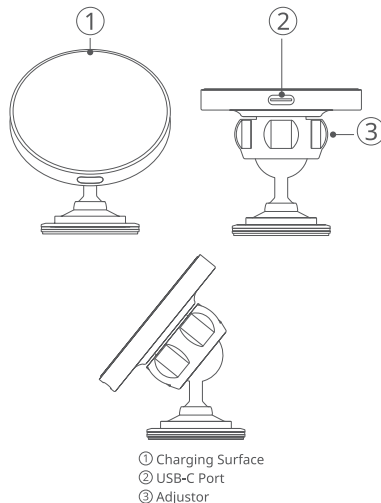
Cautions

1. The product is for indoor use only.
2. Keep the product out of reach of children.
3. Use only certified and compatible power supplies, chargers, and batteries with the wireless charger.
4. Do not drop, hit, or subject the product to strong impacts. Avoid storing or using it in high-temperature or humid environments. Do not throw into fire.
5. Do not place metal objects on the surface of the wireless charger to prevent equipment failure or overheating.
6. When not in use for extended periods, disconnect the wireless charger from the power supply to avoid unnecessary power consumption.
7. In medical and healthcare facilities where the use of wireless devices is explicitly prohibited, please comply with the facility's rules and turn off the device.
8. The radio waves generated by this device may interfere with the normal operation of implanted medical devices or personal medical equipment, such as pacemakers, cochlear implants, and hearing aids. Usage

1. Rotate the rear knob to adjust the tightness as needed.
2. Connect the cable to the USB-C port and plug it into a suitable power adapter.
3. Place the phone on the charging surface and connect the power supply to start charging.
