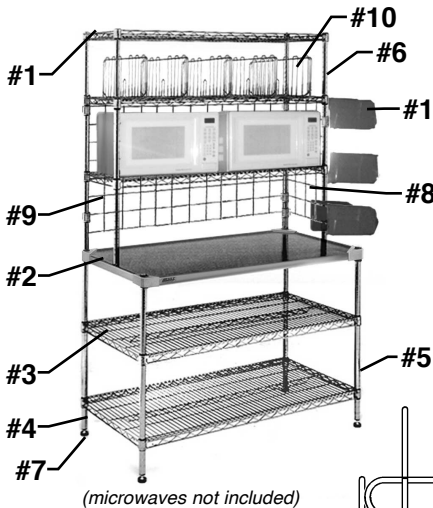


Microwave Prep Table

Step 1 - Assemble bottom undershelf to #7 groove on all posts.

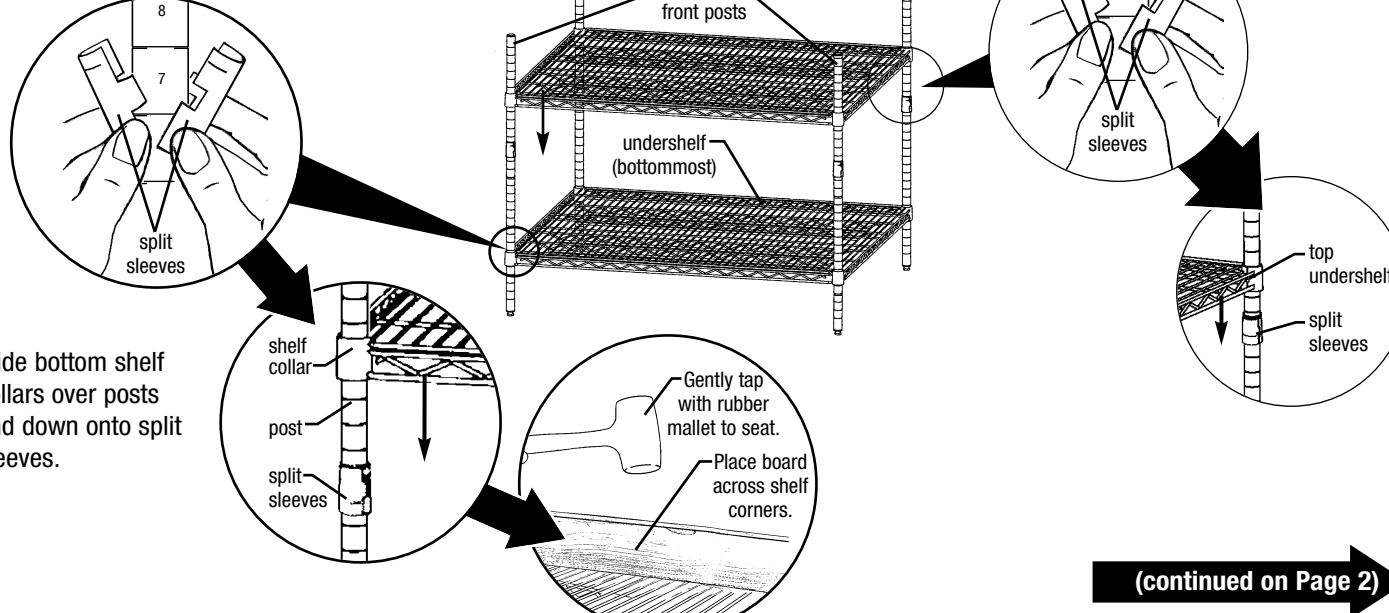
Snap split sleeves onto #7 groove on posts.

- The wider part of the taper goes toward the bottom.
- Make sure rib on split sleeve is seated into a groove on the post.

Note: The number covered by the split sleeve indicates approximate height of shelf.

Step 2 - Assemble top undershelf to #19 groove on all posts.

Repeat Step 1, attaching split sleeves onto #19 groove on posts.



Slide bottom shelf collars over posts and down onto split sleeves.

Gently tap with rubber mallet to seat.
Place board across shelf corners.

