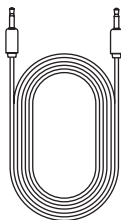

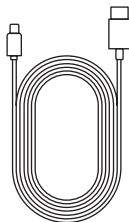

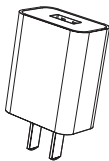

USEFUL TIPS

1. Battery

Please recharge the battery for at least 4.5 hours before initial use. If you connect this player to DC power, you can use it directly.

Note: The charging indicator light on the panel will glow red while charging and will turn green when charging is complete.

2. Power Switch

Slide the power switch on the rear of the CD player to the "ON" position to turn it on after connecting to the mains power supply. Slide it to the "OFF" position to turn the player off completely.

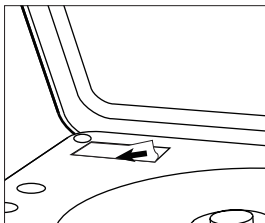
3. Laser Pickup

There is a protective card inside the player. Please remove this card before inserting a disc. **DO NOT** touch the laser pickup or other internal components with your hands.



4. LCD Screen

If you find scratches on the screen, simply remove the screen protector.



5. Support Format

Supported Disc Formats (Disc Types): CD, CD-R, CD-RW, CD-G

Supported Audio Formats (File Types): CD-DA, MP3, WMA

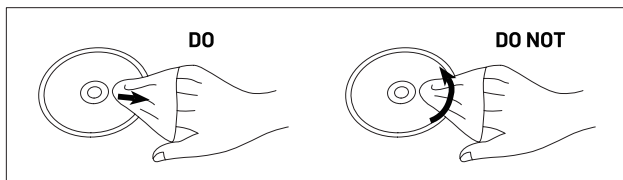
6. About Standby Mode

CD player is set to enter standby mode following 15 minutes of no activity. To wake the CD player from standby, you can either:

Press the power button  on the remote, or locate the play/pause button  on the panel and hold it down for 2 seconds.

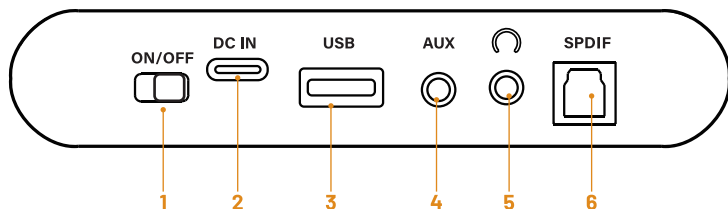
7. About Maintenance

- Wipe the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Use eyeglass cleaner to remove stubborn dirt from the transparent lid.
- Do not use alcohol, paint thinner, or benzene for cleaning.
- Do not press on the panel LCD screen or drop the product from a height.
- This unit is not waterproof. To prevent moisture damage, do not place containers with liquids (e.g., vases, flower pots) near the unit or expose it to dripping, splashing, rain, or humidity.



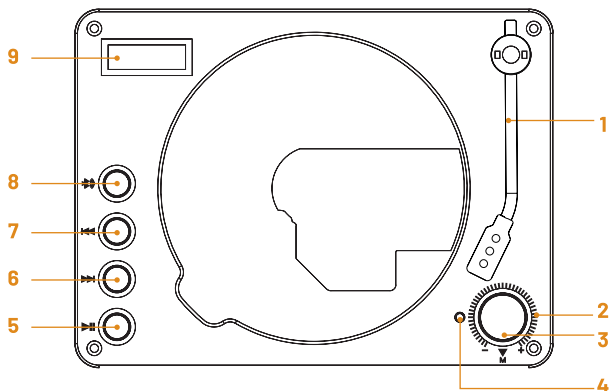
- To clean discs, wipe with a damp cloth and then dry immediately.
- Do not attach labels or stickers to any discs (This may cause disc warping, making it unusable).
- Do not write on the discs with a ball-point pen or any other writing tool.
- To protect discs from scratches and dirt, return them to their cases or cassettes when not in use.
- Do not use discs that are severely deformed, cracked, or irregularly shaped (e.g., heart-shaped).

