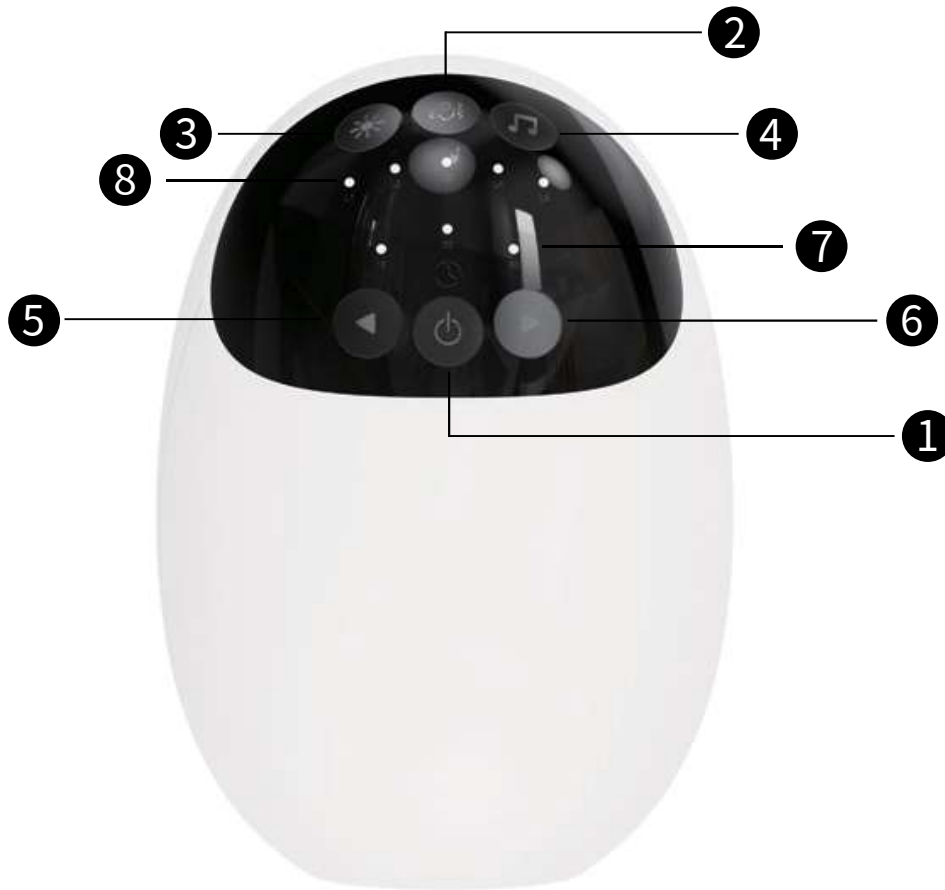

1.Long press to turn on, click to switch timing, long press again to turn off

2.Press the vibration button briefly:
On - Cycle through levels L1 to L5 - Off

3.Press the button briefly to keep the warm light on.
Press again to activate the breathing light.
Press a third time to turn it off.

4.Press briefly to turn white noise on/off.
Press and hold to connect via Bluetooth.
The corresponding timer light will flash.
Once connected, the light will remain steady.

5.Volume Down Button,
Long press to go back to the
previous track.

6.Volume Up Button,Press and
hold to skip to the next track.

7.Timer Indicator Light and Label.

8.Gear Indicator Light and Symbol.

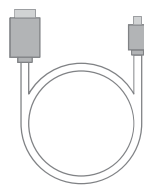

- Babies are safest sleeping flat and on their backs.

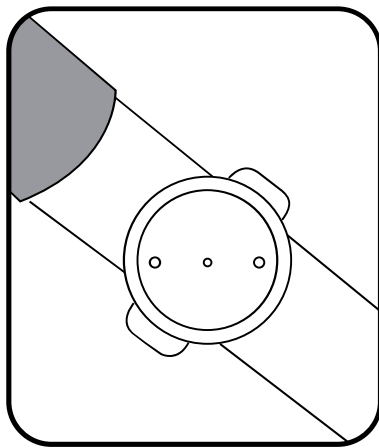

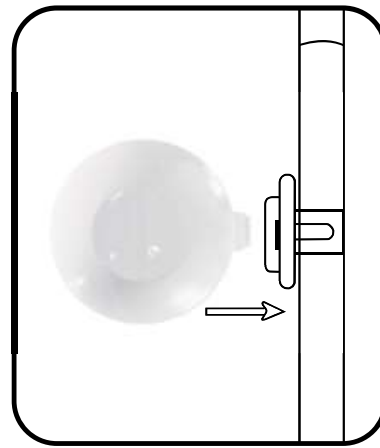

Installing the Bracket:

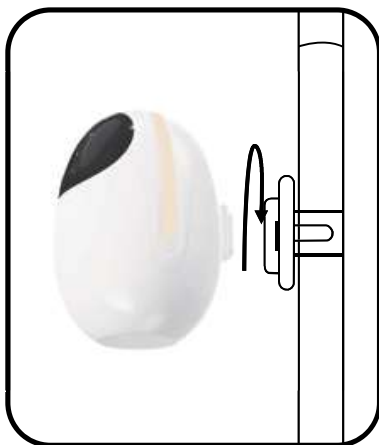
bracket should be positioned out of reach of the child and fitted high up on the frame or handle.



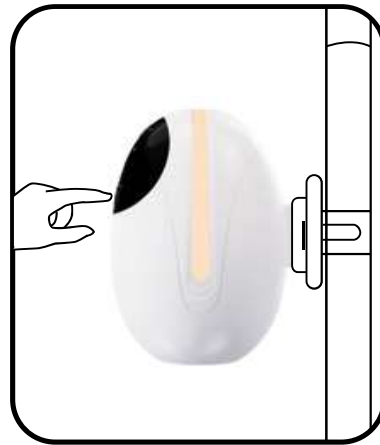
① Fit bracket



② Install



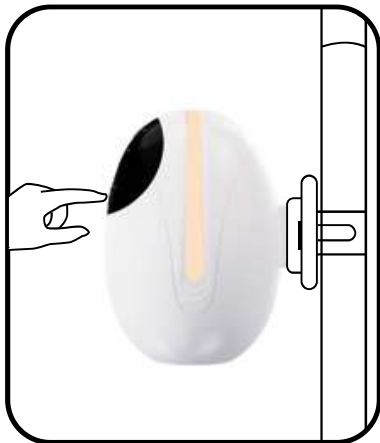
③ Lock-in



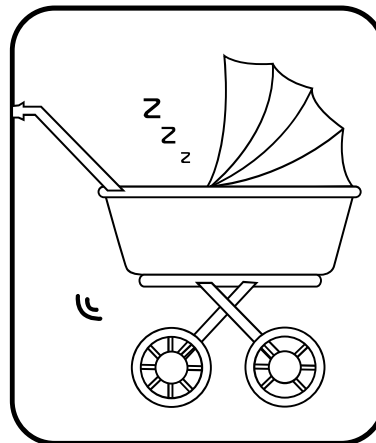
④ Turn on

Simply attach to your stroller or pram, push the button and adjust the speed to gently rock your baby, just like you would.

Link device

What age child can I use device with?

Device is suitable for children from birth to 3 years old.

Is the rocking motion safe?

Yes. We have based the rocking motion on the way parents rock their children by hand.

How do I clean device?

Device can be surface cleaned with a damp cloth. Do not submerge in water.