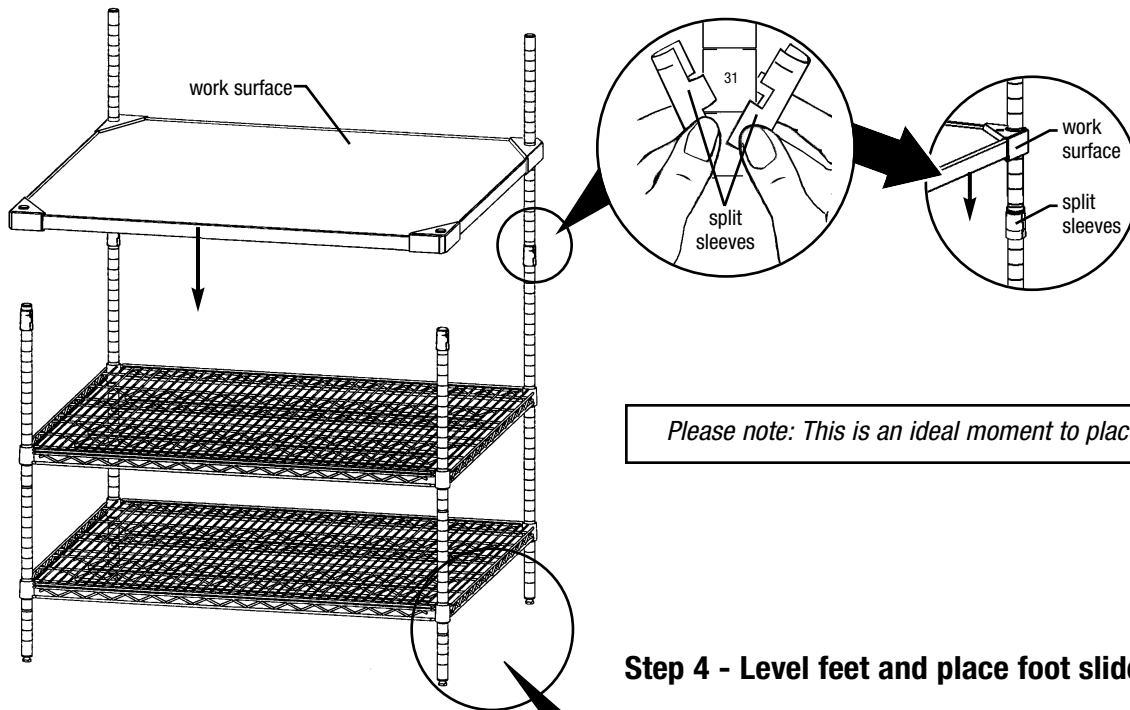

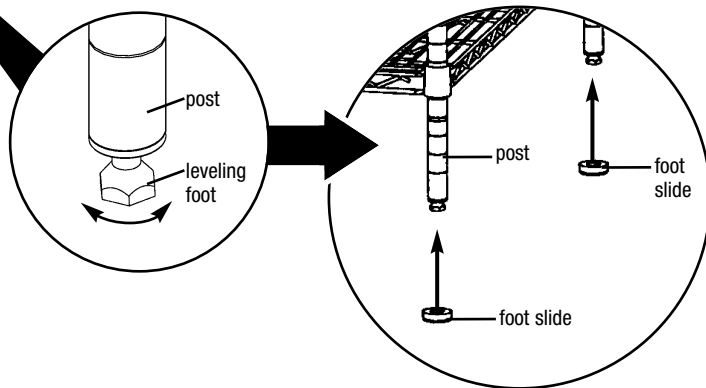

Step 3 - Attach work surface to #31 groove on rear posts (top groove on front posts).



Step 4 - Level feet and place foot slides under posts.



Assembly of the table base is complete.

