Q&A

- **Cannot take photos or record videos**
Check whether the TF card has sufficient space and whether it is locked.
- **Recording stops automatically**
Use a high-speed card or a high-speed memory card of Class 10 or above.
- **"File Error" prompt appears when replaying pictures and videos**
There was an error when the TF card was storing data, resulting in incomplete files. Please use the "Format" function of the camera to reformat the TF card.

User Manual

1. APP Download and Installation

1.1 Scan the QR code on the cover. After installation, click to enter "Viidure", as shown in the figure below.



2. Device Addition

- **For iPhone:** Enter the system WiFi, select the recorder's WiFi, enter the WiFi password (the default password is 12345678), connect, and then enter the "Viidure" APP to complete the addition.
- **For Android:** Enter the "Viidure" APP, click "Add Recorder", follow the addition wizard to enter the system WiFi interface, select the recorder's WiFi, enter the WiFi password (the default password is 12345678), connect, and after the connection is completed, click "Return" to finish the addition.

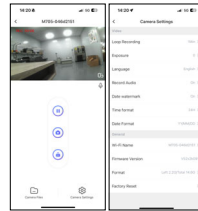


3. APP Function Introduction



1. **Recorder:** This page manages the recorder, allowing you to add, view, and delete recorders, and enter the video preview interface of the recorder.
2. **Album:** Manages pictures and videos downloaded from the recorder to the mobile phone.
3. **More:** Includes language settings, problem feedback, and information about the APP.

4. Recorder Function Introduction

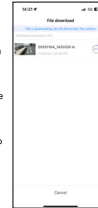


1. **Taking Photos:** Operate the recorder to take a photo, which will be saved on the recorder after completion.
2. **Zooming:** Enter or exit full-screen video mode.
3. **Recorder Files:** Access the file list on the recorder, classified by loop videos, photo files, emergency events, and other events.
4. **Recorder Settings:** Enter the recorder's settings interface to configure loop recording, exposure and record audio, etc.

4.1. Recorder File Download
Click "Recorder Files" to enter the file list interface, click the "Select" button, select the pictures or videos to be downloaded, click "Download" to start downloading the files. After the download is completed, the files will be saved to the mobile phone and can be viewed through "Album".



4.2 Recorder File Playback
Click "Recorder Files" to enter the file list interface. You can play the videos on the recorder directly without downloading, and you can also take a photo of the current playback screen of the video.



Download: Download the video to the mobile phone.

Take Photo: Take a photo of the current playback screen and save it to the mobile phone.

5. Album

Enter "Album" to manage the pictures or videos that have been downloaded to the mobile phone. Click "All" to enter the complete list of videos in this category. The file list is arranged by date. Click "Select" to select multiple files for operation.

File Classification

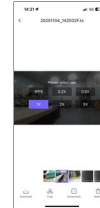
1. **Video:** All video files.
2. **Image:** All image files.
3. **Emergency:** Files triggered by collision sensing.



6. Video Playback

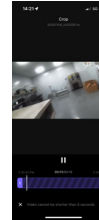
For pictures or videos in the "Album", multiple operations can be performed (details as shown in the figure).

When playing videos in "Recorder Files" or "Album", you can select the playback speed. This allows you to quickly browse the video content or play key segments slowly, such as "1 frame per second" or "10x (10 times speed)".



7. File Editing

Select the file in the "Album", then select edit to enter the editing interface. It supports cropping and filter beautification for pictures; for videos, it supports cropping, music addition and other operations.