INTERFACES INTRODUCTION



1	POWER ON/OFF	To turn the unit ON or OFF.
2	DC IN JACK	Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port to power the unit.
3	USB JACK	Insert a USB drive to play audio content.
4	AUX IN JACK	Connect other audio output device to the AUX IN port via a 3.5mm audio cable.
5	HEADPHONES JACK (3.5mm Audio Interface)	Insert headphones into the headphone jack for private audio listening.
6	SPDIF JACK	Connect the device's SPDIF jack to your home audio system via an optical cable to achieve lossless transmission of CD audio.

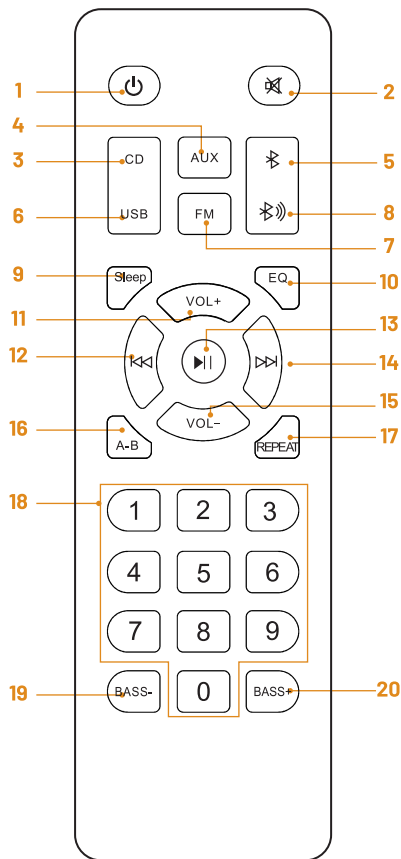
PANEL INTRODUCTION



1	Play/Stop Lever	Slide the lever to the left to play audio from the CD. Slide the lever to the right to stop playback and allow the CD to be removed.
2	Volume Adjustment	Turn clockwise to increase volume, counterclockwise to decrease.
3	Mode Switching	Press the  button vertically downward briefly to cycle through CD mode, USB mode, AUX IN mode, Bluetooth Receiver mode and FM mode.
4	Charging Indicator Light	The charging indicator light of the panel will glow red while charging and will turn green when charging is complete.
5	Play/Pause	In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver mode or Bluetooth Transmitter mode press briefly to play/pause audio. In FM radio mode, press briefly to switch stations.

6	Next	In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver or Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press briefly to skip to the next track. In FM radio mode: Press briefly to increase the frequency step by step. Press and hold to start an automatic backward scan; the device will search in the direction of increasing frequency and automatically save stations with a signal.
7	Previous	In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver or Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press briefly to skip to the previous track. In FM radio mode: Press briefly to decrease the frequency step by step. Press and hold to start an automatic forward scan; the device will search in the direction of decreasing frequency and automatically save stations with a signal.
8	Bluetooth Transmitter	In CD mode, briefly press to search for and pair with nearby enabled Bluetooth audio devices. This allows the CD audio to be streamed wirelessly to the connected device for playback.
9	LCD Display	The LCD display shows playback mode, track information, volume status, and radio frequency.

