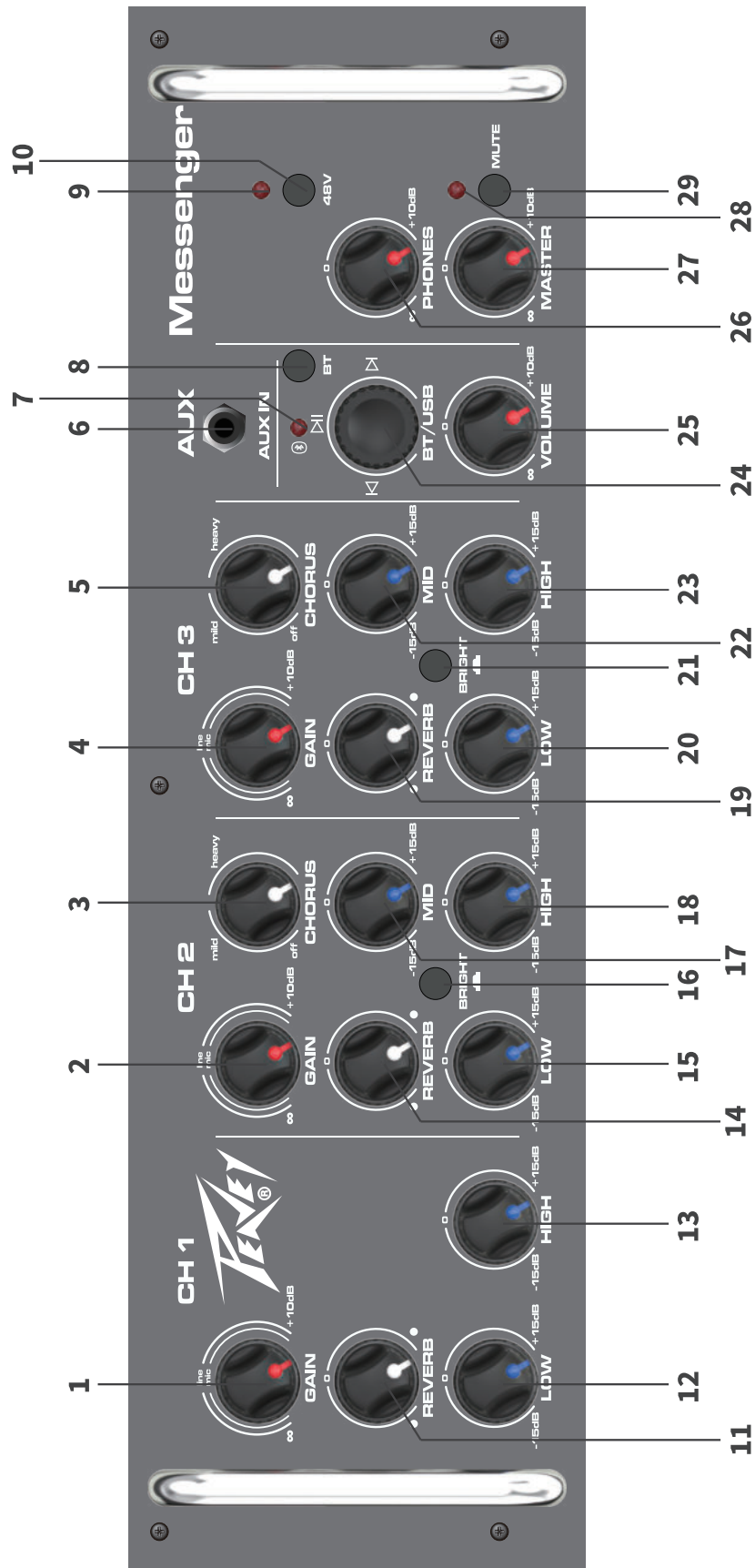

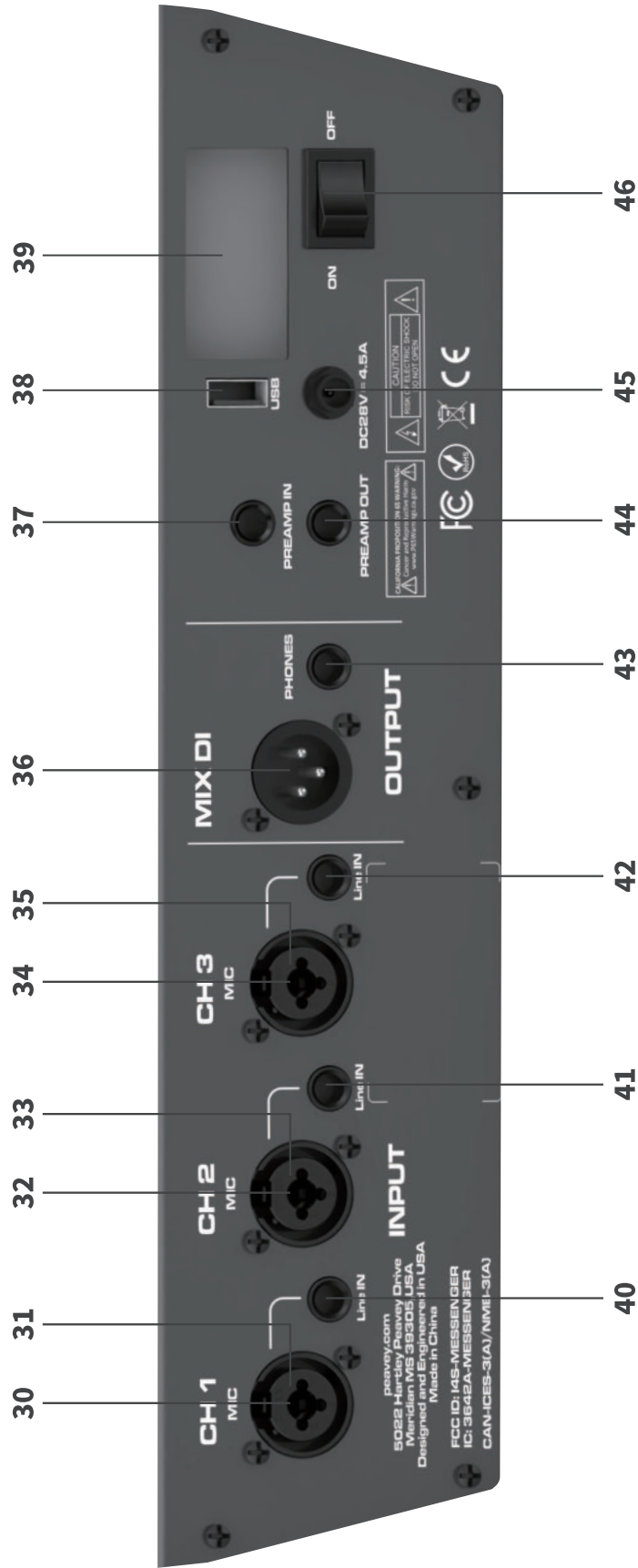

Bluetooth pairing

Press switch, blue indicator blinking, at this point, in Bluetooth pairing state, search Messenger and connect. blue light on, pairing is successful(Only one Bluetooth device can be connected at the same time)



