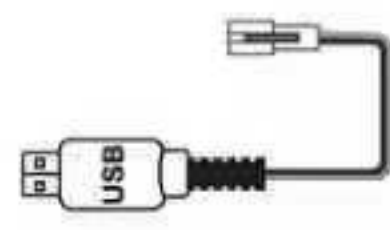

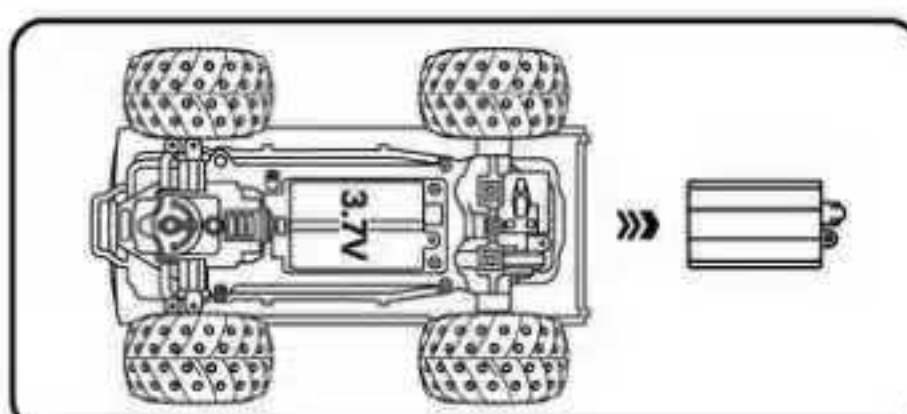
### Battery installation and charging of remote control car and remote control



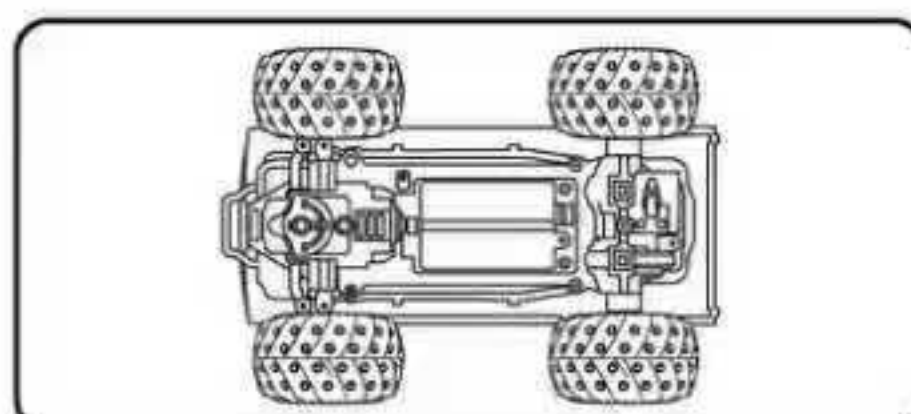
Connect the battery to the charging cable, then plug the USB cable into a computer USB port or a USB charger to start charging.  
Red light on: charging;  
Red light off: fully charged.



**Remote Control Battery Installation**  
(1) Open the battery cover on the bottom of the remote control.  
(2) Insert 2 × 1.5V "AA" batteries with correct polarity, then close the battery cover.

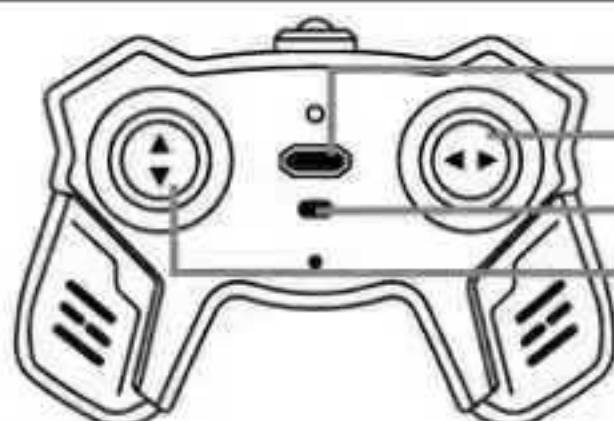


After charging, open the battery cover and insert the battery into the compartment.



