1. Light Indicators:
2.4GHz: Red light BT1: Green light BT2: Blue light
2. 2.4GHz Wireless Pairing:
Slide the ON/OFF power switch on the bottom of the mouse to ON. The mode indicator will flash red. Remove the USB receiver from the bottom of the mouse and plug it into your computer. After the red light flashes rapidly and then turns off, the mouse is successfully connected.
3. Wireless BT Pairing:
Slide the power switch to ON, then press the mode button for BT1 (green) or BT2 (blue). The corresponding indicator will flash rapidly. Select the Bluetooth name that appears on your device to connect. Once connected, the indicator will flash and then turn off.
4. Wireless BT Names:
BT1: M0-76 CHI BT2: M0-76 CH2
5. Mode Switching:
A short press cycles through 2.4GHz, BT1, and BT2 modes (indicator flashes); a long press initiates pairing for the selected mode.
6. Sleep Timer:
The mouse enters Level 1 sleep after 2 minutes of inactivity, followed by deep sleep after 10 minutes. Press
