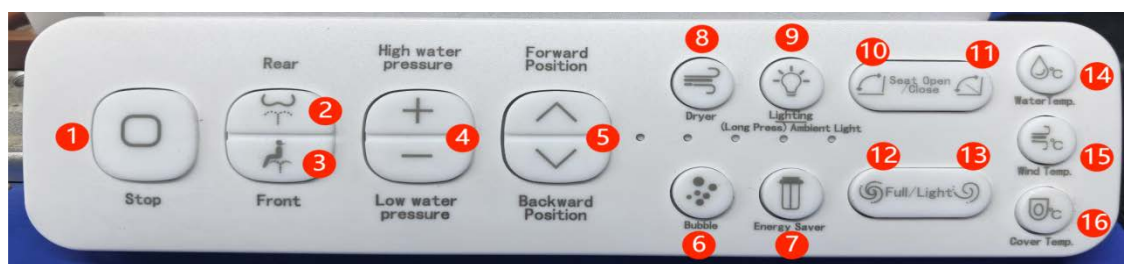
This product is applicable to integrated smart toilets and smart toilet seats.

II. Product Operating Conditions

1. Operating Environment: This product is required to be used in an environment free of dust and corrosive air.
2. Operating Temperature Range: Ambient temperature 0°C~40°C
3. Operating Humidity Range: Ambient humidity $\leq$ 95%RH (no condensation)
4. Storage Temperature Range: -10°C~50°C

III. Product Characteristics

1. Operating Voltage: 3.0V (DC)



1.	Stop button Press and hold to stop function Long press to enter standby / power on
2.	Buttocks wash button Press the buttocks to clean them
3.	Female wash button Press the female wash button
4.	Water pressure +/- button Press +/- to adjust water pressure for cleaning
5.	Position Button Tap to adjust the cleaning position
6.	Press the bubble button to start foaming.
7.	Press the energy-saving button to switch on/off energy-saving mode.
8.	Drying button Press to activate warm air drying
9.	Night light button for pressing switch on/off the night light
10.	Flip cover button Press to open/close the seat cover open/close button
11.	Flip ring button Press to open/close the seat ring
12.	Press the "Dai Chong" button Press and hold to start the flushing and fully discharge the water volume
13.	Press the "Big Flush" button Press and hold to start the flushing with half the water volume
14.	Water temperature button Press and hold to start adjusting water temperature
15.	Wind temperature button Press again to start adjusting the wind temperature
16.	Seat temperature button Press again to start adjusting the water temperature Seat
