Connect to the Power

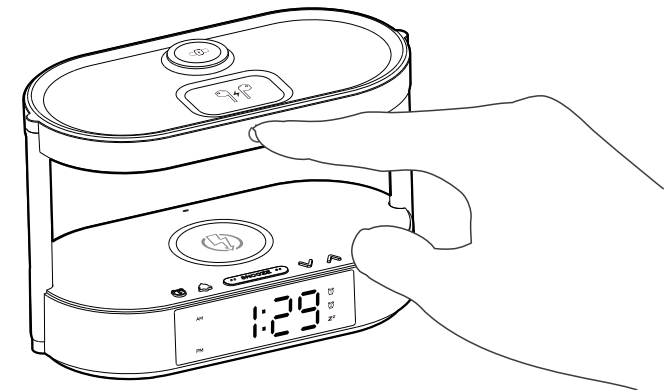
Plug in the adaptor, display screen open automatically, buzzer will make two sounds of bleep, and indicator of wireless charger light up red 3 seconds and then turn off.



The light source in the product should be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or similar qualified person

Night Light Adjustment

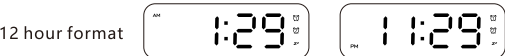
Short press "Night light button" in turn to adjust night light brightness: Maximum- Middle -Low - Off.



Time Setting

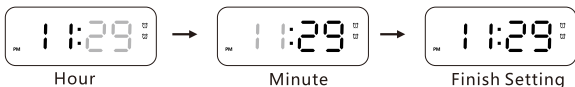


Short press to switch from 12 and 24 hour time format.
12 hour format will show AM/PM.



Time Setting:

Long press to enter time setting. When first enter setting mode, the Hour digital flashing, press or to set Hour. When we finish setting hour, press to set Minute.
press or to set Minute. When finish setting minute, press to exit time setting.
If without any operation in time setting mode for 30 seconds, it will exit time setting automatically and display current time.

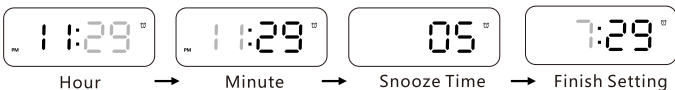


Alarm Setting

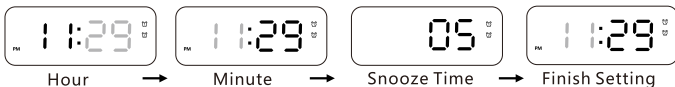
Alarm 1 Setting:



Alarm : Press to enter alarm 1 setting mode, the icon will display on screen, and then long press to enter setting Hour, the hour digital will flashing. Press or to set Hour. When finish setting Hour, press to enter setting Minute, and press again to set Snooze, you can set snooze time 5/10/15/20/25/30 minutes. When finish setting, press to exit.
In alarm 1 setting mode, if without any operation for 30 seconds, it will exit alarm setting mode automatically. Or you can press to exit setting alarm.



Alarm : First, press to enter alarm 2 setting mode. When in alarm 2 setting mode, the icon will display on screen. Long press to enter setting Hour-Minute-Snooze. It is the same operation as we set alarm 1.



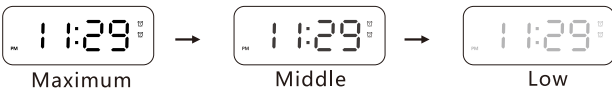
Note: In time display model, short press in turn to turn on or turn off alarm 1 and alarm 2. When the alarm is turned on, the icon will display on screen. When the alarm icon disappear in screen, it means the alarm is turned off.

Snooze Function

- ① When alarm rings, press to enter snooze mode, the icon **ZZ** will flashing on screen. When in snooze mode, press again to cancel snooze function. the icon **ZZ** disappear from the screen.
- ② When the alarm rings, press any of the 4 buttons /// to stop the alarm. If the alarm rings for 1 minute without any operation, it will stop rings.

Screen Backlight

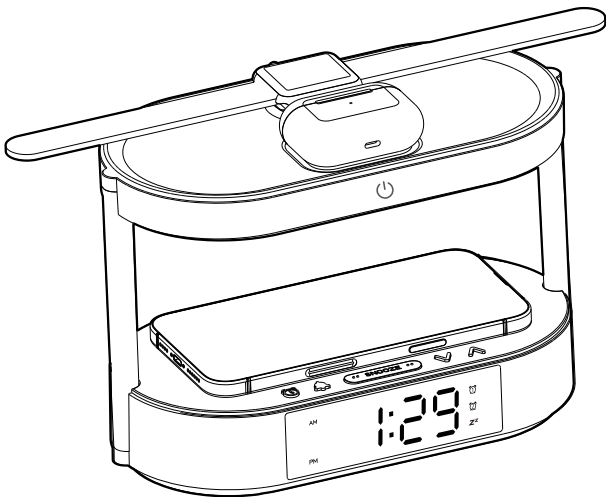
In any mode, press to adjust the screen backlight. The screen brightness is Maximum - Middle - Low - Turn Off.



Wireless Charging

Put the devices which supports wireless charging function on the middle of slide -proof pad, red indicator means it is charging, green indicator means it is fully charged. If the red light flashing, it is failure signal, please check if there is any metal object on the wireless charging pad.
Bottom is 10W wireless charging, upper is 5W wireless charging for earphone, and 3W wireless charging for Apple series watch.

Note: Only mobile phone wireless charging has indicator function, watch wireless charging only supports Apple series.