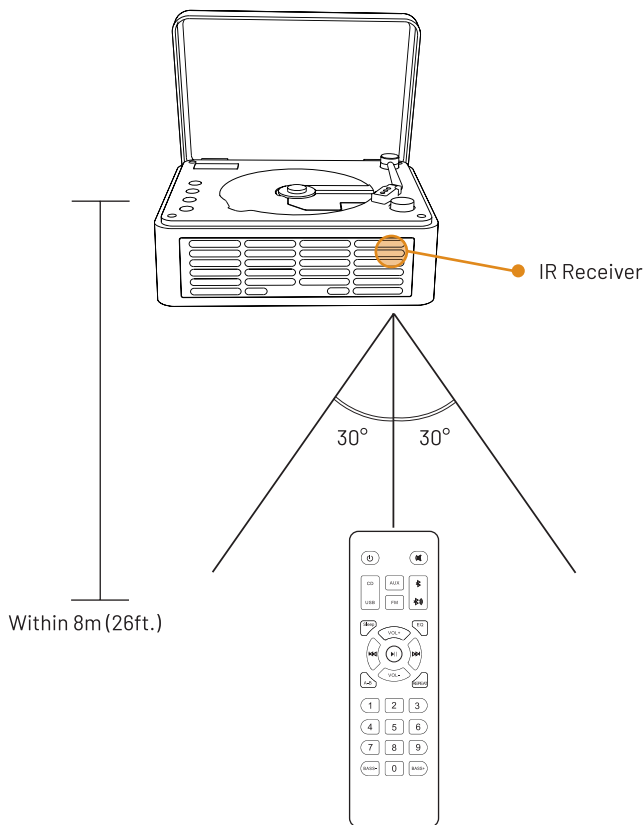
REMOTE CONTROL INTRODUCTION



1		Turn on/off standby mode (low-power state). For complete power off, slide the back switch from ON to OFF.
2		Enable/Disable the sound output.
3	CD	Press to switch to the CD mode.
4	AUX	Press to switch to AUX IN mode
5		Press to switch to Bluetooth Receiver mode.
6	USB	Press to switch to USB mode.
7	FM	Press to switch to FM mode.
8		Press to switch to Bluetooth Transmitter mode.
9	Sleep	Press to activate sleep mode for 30/45/60/90 minutes or deactivate sleep mode.
10	EQ	Press to activate EQ sound mode: cycle through BBS/POP/Jazz/Rock/Classic presets.
11	VOL+	Press to increase the volume, with a maximum volume of 30.
12		In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver or Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press briefly to skip to the previous track. In FM radio mode: Press briefly to decrease the frequency step by step. Press and hold to start an automatic forward scan; the device will search in the direction of decreasing frequency and automatically save stations with a signal.
13		In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver mode or Bluetooth Transmitter press briefly to play/pause audio. In FM radio mode, press briefly to switch stations.

14		In CD, USB, Bluetooth Receiver or Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press briefly to skip to the next track. In FM radio mode: Press briefly to increase the frequency step by step. Press and hold to start an automatic backward scan; the device will search in the direction of increasing frequency and automatically save stations with a signal.
15	VOL-	Press to decrease the volume, with a minimum volume of 0.
16	A-B	In CD, USB, Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press to set A-B repeat playback. The first press sets the starting point A, the second press sets the ending point B, and the third press turns off repeat playback.
17	REPEAT	In CD, USB, Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press to cycle through playback modes: Single Repeat, All Repeat, Random Play, or Repeat Off.
18	Numeric Keypad 0~9	In CD, USB or Bluetooth Transmitter mode, press a number to play the corresponding track. In FM mode, press a number to switch to the corresponding station.
19	BASS-	Press to reduce the bass effect.
20	BASS+	Press to reduce the bass effect.

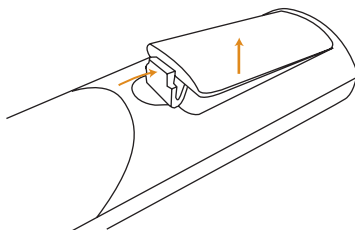

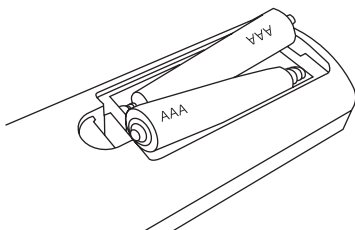

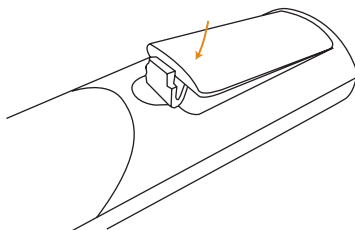
BATTERY INSTALLATION

MODE INTRODUCTION

» CD MODE

1. Remove the protective card. Slide the ON/OFF switch on the back to ON, insert a compatible CD, then slide the Play/Stop Lever to the left to load and playback.
2. Select from 3 modes using the "REPEAT" button on the remote: Single Track Repeat, All Tracks Repeat, or Shuffle Play. If repeat playback is not set, after playing the entire CD, playback will stop automatically. The unit will enter standby mode after 15 minutes of inactivity.
3. Supports setting an A-B repeat playback segment within a single track.
4. Press "8" on the remote control to play the 8th track. Quickly press "1" and then "2" in succession to play the 12th track.
5. Automatically remembers the playback position when powered off and will resume playback from that point upon next power-on.
6. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the 3.5mm headphones jack. The CD player's internal speaker will be muted, and audio will be output through the connected headphones or external audio device.

