Compatibility & Preparations

🔌 Applicable Scope
 Works for cars with original wired CarPlay/Android Auto. Supports wireless CarPlay (iPhone) & wireless Android Auto (Android). Note: CarPlay & Android Auto are mutually exclusive.

📱 Device Compatibility
 iPhone: iPhone 6+, iOS 10+.
 Android: Android 11+ with latest Android Auto function.

🔌 Check Car's Wired Function
 Connect phone to car via USB cable. Confirm the CarPlay/Android Auto logo on the display to ensure correct port usage.

🧠 Basic Precaution
 Insert the box into the correct port. Success prompt: "Debug BT"carplay_box xxxx".

Wireless Connection Steps

🤖 For Android (Wireless Android Auto)

- Start the car and insert the box into the Android Auto port.
- Pair with "Carplay_box-xxxx" via Bluetooth and authorize access.
- Note: Detection promptly appears for the first connection.

🍏 For iPhone (Wireless CarPlay)

- Start the car and insert the box into the CarPlay port.
- Enable Bluetooth on iPhone, search for "Carplay-box-xxxx".
- Tap "Connect" on the car display pop-up to confirm.

OTA Firmware Update

🏭 Common Preparations

- Connect the box to car port (Display: "Debug BT:carplay_box 3010").
- Join WiFi "carplay-box-xxxx" (Password: 12345678).
- Open browser and visit: 192.168.43.1.

🤖 Android Phone Update

- Enable Mobile Data, disable WiFi → Check & Download.
- Reconnect WiFi → Tap "Update Firmware".

🍏 iPhone Update

- Directly tap "Check Cloud Version" → "Start Download".
- After download, tap "Update Firmware" to complete.

💡 Update Tips
 The interface displays "Local Version" (current) and "Cloud Version" (latest). Always select the latest Cloud Version for download. Do not disconnect during the update process.
