## Introduction

**Pyle** delivers a classic, iconic retro-style performance microphone that adds vintage elegance to live performances or studio recordings. It offers tomorrow's audio performance with a legendary, old-school feel. The built-in pop shield helps eliminate popping sounds caused by the mechanical impact of fast-moving air, resulting in clearer audio.

This professional classic dynamic vocal mic features a 16-foot XLR cable, high signal output, integrated low noise circuitry, an ultra-wide frequency response of 30 Hz–15 kHz, a sensitivity of  $-50$  dB ( $\pm 3$  dB @ 1 kHz), and a 600-ohm output impedance.

The cardioid (heart-shaped) pickup pattern is most sensitive at the front and rejects sound from the sides, making it ideal for live stage performances, karaoke, and studio recording. The built-in universal mic stand adapter is compatible with most mic stands available today. It also features a self-tensioning swivel mount and an internal cartridge shock mount that allows you to fully adjust the mic forward or backward.

## Precautions

- Do not expose the microphone to water, moisture, or extreme heat.
- Always handle the microphone with care to avoid damage from dropping or impact.
- Use only the included or compatible XLR cables and connectors.
- Turn off the microphone when not in use to extend its lifespan.
- Avoid blocking the grill to ensure optimal sound pickup.
- Keep away from strong magnetic fields to prevent interference.
- Never attempt to open or modify the microphone; this may void the warranty.

## How to Use

Before using your dynamic microphone, connect it to an audio interface. First, plug the audio interface into your computer, then connect the microphone to the interface using the included XLR cable. Finally, change the input settings on your computer to use the audio interface.

## How to Operate

- Push the slider upward to turn **ON** the microphone.
- Push the slider downward to power **OFF** the microphone.
- Push the mic forward or backward to adjust its position.

## How to Remove Background Noise

1. **Publish audio:** Upload your audio files to VEED (browser-based).
2. **Remove background noise:** Click on the audio track, open Settings, then select Clean Audio. Background noise will be removed automatically.
3. **Done:** Your audio is now cleaned and ready.

## How to Connect

Connect one end of the XLR cable to the microphone and the other end to your desired device. Ideal for karaoke, stage performances, and recording.

# Cleaning, Maintenance, and Storage

## Cleaning:

- Gently wipe the exterior with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.
- For tougher spots, lightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using any harsh cleaners, solvents, or alcohol.
- Do not spray any liquid directly on the microphone.

## Maintenance:

- Regularly inspect the XLR cable for any signs of damage or wear.
- Keep the microphone free from dust and debris by storing it properly after each use.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the mic to shock to protect the internal cartridge.

## Storage:

- Store the microphone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- If possible, keep the microphone in a padded case or box to prevent damage.
- Detach the XLR cable before storage to avoid stress on the connectors.
