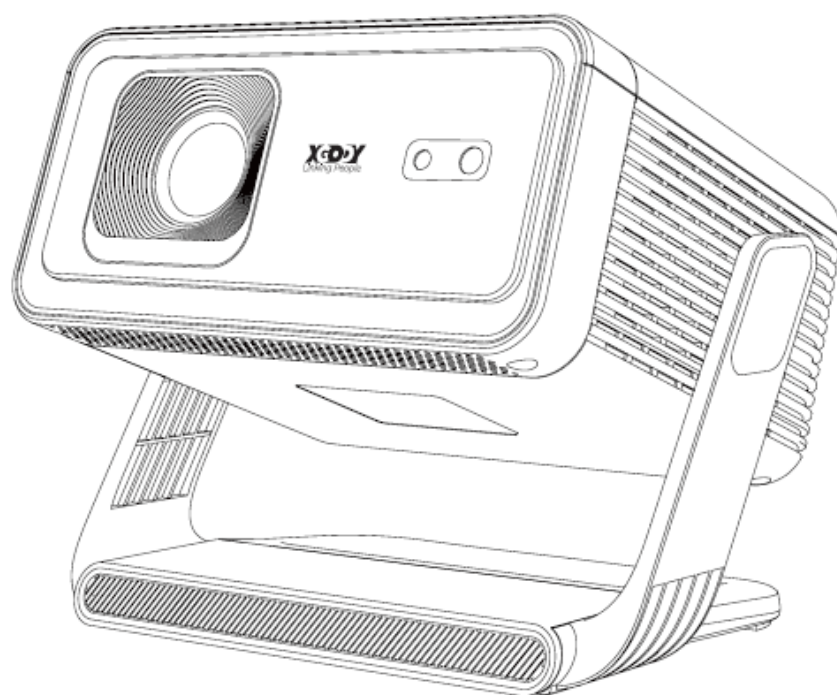

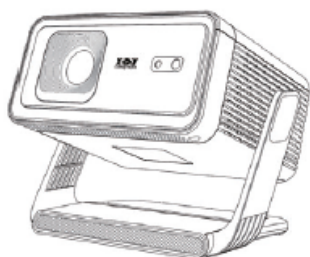
Please read this manual carefully before use and keep it for future reference.

	Non-professionals are forbidden to disassemble the projector for testing and maintenance

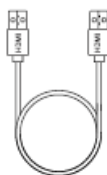

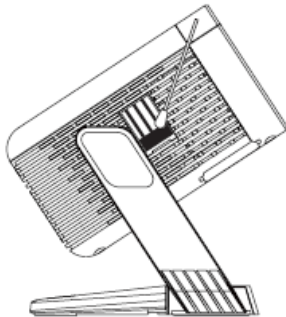
Blurry Images

Click Settings - Projection Settings, open Auto Focus to adjust the image clarity. Press the focus button on remote control to get the best clarity.

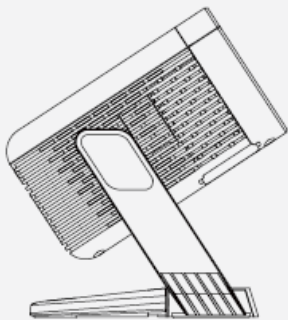
Cleaning Method



- ① Use your hand or another tool to pry the dust cover upward.

