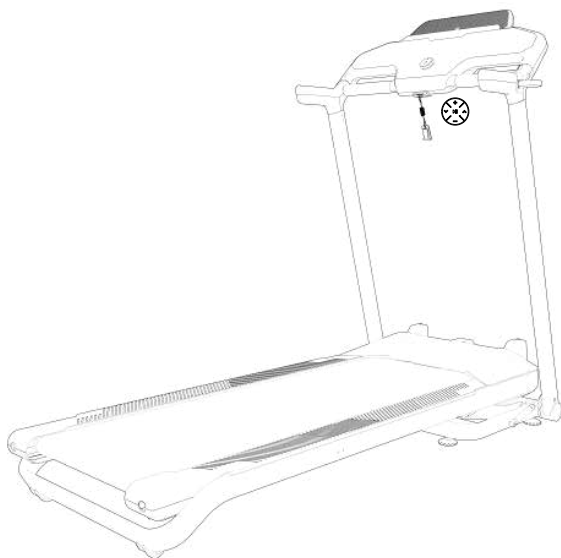

Pairing: Remote Control Close to Console (See picture), keep pressing «+» + «-». If succeed, Console will beep x3

A. ST/SP Start/Stop Button: Controls the start and stop of the treadmill after successful pairing.

B. SPEED+ Speed Increase Button: When the treadmill is running, this button can be used to increase the speed. The increment is the same as pressing the speed+ button on the treadmill once. Press this button simultaneously during pairing.

C. SPEED- Speed Decrease Button: When the treadmill is running, this button can be used to decrease the speed. The decrement is the same as pressing the speed- button on the treadmill once. Press this button simultaneously during pairing.

D. INCLINE+ Incline Increase Button: When the treadmill is running, this button can be used to raise the incline. The increment is the same as pressing the incline+ button on the treadmill once.

E. INCLINE- Incline Decrease Button: When the treadmill is running, this button can be used to lower the incline. The decrement is the same as pressing the incline- button on the treadmill once.

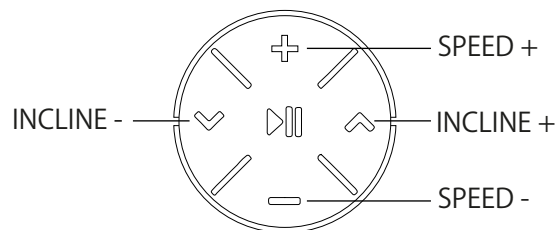
