PRODUCT FEATURE

- Automatically enters Bluetooth mode when powered on; a beep indicates successful pairing.
- Built-in WMA decoding capability; can directly play WMA music files stored on a memory card.
- Built-in FM radio module; inserting a USB cable provides a signal source for convenient auto-scanning and saving of radio stations.

KEY&SLOT FUNCTION

- **POWER SWITCH:** OFF = off, ON = on
- **TWS:** POWER ON TWO DEVICES (A AND B). BRIEFLY PRESS THE PAUSE BUTTON ON DEVICE A TWICE; A BEEP INDICATES SUCCESSFUL PAIRING.
- **5V CHARGING VIA STANDARD USB-C CABLE.**
- **MEMORY CARD SLOT:** INSERT A MICROSD CARD TO DECODE AND PLAY AUDIO FILES.
- **USB CARD SLOT:** INSERT A USB CARD TO DECODE AND PLAY AUDIO FILES.
- **⏮/V- BUTTON:** SHORT PRESS TO PLAY PREVIOUS TRACK; LONG PRESS TO DECREASE VOLUME.
- **⏭/V+ BUTTON:** SHORT PRESS TO SKIP TO NEXT TRACK; LONG PRESS TO INCREASE VOLUME.
- **PAUSE BUTTON:** WHEN PLAYING MUSIC (FROM MEMORY CARD OR BLUETOOTH), BRIEFLY PRESS TO PLAY/PAUSE.
- Press the M key to switch between lighting effects.