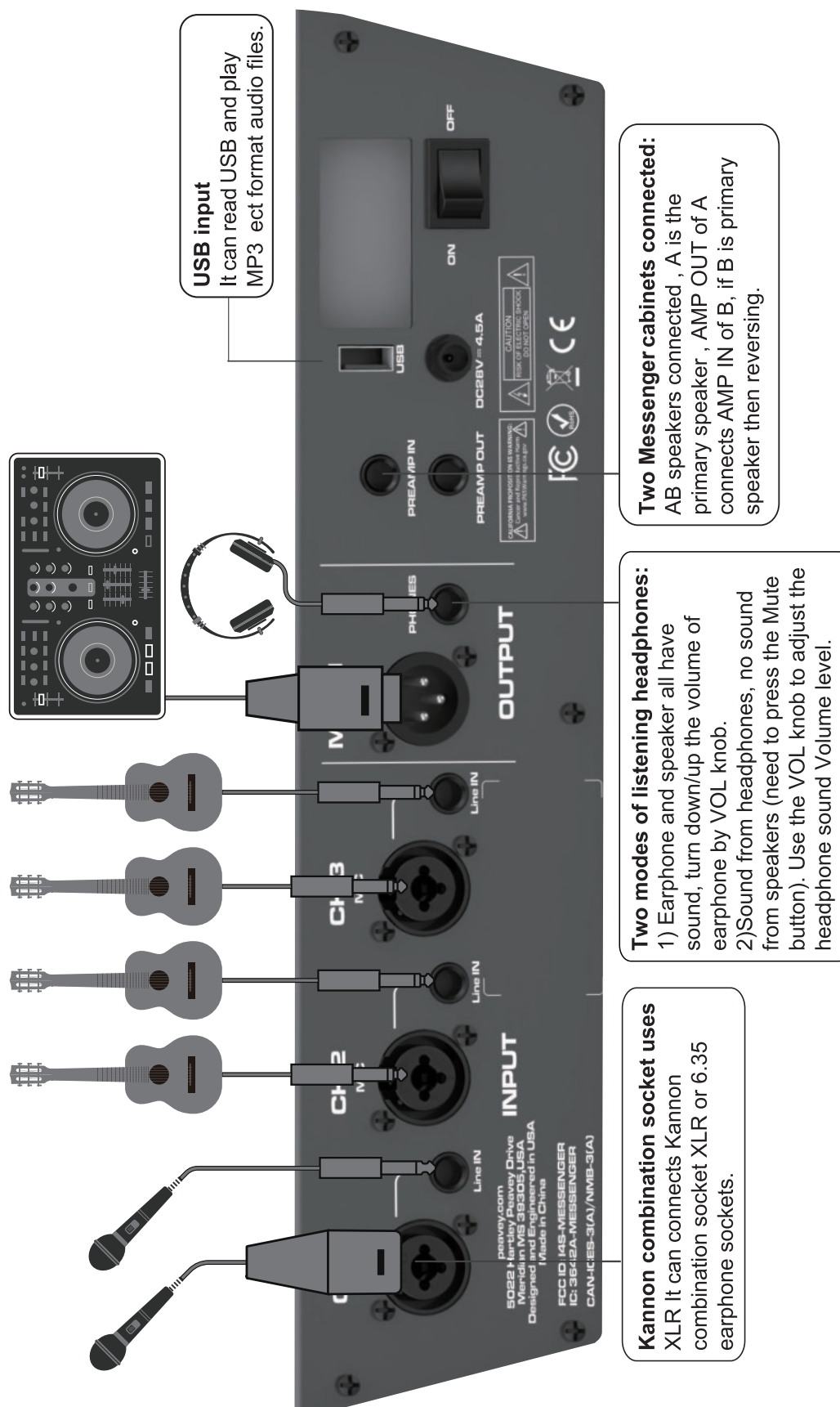
Bright/Button

48V Phantom Power
Capacitor microphone 48V phantom power supply switch, red indicator for 48V open, blue is power supply indicator.

* In order to reduce the bottom noise, speaker and phone devices don't use AC power during recording live broadcasting, the bottom noise of battery power supply is smaller. The volume of the recorded live broadcast is directly related to the gain of each channel and has nothing to do with the total volume. It is better to turn the gain knob in the direction of 1:00-2:00.

* Before any connecting, please turn down the volume, and turn off the power, to avoid device fault or damage.
