Visit start.kontakt.io to create a customer account and add your devices to the customer panel using your Order ID. Download the app and activate your Dispenser Beacon ES10. Follow the instructions in the Kontakt Device Manager mobile app to configure your Dispenser Beacon ES10.

ES10 Dispenser Beacon is attached as a SmartLink module to the Gojo ES10 soap/sanitizer dispenser. It is a dispense event sensor used to monitor hand hygiene compliance in Healthcare facilities. Battery: 4x ER14250 3.6V, total capacity 10800 mAh.

Postępuj zgodnie z instrukcjami w aplikacji mobilnej Kontakt Device Manager, aby skonfigurować Dispenser Beacon ES10.
