



- Clean the fixture with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, volatile solvent or harsh abrasives.
- Non-professional Do not attempt to take apart and repair the fixture .
- Please use the constant-current driver exclusively adaptive to the troffer, do not change the driver without permission .

LOCATION: Fixture can be wall mounted.

Fixture designed for wall mount above 4 ft. only. Mount fixture to a grounded standard junction box marked for use in wet locations. Suggest to install the light fixture between 5 ft. and 8 ft.above the ground.

FEATURES:

Photocell control: At night,turns light ON automatically and turns light OFF automatically when the sun rises.
 Lumens output: 1,000 lumens / 5,000K .

Note: Photocell may have a few minutes delay, to reduce it's sensitivity to sudden light changes. When testing shine a light/cover the photocell for a few minutes to check if fixture functions properly.









PREPARATION: Tools required for assembly (not included): Philips screwdriver, hammer, safety goggles, power drill, silicone sealant and ladder.

INSTALLATION AND OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION

- Before installing the light fixture, ensure that all parts are present. Compare parts with the Hardware Included and Package Contents sections. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install, or operate this light fixture.
- Turn off the power before installation,remove the old light fixture if necessary.Open the hole on the mounting surface according to the size of fixture.
- When mounting fixture, for Dusk to Dawn operation, make sure the photocell orientation is at the top for wall mount, in an area that receives daylight and not too close to reflective surfaces.

Estimated installation time: 10 minutes.

 <p>1. Turn off the power and take off the original light fixture.</p>	 <p>2. Place the Threaded Tube (C) clockwise into the Junction Box Bracket (B).</p>	 <p>3. Line up the holes on the Junction Box Bracket (B) with the holes on your junction box. Using the two screws (G or H) that best fit the outlet box attach the Junction Box Bracket (B) to your junction box and fix tightly.</p>	 <p>4. Making the electrical connections using attached two Wire Nuts (F). Make sure the wire connection polarity is correct. * White to white * Black to black * Ground on Junction Box Bracket to house ground</p>
 <p>5. Remove the light shade from the light towards anti-clockwise direction.</p>	 <p>6. Place all power cords into the junction box, insert the back hole of the light into the Threaded Tube, then screw the Light Fixing Nut (D) with Waterproof Ring (E) tightly.</p>	 <p>7. Clip the light shade into the groove of the light and rotate it towards clockwise direction to tighten it. Caulk around the light base and mounting surface with silicone sealant (not included).</p>	 <p>8. Turn on the power and check the light function.</p>

OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dusk-to-dawn operation enables the light fixture to automatically turn ON when dark outside and turn OFF when the sun rises, thus saving you energy.

TIP: To test if the light fixture and photocell works properly run power to the fixture and cover the photocell to turn fixture ON. Shine a light into the photocell to see if fixture turns OFF.

Note: If photocell on the top of the light fixture is located in an area under heavy shade the photocell may not detect enough light and turn the light fixture on.



TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn ON	No power to the fixture.	Check if circuit breaker is tripped and confirm wall switch is ON. Verify wiring to fixture is correct (turn power off to fixture beforehand).
Light cycles ON and OFF continuously	Photocell light sensor is sensing reflected light.	Relocate light fixture to a location where there is no reflected light.
Light FLICKERS	The light fixture is wired through an unsuitable dimmer.	Replace the dimmer switch to a standard ON/OFF wall switch.
Light stays ON	Light sensor is in a shaded area.	Shine a flashlight into the light sensor and wait a couple minutes. If the light turns OFF, the fixture should be moved to a location with enough light in the daylight hours for the light sensor to work.
