

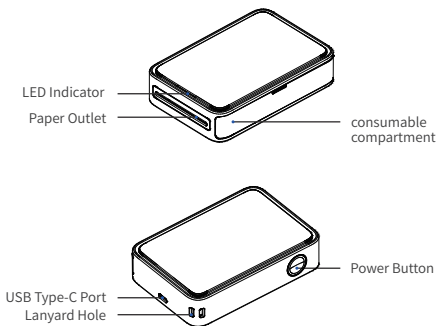

3 Charging status

Status	Indicator Light Status
Charging in progress	Flashing green (slow)
Fully charged (powered on)	Solid green
Fully charged (powered off)	Solid green (until the USB-C cable is unplugged)

 Flashing red (slow) indicator indicates the temperature is outside the safe range for charging. Recommended charging temperature: 0°C to 45°C.

Consumable Installation Instructions

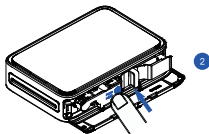
Open the consumable compartment.

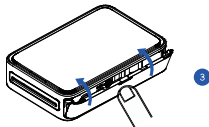
Insert the consumable.

Take out a consumable, put it into the compartment according to the direction shown below, place your finger in the "Push" position and press it into place until it makes a "click" sound;

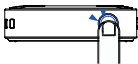
Close the consumable compartment.



1. The photo paper is susceptible to moisture, please use it as soon as possible after opening.
2. This device only supports official photo paper that comes with the ribbon, please do not replace it by yourself.
3. Avoid excessive direct sunlight and low temperature.
4. If the consumable is damaged or deformed by external force, please do not insert it into the device by force.

Printing Instructions

- 1 Long press the power button until the indicator light turns on, then release. The device will power on.



- 2 Scan the QR code to download the "HeyPhoto" APP.

- 3 Open APP, click "Add Device", Search for "PIX22-XXXX" and click to connect.



- 4 In the app, select the photos you want to print. You can also edit the photos as needed before printing.



-  1. After the first connection, you just need to click the print icon for subsequent use, the printer will be automatically connected and print.
2. Do not exit the APP during the printing process, this may cause printing failure.

Precautions

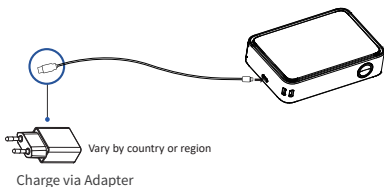
1. The best working temperature of the printer is 5°C~35°C.
If the ambient temperature is too high, the printing quality may be affected;
2. Please use official ribbon and photo paper to ensure print quality;
3. Avoid disassembling the ribbon and photo paper by yourself.
If the glossy surface of the photo paper is contaminated, the print quality will be affected;
4. Do not pull out the consumable forcibly during printing, this may damage the printer;
5. When not in use for a long time, close the consumable compartment to keep things like dust out;
6. After printing multiple photos in a row, the device may activate overtemperature protection, which is normal, and the current task will continue to be printed after cooling;
7. Do not perform any operations while the device is turning on.

Operating Environment

1. Place the printer on a desktop or other flat, stable surface;
2. Please make sure that there is more than 10cm space in the paper outlet of the printer.

Battery Charging

1. When the printer battery is low, please charge it promptly using the provided USB Type-C cable. Continuing to print may cause the printer to shut down automatically.
2. Connect one end of the USB Type-C cable to the printer's USB port and the other end to a power adapter. The printer will begin charging once connected.
3. Under ambient temperature conditions, a full charge takes approximately 90–120 minutes.



- ⚠** 1. The printer can be charged via a computer or an adapter using a USB cable. Please note that the adapter is not equipped with the printer. Users who use power adapters for charging should purchase and use power adapters that are certified for safety and meet the requirements of the standard.
2. Users are prohibited from disassembling the machine themselves. Replacing the battery with the wrong model may result in an explosion. Please be sure to dispose of the used battery according to the instructions.
3. When the printer is low on power, charge it for a while before use to prevent printing interruptions.
- WARNING:** Operating this device may cause radio interference in a residential environment.
