二、 Receiver, Handset, quick plug-in illustration and overview

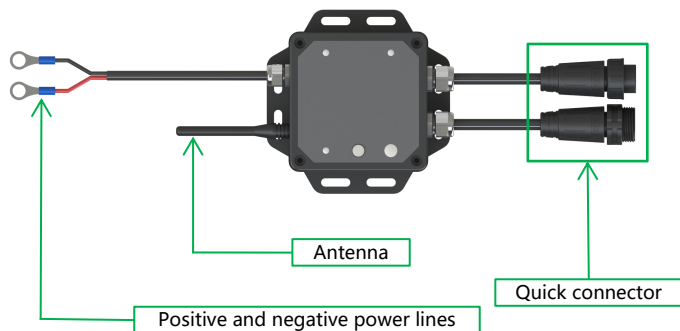


Figure 1 Receiver

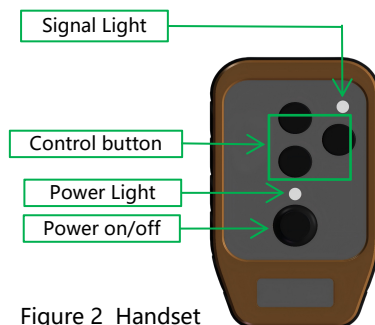
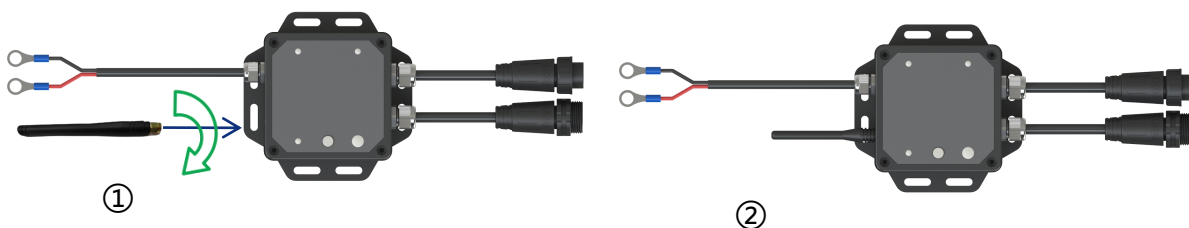


Figure 2 Handset

三、 Installation and usage instructions

1. **Receiver antenna installation:** Follow steps ①② to install the antenna onto the receiver and tighten it. (Clockwise direction)



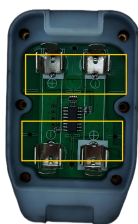
2. **Handset battery installation:**



① Prepare tools

② Loosen the screws on the back cover

③ Remove the back cover



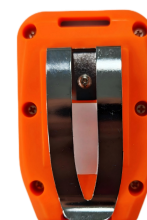
④ Battery Specification: 2 x 7# AAA

⑤ Check "+" and "-"

⑥ Install the battery correctly



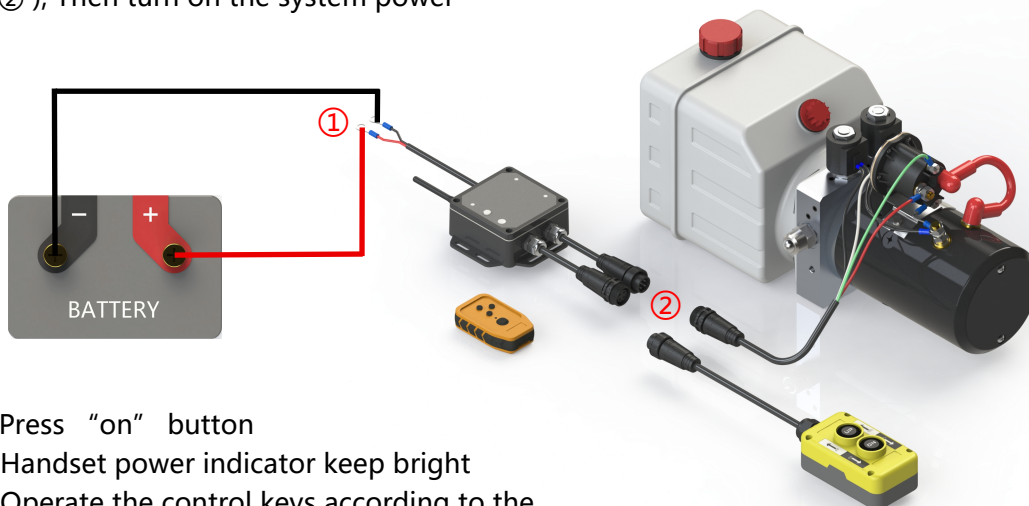
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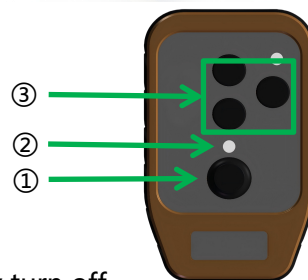
⑦ Install the back cover and tighten the mounting screws on the back cover

3. Remote control connection and installation:

1. Connect the receiver's positive and negative terminals to the battery. (See mark ①), connect receiver connector to hydraulic power unit connector (See mark ②), Then turn on the system power



2. ① Press "on" button
- ② Handset power indicator keep bright
- ③ Operate the control keys according to the markings on the remote control panel.



3. Please note if there is no operation over 5 seconds after the handset is powered on, The handset will automatically turn off.

Caution⚠ :

When handset is in active, Please do not press two or more control buttons at the same time. Please make sure that after pressing any button, then press the other one!