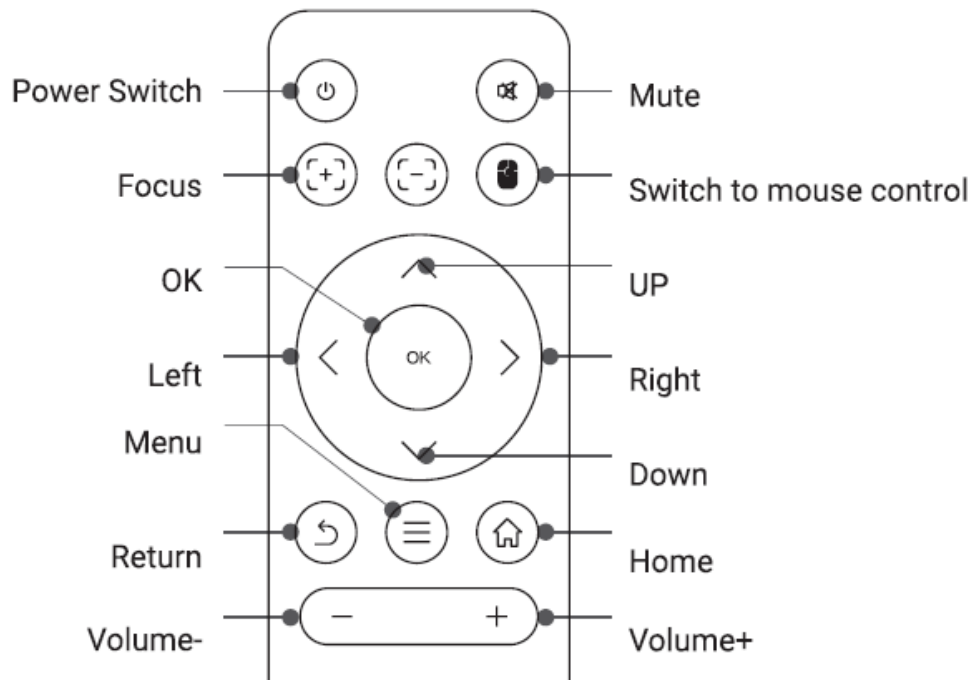


- ② Clean the projector by the Cotton swab.



- ③ Reinstall the bottom cover after cleaning.

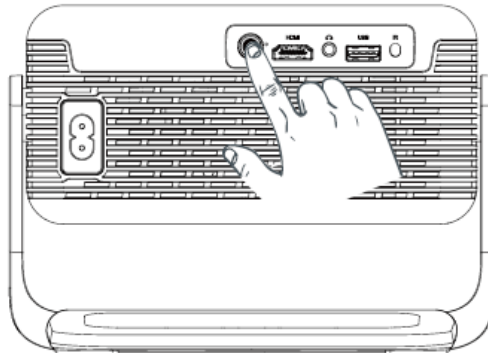
Remote Control



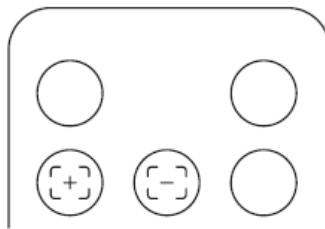
Attention:

1. Do not submerge the remote control in the water.
2. Do not put the remote control near fire or in wet or hot places.
3. Do not use old and new batteries together in there mote control.
4. Please take the batteries out if not using the remote control for a long time to avoid battery leakage.
5. Please point the remote control toward the IR receiver.
6. Please use the remote control within 6 meters distance and 30 degree angle.

Getting Started



- ① Plug the power cable to the projector.
- ② Press power button to turn on the projector.



Use the manual focus by pressing the "Focus" button on the remote control.

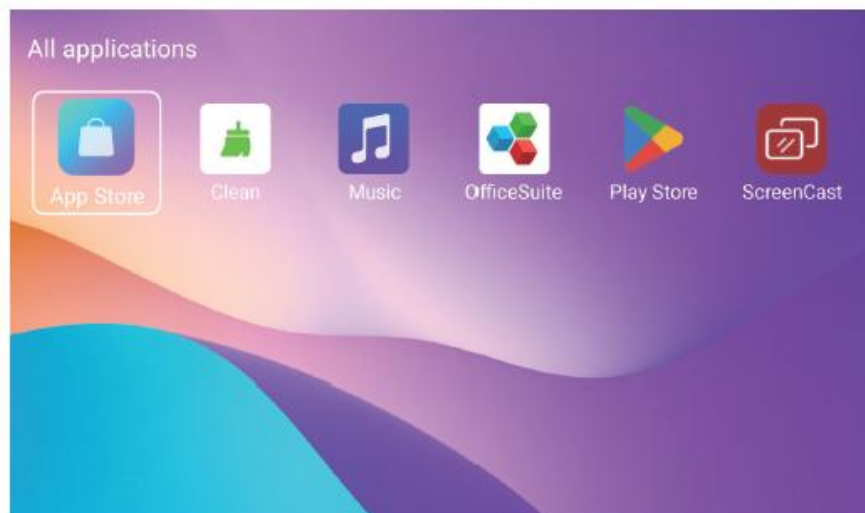
TIPS: Make sure the projector is horizontal to the projector screen.

