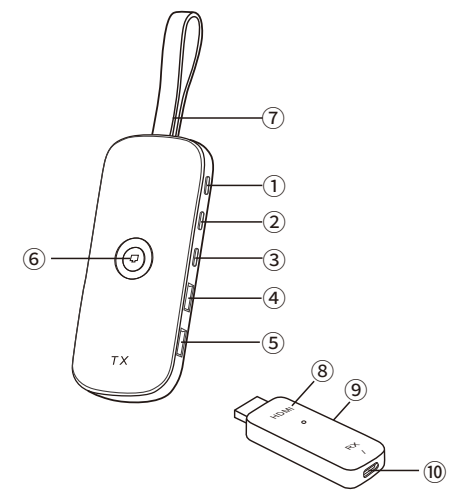

5 IN 1 Wireless HDMI HUB

01 At a Glance



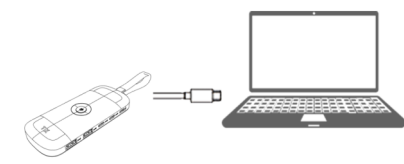
No.	Item	Description
TX (Transmitter)		
①	PD in	- Connect to a PD (Power Delivery) charger and cable to charge your laptop. - This port supports charging up to 85W for your laptop, plus an additional 15W to power the hub. For optimal 85W charging, a 100w PD charger and cable (not included) are required.

②	USB-C port	Connect to a USB-C device to transfer data at speeds up to 5Gbps, only data
③	USB-C port	Connect to a USB-C device to transfer data at speeds up to 5Gbps, only data
④	USB-A port	Connect to a USB-A device to transfer data at speeds up to 5Gbps
⑤	USB-A port	Connect to a USB-A device to transfer data at speeds up to 5Gbps
⑥	Switch button	Control the display of the extended screen (on or off)
⑦	USB-C connector	Plug into the laptop's USB-C port

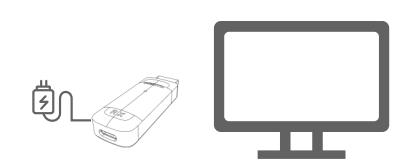
RX(Receiver)		
⑧	HDMI port	Connect to HDMI-enabled monitors, with a maximum resolution of up to 1080P/60Hz
⑨	Pairing button	Re-pairing TX and RX
⑩	Power in	Connect to a at least 5W charger and cable to charge your RX.
Frequency Range		5150MHz ~ 5250MHz 5725MHz ~ 5850MHz

02 How to use your wireless HDMI hub

①TX hub connect to the USB-C port of your laptop. Make sure that the USB-C port of your laptop supports Power Delivery (for charging) and DP Alt Mode (for HDMI display).



②Plug the receiver (RX) into the monitor or TV. Use a USB-C power cable to connect a power source of at least 5V/1A



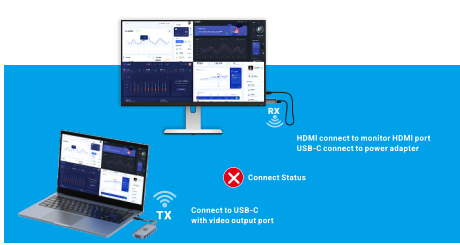
③The product is pre-paired at the factory and is plug-and-play. Please wait for about 10 seconds. When you see a green checkmark on the screen, it means the connection was successful.



④Once the screen appears successfully, you can choose either mirror mode or extended mode on your computer.



⑤If the display does not show an image or the connection fails, you can try resolving the issue by re-pairing the devices. Use a paperclip to press the re-pairing switch on the RX to enter re-pairing mode, then wait a few seconds for the re-pairing process to complete.



⑥The 2*USB-C and 2*USB-A ports support a data transfer rate of 5Gbps and can be used to connect devices such as keyboards, mice, USB flash drives, external hard drives, and printers for data transfer.

⑦The power charging port support PD3.0 100W max. input, which can support charging up to 85W for your laptop.

03 Safety & operational warnings

①Power & Electrical Safety

Use Approved Power Adapters: For the RX, always use a certified 5V/1A (or 5V/2A) power supply. Connecting to incompatible voltage or current sources may cause circuit burnout or fire hazards.
Do Not Disassemble: There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Do not open, modify, or attempt to repair the casing, as doing so may cause electric shock and void your warranty.

②Wireless Performance & Interference

Avoid Physical Obstructions: Wi-Fi signals degrade significantly when passing through walls, metal structures, or solid furniture, causing latency or signal loss. Maintain a direct line of sight between the transmitter (TX) and receiver (RX) whenever possible.
Frequency Interference: Wireless routers, microwaves, and Bluetooth devices operating on the 5GHz bands may cause signal interference.
Transmission Range: Stated maximum distances are measured in open, unobstructed environments. Actual operational range may vary based on environmental interference and obstacles.

③Thermal Safety & Ventilation

Normal Operating Heat: High-speed video decoding and Wi-Fi transmission generate heat. The surface temperature rise (typically 40°C–50°C / 104°F–122°F) during operation is normal and not a product defect.
Ensure Proper Ventilation: Do not place the device in

enclosed spaces, cover it with cloth, or position it near heat sources (e.g., radiators, AV receivers). Overheating may trigger automatic shutdown or damage the unit.

④Latency & Content Limitations

Not Suitable for Competitive Gaming: Wireless Wi-Fi transmission introduces a slight latency (typically 30ms–150ms). While ideal for presentations and media streaming, it is not recommended for real-time competitive gaming.
HDCP Copyright Restrictions: Certain DRM-protected content (e.g., Netflix, Disney+, Amazon Prime Video) may not mirror properly on specific source devices due to HDCP protocol limitations.

⑤Handling & Port Protection

Proper Cable Insertion: Insert and remove HDMI/USB-C connectors horizontally without twisting to prevent pin damage.
Keep Away from Moisture: This device is not waterproof. Do not expose it to rain, high humidity, or liquids.