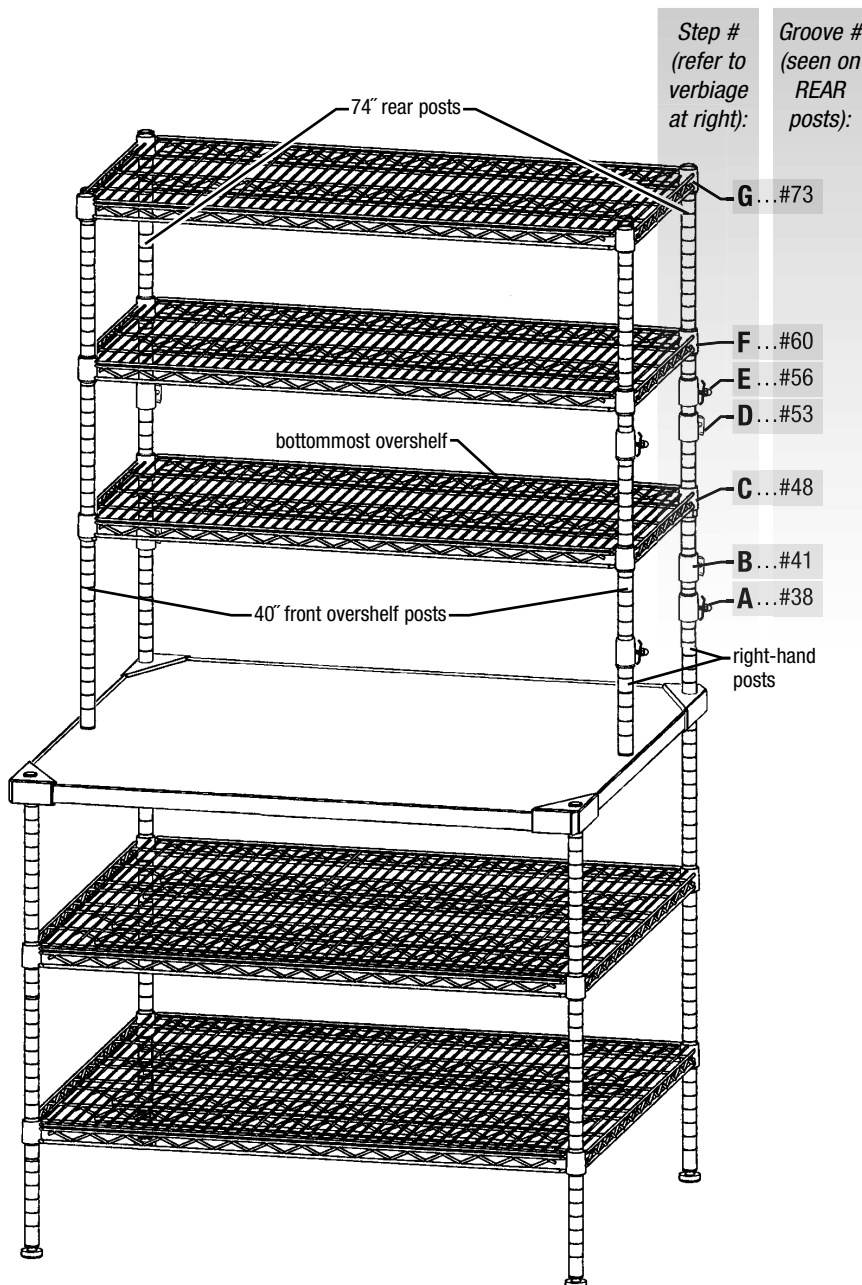
Step 5 - Assemble front overshelf posts, grid panel clamps, and overshelves—working from bottom to top.

Please note: Groove #s seen on 74" rear posts differ from groove #s on 40" front overshelf posts.

The "Groove #" reference in the Step 5 illustration below pertains only to the REAR posts.

For Steps 5A, C, E, F, and G: When installing split sleeves onto the front overshelf posts, match the heights to the rear posts' groove #s listed in illustration.

Referring to illustration, assemble in the following order:



A) Attach bottommost grid panel clamps for side grid panel.

- Snap split sleeves onto right-hand posts.
- Slide grid panel clamps down posts and onto split sleeves, making sure they face outward.

B) Attach bottommost grid panel clamps for rear grid panel.

- Snap split sleeves onto rear posts.
- Slide grid panel clamps down posts and onto split sleeves, making sure they face outward.

C) Attach bottommost overshelf.

- Snap split sleeves onto all four posts.
- Slide overshelf down posts and onto split sleeves.

D) Attach topmost grid panel clamps for rear grid panel.

- Snap split sleeves onto rear posts.
- Slide grid panel clamps down posts and onto split sleeves, making sure they face outward.