» USB MODE

1. Insert the USB drive into the USB port, press the  on the panel or the USB key on the remote control to switch to USB mode. After loading for about 10 seconds, you can start playing the audio content from the USB drive.
2. Select from 4 modes using the "REPEAT" button on the remote: Single Track Repeat, All Tracks Repeat, File Repeat or Shuffle Play. If no repeat mode is set, playback will automatically stop after finishing all audio content on the USB drive and enter standby mode after 15 minutes of inactivity.
3. Supports A-B repeat playback within the same track.
4. Pressing number 8 on the remote control will play the 8th track, while quickly pressing numbers 1 and 2 will play the 12th track.
5. Automatically remembers the playback position when powered off and resumes from that position the next time it is turned on.

6. By inserting a 3.5mm audio cable into the 3.5mm headphone jack, the CD player will mute its internal audio, and audio will be output through other external headphones or audio devices.

» AUX IN MODE

1. Connect your mobile phone/tablet/laptop/computer to the CD player's AUX port using a 3.5mm audio cable, then press the "▼M" on the panel or the "AUX" button on the remote to switch to AUX mode.
2. In this mode, the CD player functions as an external audio device. When connected to a mobile phone/tablet/laptop, the audio from the device will be output through the CD player.

» Bluetooth Receiver Mode

1. Press the "▼M" on the panel or the "⌘" on the remote control to switch to Bluetooth receiver mode.
2. When the ⌘ flashes, the CD player is in pairing mode.
3. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone/tablet/laptop/computer, locate "CD_PLAYER" in the device list, and pair with it.
4. Once paired successfully, the ⌘ will remain steady, and you can wirelessly stream audio from your mobile phone/tablet/laptop/computer to the CD player.

Note: During pairing, avoid turning on other Bluetooth devices within 10 meters to prevent pairing failure. If pairing fails, make sure other Bluetooth devices are disconnected, or search and pair again.

» FM MODE

1. Press the "▼M" on the panel or "FM" on the remote control to switch to FM mode (rAd).
2. Full-auto station search:
 - Press and hold ► on the panel or remote control for a few seconds to complete a full-auto station scan.
 - Stations with signals found during the scan will be temporarily saved automatically. Press the corresponding number key on the remote to switch to that station.

3. Semi-auto station search:

Press and hold "◀◀" or "▶▶" on the panel or remote control to automatically search forward or backward for stations with signals and stop at the found station.

4. Manual station search:

Press "◀◀" or "▶▶" briefly to decrease or increase the frequency by 0.1 steps. Stop adjusting when you hear a clear signal with audio output.

» **BLUETOOTH TRANSMITTER MODE**

1. In CD or USB mode, press on "🔗" the panel or the remote control. When 🔗 on the LCD screen flashes, the CD player is in pairing mode.
2. Switch another Bluetooth audio device to Bluetooth pairing mode.
3. The CD player will automatically select the nearest Bluetooth audio device with the strongest signal for pairing.
4. Once paired successfully, 🔗 on the LCD screen will stay lit. The audio from the CD player will be output through the other Bluetooth audio device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Unable to load or play CD audio content.	1. Check the CD disc format Ensure the disc is compatible: CD, CD-R, CD-G or CD-RW 2. Inspect the CD disc for damage Check if the disc is cracked, scratched, or severely damaged. If the issue persists, please contact help@pofotovip.com for further customer support.
Unable to load or play audio content from the USB drive, or playback stutters/skips.	1. Ensure the audio files are in supported formats (MP3, WMA). 2. The USB drive should be formatted in FAT32 or exFAT (NTFS is usually not supported). Avoid using USB drives with complex partitions or encryption features. 3. Check the USB drive for physical damage or poor contact. Try connecting the USB drive to a computer to verify if the files can be read normally. If possible, try testing with another USB drive to determine if the issue is related to the drive itself. 4. Check audio file integrity. The audio files may be corrupted. Try playing these files on another device (e.g., a computer or mobile phone) to confirm they are intact. 5. File quantity and organization. Avoid storing too many files or folders on the USB drive, as this may cause slower loading speeds.

	6. Keep the directory structure simple; it is best to place audio files in the root directory. USB drives larger than 128GB are not supported. If the issue persists, please contact help@pofotovip.com for further customer support.

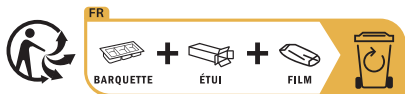
