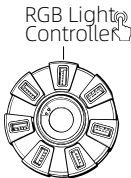

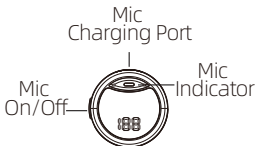

Products Composition

This product is mainly composed of two parts: USB 2.0 HUB and wireless lavalier microphone.



USB 2.0 HUB

Instruction

【Using the USB 2.0 Hub】

Plug the USB expander into your computer while the computer is powered on; it is ready to use.

【Using the Microphone】

Power On

Plug the USB expander into your computer while the computer is powered on; it is ready to use.

- Pairing: Microphone indicator flashes red and green alternately.
- Paired successfully: Microphone indicator stays green.

Microphone Power Button Functions



Long press: Power on / Power off

Single click: Noise reduction on/off

Double click: Mute on/off

*The microphone is ready for use once paired successfully.

Mute

Double click the microphone power button to enter mute mode. The indicator stays red. Double click again to exit mute.

Noise Reduction

After the microphone is powered on and paired successfully, deep noise reduction is enabled by default (indicator stays green). Single click the power button to disable noise reduction (indicator flashes green). Click again to enable noise reduction.

Power Off

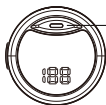
Long press the microphone power button for 3 seconds to turn off the microphone.

Charging

Place the microphone into the USB Hub; it will

automatically power off and start charging.
Charging stops automatically when full.

Microphone Indicator Status



Pairing: Red and green flashing
Paired successfully: Green steady
Noise reduction on: Green steady
Noise reduction off: Green flashing
Mute: Red steady
Low battery: Red flashing

RGB Lighting Control

After the expander is plugged into the computer, it defaults to rainbow mode. To adjust or turn off the lighting, single click the finger-pattern area on the side of the HUB.



Single Click

- 1st click: Blue, red, green, yellow 4 lights rotate clockwise
- 2nd click: Red, green, blue, pink, orange, purple, white lights cycle sequentially
- 3rd click: Lights off
