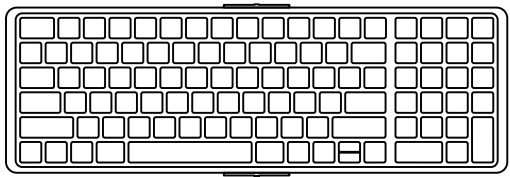

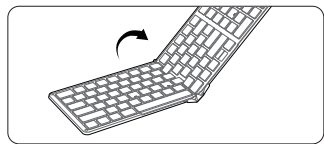

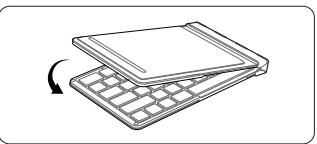
03 Indicators & definition

Icon	Indicator	Color	Definition
	Charging	Red-Green	Stay in red color when charging, and it will turn green after fully charged.
	Caps lock	Blue	Blue indicator is on.
	BT1	Blue	Short press 1 to switch BT1 , long press $\geq 3s$ for Bluetooth pairing.
	BT2	Blue	Short press 2 to switch BT2 , long press $\geq 3s$ for Bluetooth pairing.
	BT3	Blue	Short press 3 to switch BT3 , long press $\geq 3s$ for Bluetooth pairing.
	Power on	Blue	Three Bluetooth channel indicators stay on for 3s, then turn off.

04 Pairing Steps



Power On:
Unfold the keyboard to turn on.



Power Off:
Fold the keyboard to turn off.

Pair with 1st device

Step 1: Short press 1 to switch **BT1**.

Step 2: Long Press 1 to enter pairing mode, Bluetooth channel 1 indicator will flash blue and start to search the available Bluetooth device.

Step 3: On your bluetooth device, find the Bluetooth name "**iClever KF01**" and click to connect it.

Step 4: The status indicator will be off after successfully paired.



Pair with 2nd device

Step 1: Short press 2 to switch **BT2**.

Step 2: Long Press 2 to enter pairing mode, Bluetooth channel 2 indicator will flash blue and start to search the available Bluetooth device.

Step 3: Repeat the above pairing step 3 and step 4.

Pair with 3rd device

Step 1: Short press 3 to switch **BT3**.

Step 2: Long Press 3 to enter pairing mode, Bluetooth channel 3 indicator will flash blue and start to search the available Bluetooth device.

Step 3: Repeat the above pairing step 3 and step 4.

06 Sleep Mode

The keyboard will enter sleep mode if idle for 120min.
Press any key to exit sleep mode.

07 Charging

Step 1: Connect one end of the included type-c cable to a USB charger, and connect the opposite end to the charging slot on the keyboard.
(Note: Output: DC 5 V / 500mA; USB charger is not included)

Step 2: The charging indicator will glow red while the keyboard is charging.
A full charge takes approximately 2.5 hours.