E) Attach topmost grid panel clamps for side grid panel.

- Snap split sleeves onto right-hand posts.
- Slide grid panel clamps down posts and onto split sleeves, making sure they face outward.

F) Attach mid overshelf.

- Snap split sleeves onto all four posts.
- Slide overshelf down posts and onto split sleeves.

G) Attach top overshelf.

- Snap split sleeves onto topmost groove on all four posts.
- Seat topmost overshelf onto split sleeves.

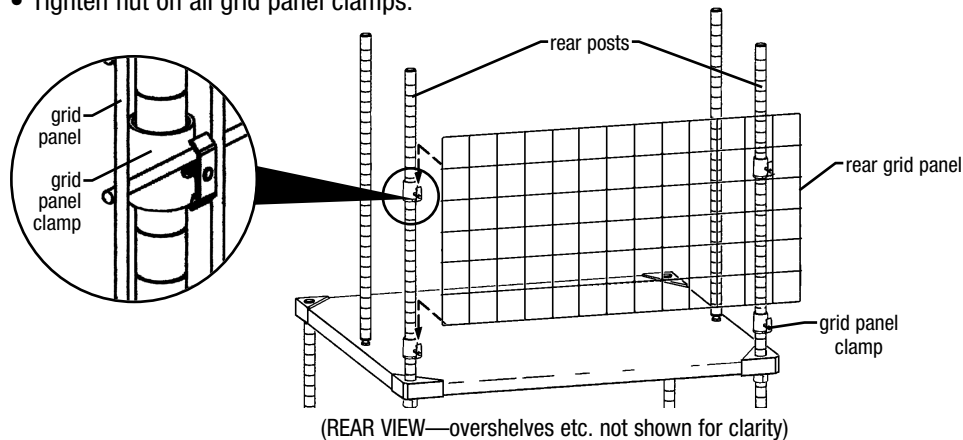

Step 6 - Attach rear grid panel.

- Loosen nut on each grid panel clamp as needed.
- Make sure the top of the grid panel lines up with the mid overshelf.
- Tighten nut on all grid panel clamps.



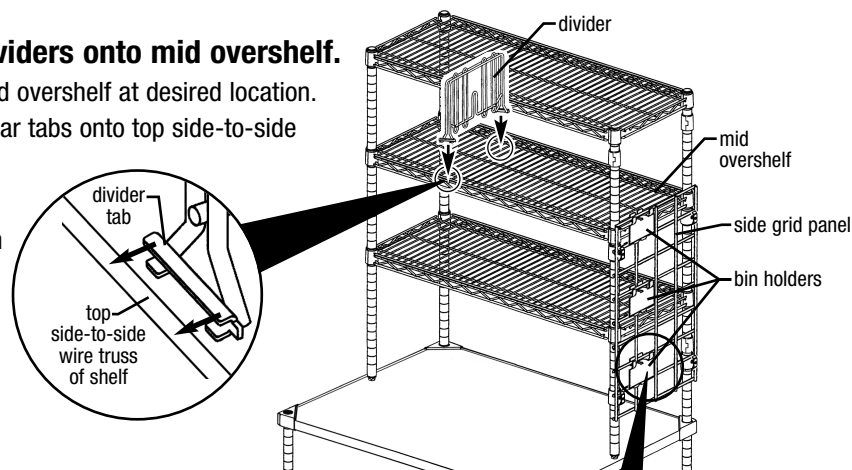
Step 7 - Attach side grid panel.

Repeat Step 6, making sure the side grid panel lines up with the rear grid panel.

Step 8 - Attach dividers onto mid overshelf.

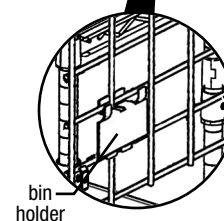
- Place divider onto mid overshelf at desired location.
- Snap the front and rear tabs onto top side-to-side wire trusses of shelf.

Repeat Step 8 to attach remaining dividers.



Step 9 - Attach bin holders to side grid panel and hang supply bins.

Refer to Step 8 illustration for typical locations of bin holders.



Step 10 - Hang hooks, racks, etc. onto grid panels where desired.

Assembly is complete.