- ⚙️ Click on apps  icon to view installed applications, click application icon to switch between applications. All Apps' can be clearly distinguished from the icons.



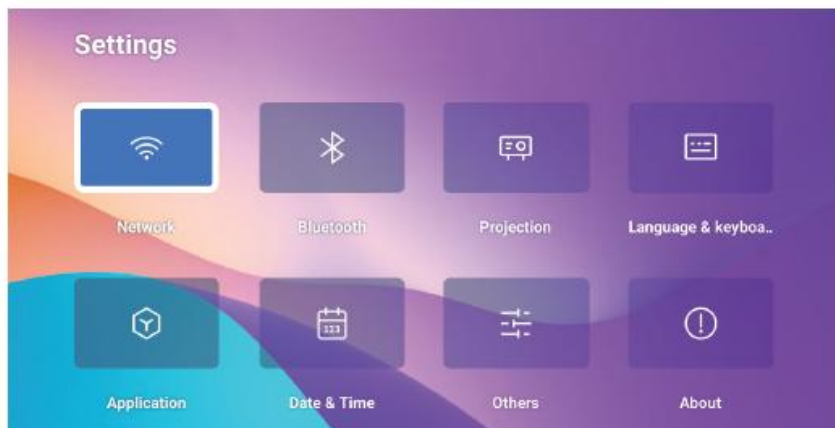
App Store

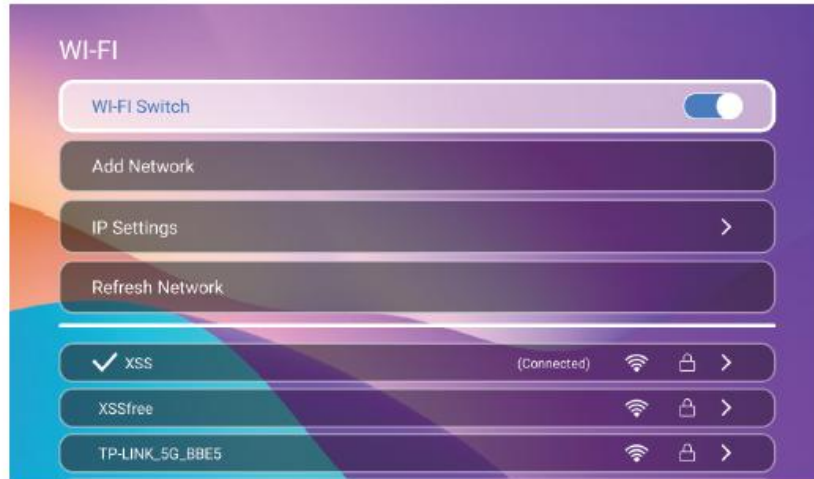
Settings

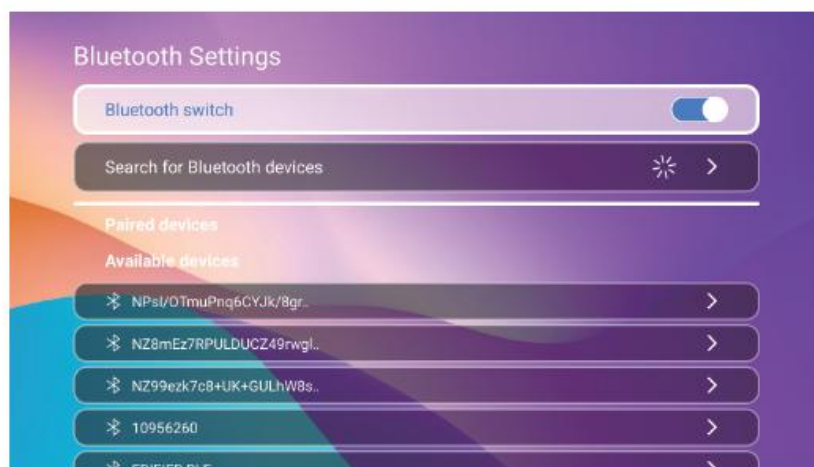
