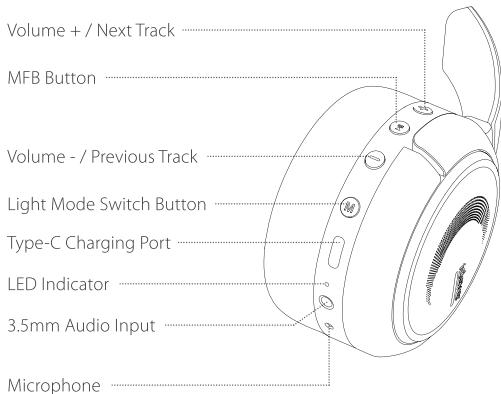

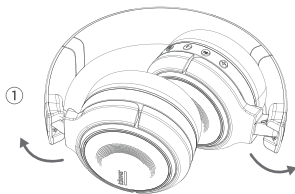

Product Diagram



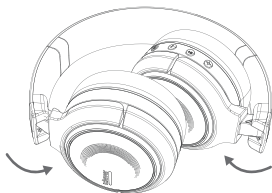
On / Off





1. If the headphone is folded, just unfold it. Then it will be auto on, the colorful lights will be also on, and the headphone will enter the pairing mode.

2. When the headphone is folded as shown below, it will be auto off.



Note: If there is an abnormal situation, press and hold the MFB button for 3-5s to turn the headphone on and enter the pairing mode.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. In the power-on state, the colorful lights are on; Bluetooth enters the pairing state, and the red and blue lights flash alternately.

2. Turn on the Bluetooth of the mobile phone. Then find and select the "iClever-BTH15" Bluetooth pairing name in the device list for Bluetooth pairing connection.

Light Mode Switching

Short press the "Light Mode Switch Button" to turn on/off the light.

Volume Limit Gear Switching

1. Press and hold the "+" & "-" buttons at the same time to switch the volume limit to the safe volume of 85dB, and the voice broadcast will be "Safe Volume".
2. Press and hold the "+" & "-" buttons at the same time to switch the volume limit to the normal volume mode, and the voice broadcast will be "Normal Volume".

Operation of Buttons

Volume Up	Short press the "+" button.
Volume Down	Short press the "-" button.
Next Track	Press and hold the "+" button for 2 seconds.
Previous Track	Press and hold the "-" button for 2 seconds.
Play / Pause	Press the MFB button once.
Answer / End A Call	Press the MFB button once.
Reject A Call	Keep pressing the MFB button for seconds.
Activate Siri	Press the MFB button twice.

Clear The Pairing List	After the Bluetooth is turned on, in any state, press and hold the "multi-function button" and "-" button at the same time for 5 seconds to clear the pairing list in the headphone.

How to Charge the Headphone

Connect the Type-C cable to the Type-C port on the headphone, and a 5V power outlet (power adapter is not included). The indicator light will glow red to indicate charging. When the headphone is fully charged, the indicator light will change from red to blue.

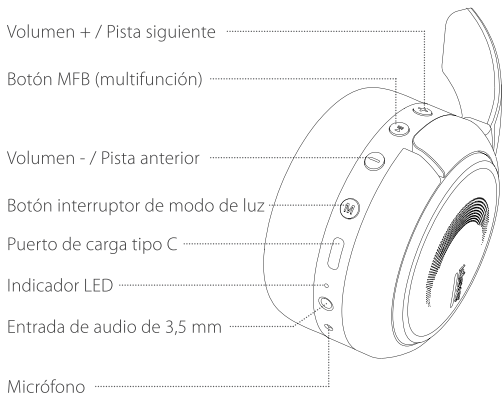

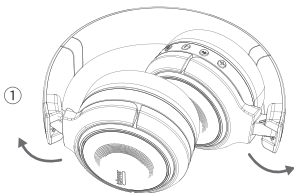

Diagrama del producto



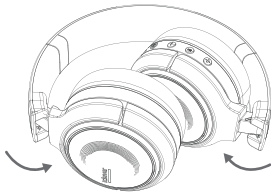
Encendido / Apagado





1. Si los auriculares están doblados, simplemente despliéguelos. Entonces se encenderán automáticamente, las luces de colores también se encenderán y los auriculares entrarán en el modo de emparejamiento.

2. Cuando los auriculares estén plegados como se muestra a continuación, se apagarán automáticamente.



Nota: Si hay una situación anormal, mantenga presionado el botón MFB durante 3-5 segundos para encender los auriculares y entrar al modo de emparejamiento.

Emparejamiento Bluetooth

1. Con los auriculares y las luces de colores encendidas; el Bluetooth entra en estado de emparejamiento y las luces roja y azul parpadean alternativamente.

2. Encienda el Bluetooth del teléfono móvil. A continuación, busque y seleccione el nombre de emparejamiento Bluetooth "iClever-BTH15" en la lista de dispositivos para la conexión.

Cambio de modo de luz

Presione brevemente el "Botón interruptor de modo de luz" para encender / apagar la luz.

Cambio de límite de volumen

1. Mantenga presionados los botones "+" y "-" al mismo tiempo para cambiar el límite de volumen a un volumen seguro de 85dB, y la voz dirá "Safe volume".
2. Mantenga presionados los botones "+" y "-" al mismo tiempo para cambiar el límite de volumen al modo de volumen normal, y la voz dirá "Normal volume".

Uso de los botones

Subir volumen	Presione brevemente el botón "+".
Subir volumen	Presione brevemente el botón "-".
Siguiente pista	Mantenga presionado el botón "+" durante 2 segundos.
Pista anterior	Mantenga presionado el botón "-" durante 2 segundos.
Play / Pausa	Presione el botón MFB una vez.
Responder / finalizar una llamada	Presione el botón MFB una vez.
Rechazar una llamada	Mantenga presionado el botón MFB durante unos segundos.
Activar Siri	Presione el botón MFB dos veces.

Borrar la lista de emparejamientos

Una vez que el Bluetooth esté encendido, en cualquier estado, presione y mantenga presionado el "botón multifunción" y el botón "-" al mismo tiempo durante 5 segundos para borrar la lista de emparejamiento en los auriculares.

Cómo cargar los auriculares

Conecte el cable tipo C al puerto tipo C de los auriculares y a una toma de corriente de 5 V (el adaptador de corriente no está incluido). La luz indicadora se iluminará en rojo para indicar que se está cargando. Cuando los auriculares estén completamente cargados, la luz indicadora cambiará de rojo a azul.
