

Smart clock Instruction Manual

Thank you for purchasing this product
Please read this instruction manual carefully before use!

- 1 Ensure that this product and the phone requiring operation are connected to the same WiFi address
- 2 Plug the randomly distributed data cable with a Type-C interface into this product, and connect the other end's USB port to a 5V plug. (Note: Do not connect high power)
- 3 After being powered on, the product enters the initialization state:

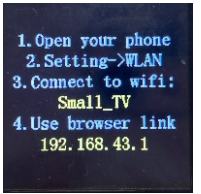

- 4 Open your phone, navigate to the settings menu, find the WiFi connection option, and select Small_TV (as shown in Figure 3)

In this step, the phone will automatically redirect to the WiFi settings interface. If it fails to switch automatically, you can enter 192.68.43.1 in the phone's browser

- 5 Input the password for the same WiFi address as the phone and click "Confirm" (as shown in Figure 4)
- 6 After entering the password, this product enters the IP connection interface (as shown in Figure 5)

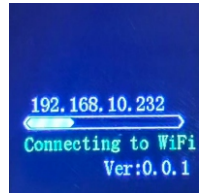

- 7 After successful connection, the product enters the initial interface of the main interface. (As shown in Figure 6)

Note: The IP address displayed on this interface is set for the phone, which is different from the previous IP address. This IP will scroll through the display

- 8 Open the mobile browser and enter the IP address of the connected product as shown in Figure 6 into the search bar. After entering, the phone will redirect to the product settings interface. (as shown in Figure 7)

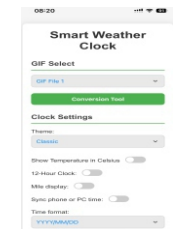

Troubleshooting:

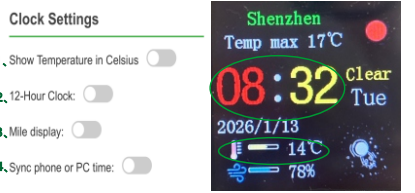
1. Do not turn on the device
Poor contact of USB cable, re plug the cable
2. Small TV cannot be found on the phone
The product has been connected to WIFI
Manually input the IP displayed in Figure 6 for scrolling
3. Unable to log in with IP address
The mobile phone and this product are not on the same WI FI
The phone is not connected to WIFI
Unplug the power and power it on again
Wrong IP address
4. Weather and time are not displayed
Network delay, simply power on again
5. The screen display is unclear
Adjust brightness in phone settings

- 9 Set GIF animation format



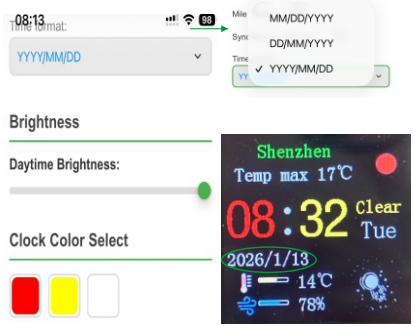
Format as: City Name, Country Abbreviation

- 10 Temperature and time settings

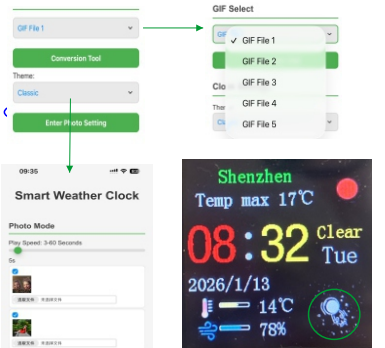


1. Temperature unit switching