Networking Settings

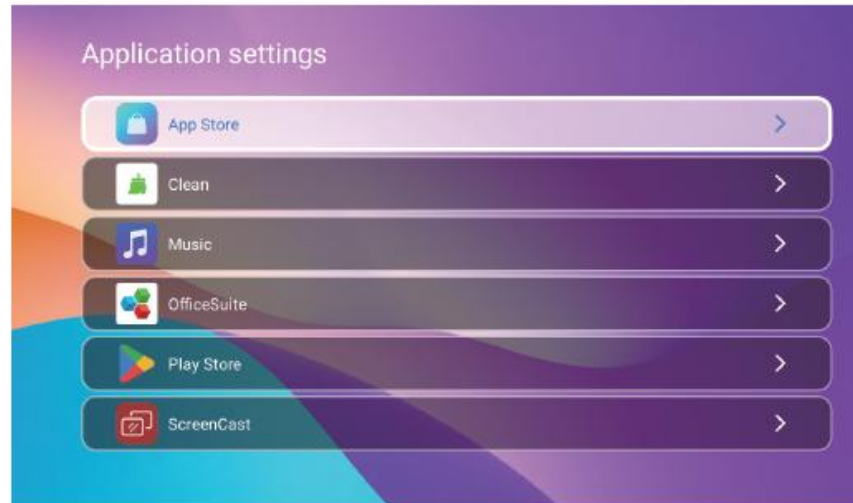
Language and keyboard

- ⌘ Settings - Language and keyboard, enter to setup language and select input keyboard.



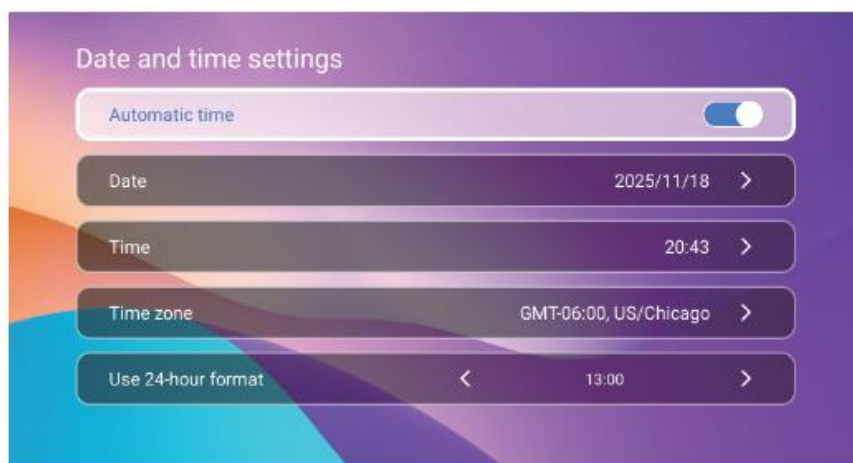
Application Settings

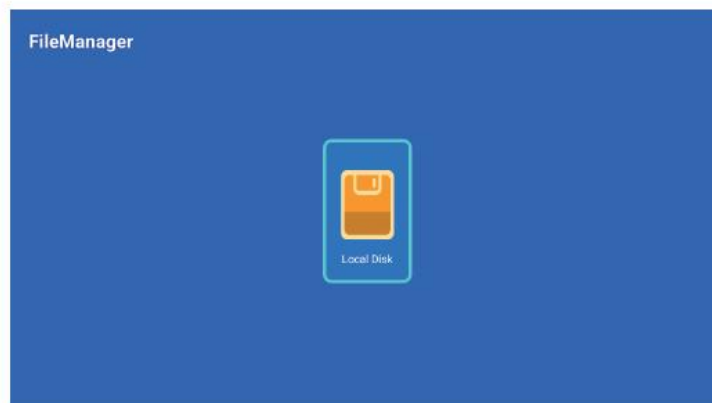
