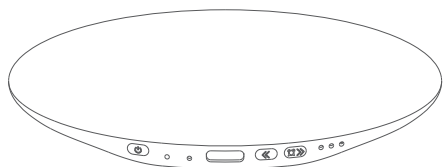

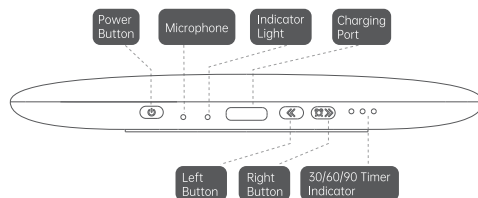


Charging Cable

Basic Operations

- Power On:** Press and hold the Power Button for 2 seconds.
Power Off: Press and hold the Power Button for 5 seconds.

Switch Mode

- Press the Power Button twice to switch between Bluetooth and Sleep Mode.

Music Controls

- Play / Pause:** Press the Power Button once.
 Volume Down: Press the Left Button once.
 Volume Up: Press the Right Button once.
 Previous Track: Press the Left Button twice.
 Next Track: Press the Right Button twice.

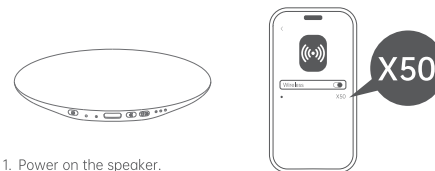
Hands-free Calls

- Answer / End Call:** Press the Power Button once.
Reject Call: Press and hold the Power Button for 2 seconds.

Timer Settings

- Set Timer:** Press and hold the Right Button for 2 seconds.
