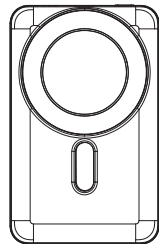

Light indication: Upon low-battery power-off, there's no out put and the lights are out.

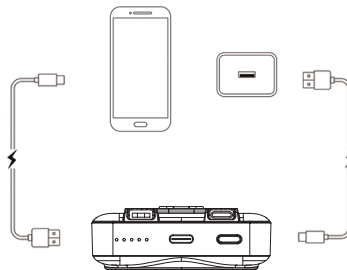

Warnings

- If the battery is not replaced properly, there will be a risk of explosion, if it is replaced with the wrong model of battery pack, there will be a risk of fire or explosion, and it can only be replaced with the same type or equivalent type of battery.
- The battery must not be exposed to environments such as sunlight, fire roasting, or similar excessive heat.

- The battery should not be disassembled, impacted, squeezed or thrown into the fire. Do not continue to use if severe bulge occurs, Do not place in a high temperature environment. It is forbidden to use it after immersion.
- When using, it should be placed in a place that is easy to dissipate heat, and should not be placed at the head of the bed, on the bedding, in the package or other environments that are not easy to dissipate heat.

- Do not short circuit the positive and negative electrodes of the input or output of the product, To avoid fire from equipment or external objects.

- If the voltage of the charger does not match, it will cause the power bank to be overloaded, causing smoke, fire and other dangers.
- Please unplug the charger after each full charge of the power bank.
- If the power bank has abnormal conditions such as odor, heat, discoloration, deformation, night leakage and other abnormalities during use; Please deactivate it immediately.
- The product should be placed on the desktop when used, and the contact time should be less than 10s if it needs to be used in contact with the human body.

- If the skin gets on the battery liquid, wash it immediately with tap water and seek medical attention promptly.

- Dispose of it properly when disposed of.