Connect the battery pack to the car interface then close the battery cover.

### Remote Functions



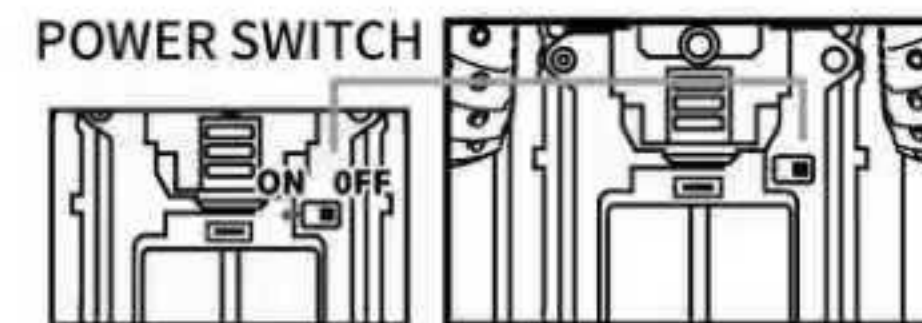
- ① TWO LIGHT MODES: STEADY ON / FLASH
- ② LEFT / RIGHT
- ③ POWER SWITCH
- ④ FORWARD / BACKWARD

### Operation method

Turn the vehicle's power switch to ON. Place the vehicle on a flat surface, then turn on the remote control. Operate the controls after the indicator light stops flashing.

Note: Do not operate the controls while the indicator light is flashing.

### Basic operation diagram for product use



- ① TWO LIGHT MODES: STEADY ON / FLASH
- ② LEFT / RIGHT
- ③ POWER SWITCH
- ④ FORWARD / BACKWARD



LIGHT KEY: PRESS TO SWITCH MODES. FIRST PRESS FOR STEADY LIGHT  
SECOND PRESS FOR FLASH, THIRD PRESS TO TURN OFF THE LIGHT.  
FORWARD/BACKWARD KEY: PRESS TO CONTROL THE CAR MOVING FORWARD OR BACKWARD.  
LEFT/RIGHT KEY: PRESS TO CONTROL THE CAR TURNING LEFT OR RIGHT.  
POWER SWITCH: PRESS TO TURN THE REMOTE CONTROL ON OR OFF.

### Maintenance and repair

1. REMOVE THE BATTERIES IF THE TOY WILL NOT BE USED FOR A LONG TIME.
2. WIPE DIRT ON THE TOY GENTLY WITH A CLEAN SOFT CLOTH.
3. DO NOT PLACE THE TOY IN HIGH TEMPERATURE, HUMID AREAS OR DIRECT SUNLIGHT.
4. KEEP THE TOY AWAY FROM WATER TO AVOID DAMAGE TO ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS.

### Precautions

- PLEASE OBSERVE CORRECT POLARITY WHEN INSTALLING OR REPLACING BATTERIES.
- DO NOT CHARGE NON-RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.
- ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED WHEN CHARGING RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.
- DO NOT MIX OLD AND NEW BATTERIES OR DIFFERENT TYPES OF BATTERIES.
- AVOID SIGNAL INTERFERENCE DURING OPERATION, OTHERWISE THE REMOTE CONTROL RANGE WILL BE REDUCED.
- IF THE CAR SLOWS DOWN, THE POWER IS LOW. PLEASE CHARGE IT AS INSTRUCTED ABOVE.
- REPLACE BATTERIES IF THE REMOTE INDICATOR LIGHT DIMS OR TURNS OFF.
- REMOVE ALL BATTERIES FROM CAR AND REMOTE CONTROL, AND SWITCH THE CAR TO OFF WHEN NOT IN USE FOR A LONG TIME.

### Warm tips

- DO NOT TOUCH THE WHEELS WHILE THE CAR IS MOVING TO PREVENT DAMAGE.
- DO NOT PLAY ON ROADS OR DANGEROUS AREAS TO AVOID ACCIDENTS.
- DO NOT USE THE CAR IN PUDDLES, MUD OR SAND.
